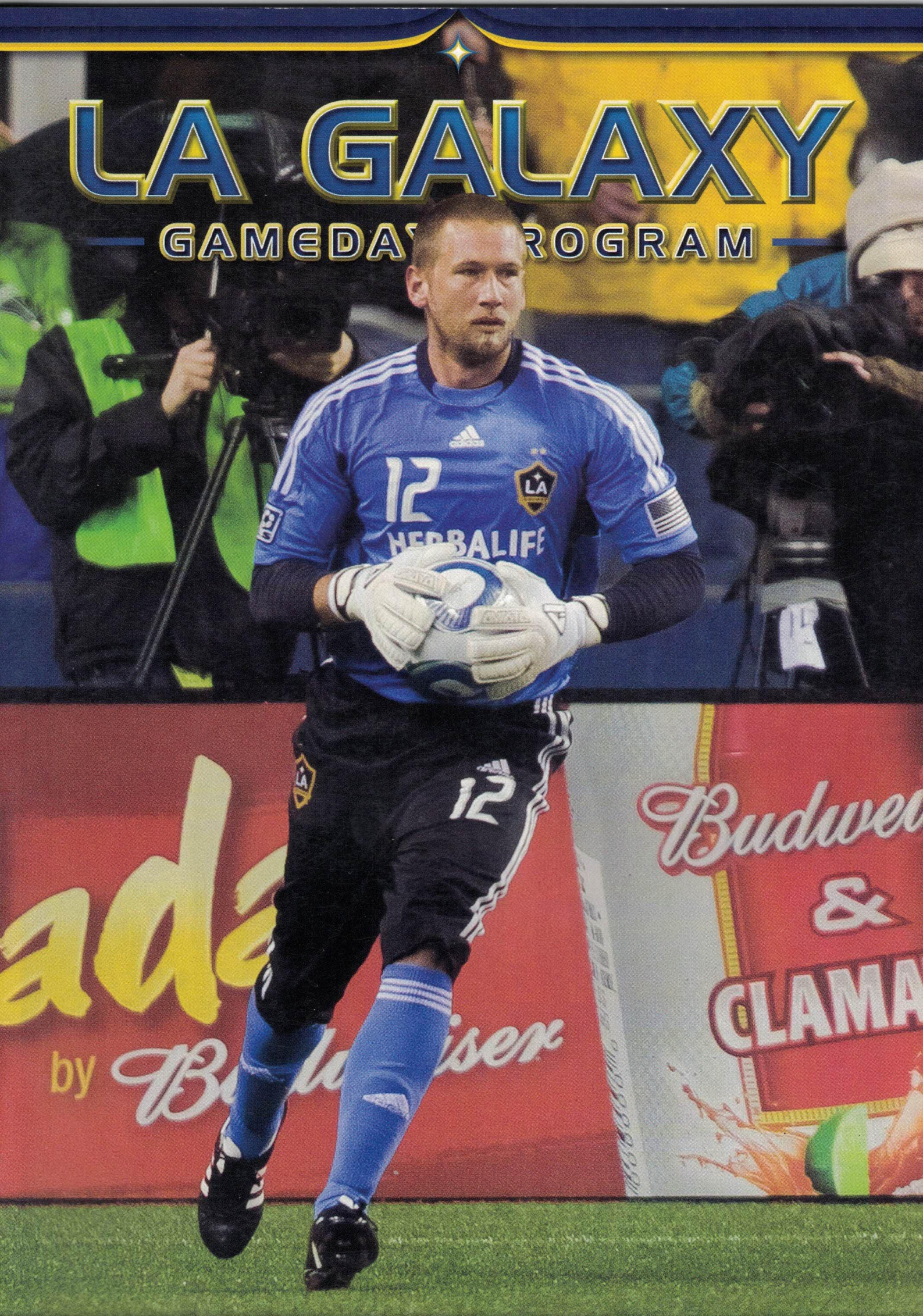

The Galaxy are coming off an outstanding week and need to maintain our momentum. Enjoy the game and support our team. You are making a difference at home and your support is greatly appreciated.



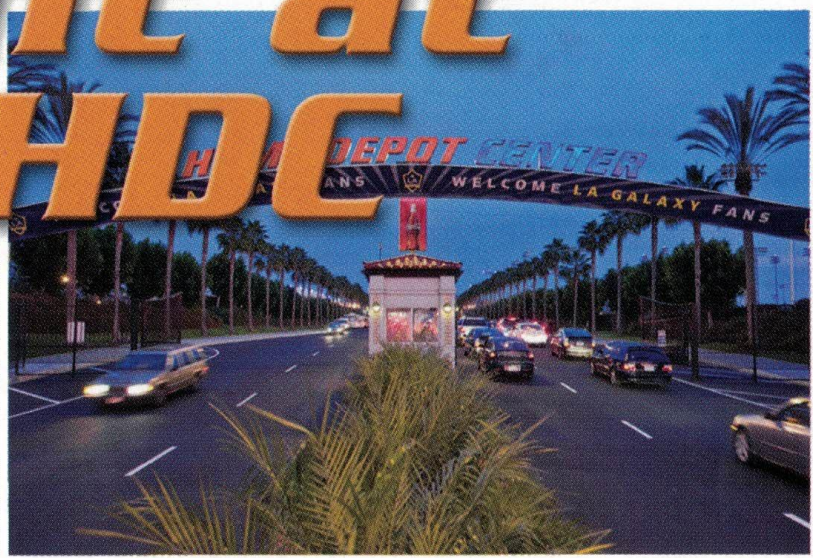

TONIGHT'S OPPONENT D.C. UNITED

For the second and final time this season, the LA Galaxy will face longtime MLS rival D.C. United. United come into tonight's game after doing what no team had done all season long, winning 3-2 in Portland on Sunday evening. Perry Kitchen, Chris Pontius and Josh Wolff all scored on the day for United, who extended their unbeaten streak to four games with the win.

Making that win all the more impressive was the fact that it was done without the services of top scorer Charlie Davies, who missed the game with a hamstring injury, though he could return to action for tonight's matchup. Davies is second in MLS with six goals this season, with one of those coming in controversial circumstances late in the two sides' first meeting at RFK Stadium on April 9. With LA leading 1-0 late in the game, Davies went to ground in the penalty area under the slightest of touches from Omar Gonzalez, earning a penalty kick that he converted to steal two points from the Galaxy and claim a 1-1 draw for his side.

While Davies still draws many of the headlines, he is only one part of a talented attacking quartet that also features 2010 MLS Rookie of the Year Andy Najar, Josh Wolff and local product Chris Pontius, who scored at The Home Depot Center in his MLS debut back in 2009. Pontius is second to Davies with four goals this season while Wolff has three, meaning that trio has accounted for 13 of United's 16 goals this season.

At the other end of the field, United will be without the services of their star center back Dejan Jakovic, who is with the Canadian National Team for the Gold Cup. As a result, head coach Ben Olsen could elect to pair first round SuperDraft selection Perry Kitchen and Academy signing Ethan White in central defense. White, who played at the University of Maryland, made his MLS debut against the Galaxy in April and has received high praise throughout his rookie season.

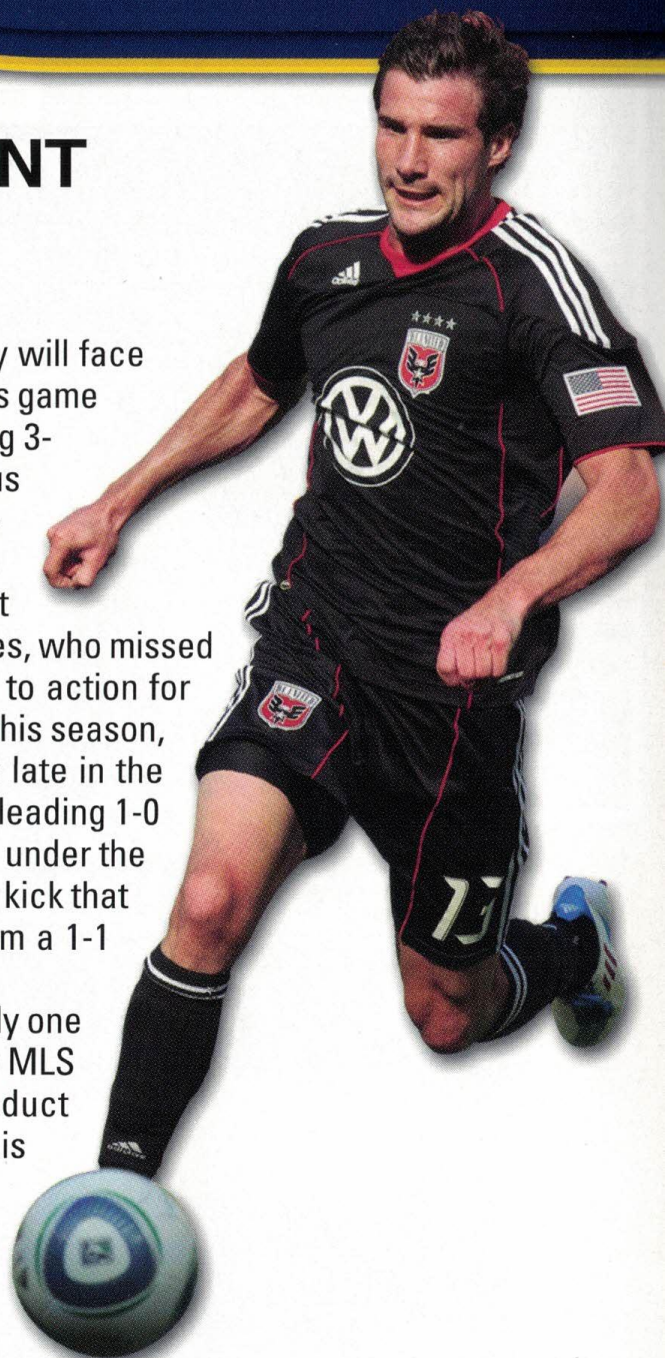
Behind them will be 20-year-old Bill Hamid, who also made his 2011 debut against the Galaxy in April. He has a 3-2-3 record on the season and was at the heart of a controversy against the Timbers on Sunday, as he was twice called for coming off his line early after stopping spot kick attempts by Kenny Cooper. Jack Jewsbury stepped up to take his team's third attempt, beating Hamid to tie the score at 1-1. Tall and athletic, Hamid is one of the top young goalkeepers in MLS and will be looking to help D.C. replicate their result against the Galaxy from April or go one better and get their first win over LA at The Home Depot Center since 2005.

The former UCSB star is back in form this season after missing much of the 2010 campaign because of hamstring surgery. Used up front, on the wing and in midfield, Pontius has already scored four goals for United this season, equaling his career-high from 2009, including one in Sunday's 3-2 win over Portland. He will look to find space on the flanks and run at the Galaxy fullbacks before crossing or taking a shot, just like he did as a rookie when he scored a goal in the 2-2 draw between the sides at The Home Depot Center. •



LA GALAXY'S LAST GAME

LA Galaxy 1, New England Revolution 0
Saturday, May 28, 2011
Gillette Stadium – Foxborough, Mass.

Miguel Lopez scored the first goal of his MLS career and the Galaxy rounded out a hectic month of May with a wild 1-0 win over the New England Revolution at Gillette Stadium on Saturday night. The win was the Galaxy's fourth straight and increased their lead at the top of the Western Conference standings to seven points over FC Dallas.

On a hot and humid night, the Revolution opened the game with the better of the chances, pressuring the Galaxy back four, which was playing its third game in eight days. However, LA were able to absorb the early pressure and came closest to scoring in the opening 45 minutes. In the 25th minute, David Beckham took one of LA's 10 corner kicks on the night and picked out Omar Gonzalez, whose powerful header beat Matt Reis only to hit the crossbar and rebound straight down in front of the goalline. Todd Dunivant was the first to get to the rebound, but he was put under heavy pressure from Benny Feilhaber and could not direct his header on target.

It would take until midway through the second half for LA to finally break the deadlock with Miguel Lopez scoring his first of the season. Sean Franklin played the ball back into the path of David Beckham on the right wing and the Galaxy midfielder crossed into the box, finding Lopez who cut in front of Franco Coria and glanced a header past Reis to give the Galaxy the lead.

Lopez tried to add to that lead a few minutes later and second half substitute Paolo Cardozo had a pair of left-footed drives late on but Reis was equal to the test each time, setting the stage for a dramatic final moments to the game.

In the first minute of stoppage time, New England's Kevin Alston floated a ball into the box which Donovan Ricketts was not able to punch away cleanly. The ball fell to Zack Schilawski and his first time shot was acrobatically cleared off the line by A.J. DeLaGarza. Sean Franklin could only clear the ball as far as Sainey Nyassi on the right wing and he whipped a cross back into the box for Schilawski who beat Ricketts again with his header, only to see it hit the crossbar and bounce down in front of the goalline. Shalrie Joseph attempted to head the rebound into the empty net, but Landon Donovan was able to recover and clear the ball away to assure the Galaxy of the full three points.

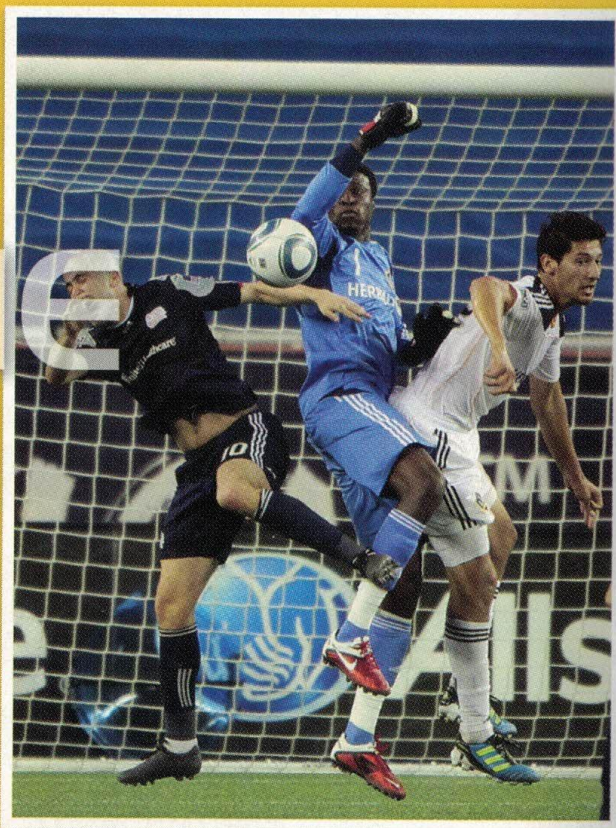

With Donovan Ricketts away on international duty ahead of the start of the Gold Cup, Josh Saunders will once again get the call in goal for the Galaxy tonight. Widely regarded as one of the top backup goalkeepers in MLS, Saunders has a 2-1-1 record with the Galaxy this season, helping lead the team to wins over Seattle and Kansas City earlier this season in place of Ricketts. As Bruce Arena pointed out in his pregame notes, the team expects Saunders to be up to the task for today's game, just as he was earlier this season when he had to step into the void to replace the injured Jamaican.

However, this will not be any typical start for Saunders, who carries tonight's theme of military appreciation to new levels. The 30-year-old has a long history of family serving in the military and he even worked with his glove provider Aviaata to produce a special camouflage-colored glove for Saunders, which he will be wearing tonight. The gloves also feature a pair of yellow ribbons on the front and the American flag across the wrists, leaving no doubt to Saunders' feelings in regards to the military.

We caught up with him before tonight's game to see what he thought about getting the start, playing on Military Appreciation Night and much more. Here is what he had to say...

You're back in the lineup tonight, how excited are you for the opportunity?

"Anytime you play you are going to be very excited. I'm looking forward to this one and hopefully I can live up to the standard that Donovan has set for us since the beginning of the year."

You have had more work this year compared to last season because of Ricketts' early season injury and now international duty. Do you think that this will help you stay on top of your game as the season progresses?

"I'm looking forward to these because we are reaching the midway point of our year. You want to be at a certain level at that point to carry you through to the end of the year. I want to use these games as a platform to gauge where I am at and get better from there. This will also give me a head start on games in the Open Cup and Champions League that are coming up and that I might be called upon for."

How much does it help to come in and play behind a back four that has been as consistent in terms of personnel all season long?

"It's great because they are playing in a rhythm and you just hope to be back there

and help out with what they're doing and not get in the way. They know the direction that they're going, so I'm just back there to give them whatever assistance they need."

Does your mindset change at all knowing that you are going to be the starter?

"Whether I'm playing or not, my mindset stays the same because you never know when you are going to be called on. I've experienced it plenty of times; you have to come into a game at a moment's notice. The mindset doesn't really change from day to day or game to game."

Because of the setup of the Gold Cup, you don't know if Donovan will be gone for two, three or four games. Does that change anything in the way that you approach each game?

"Our team's approach all season long has been to take things one game at a time, so that is how I am going to take things this month and just make sure that I am ready whenever I am called upon."

D.C. United are tonight's opponent, is the team still disappointed with the way the first game against them ended in April?

"It's a memory in the back of our heads and we feel that we had two points stolen from us. You really can't blame them, but at the same time it was a bad play on the part of their player. We just want to prove it to ourselves that we can carry through a game, see it through and win 1-0 like we have been lately."

Against Kansas City you did not have to make a number of saves in that game, do you want to get your first save out of the way early on so that you can get a better feel for the game?

"Obviously it helps to see something early on. As the game carries on, especially if it is a tight game, you don't necessarily want to be having a lot of action at your end. So getting a touch early on, catching a cross, making a save and then some distribution, that will be good."

Finally, what does it mean to you to represent the Galaxy and to wear your camouflage gloves here on Military Appreciation Night?

"Wearing these gloves means a lot to me. I have a lot of history with family in the military; my grandfather served in World War II, my dad was in the military for a long time and my niece's husband is serving now. It



is one of those things that we take for granted. We don't know what these guys do day in and day out for the jobs, and the fact that they are doing this for their country and for us, I don't think that it is appreciated enough. That's the story behind the gloves." •

With four games over the next two weekend's, the end is in sight for the Galaxy Academy U-16 team. With just one loss in their last four games, Kenny Arena's team is on the brink of qualifying for the postseason. We caught up with the U-16 coach to see what he thought of the final weeks of the regular season.

How has the team played of late and how important is it to qualify for the postseason?

"Our U-16 team continues to improve on and off the field. We've had some mixed results in 2011 but results will always vary with a "development first" philosophy. That being said, we still try to win every game that we play and with four games left, we are in prime position to make the playoffs.

You have four games left in the season, so you approach these games any differently than at the start of the year?

"We have decided to keep our age eligible U16 players together for the final 4 games of the regular season. This will be the first time all season that we've played this group together as we've played nine players up with the U-18's as well as getting them time playing with the Reserves and practicing with the first team on and off since January. Four games should be enough time to get everybody on the same page before the playoffs.

Is it important to approach each game individually as opposed to the whole group of four?

"I think it's always important to take one game at a time in terms of results. In terms of development, we will continue to try players in different spots on the field to aid in their progress of being well rounded positionally."

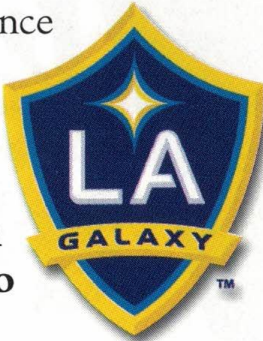
What would it mean to you and the group to be able to come back and win the division?

I'd love to win the division, but that was just one of around 100 goals that we had as a group. Winning is still important, but we care more about how we play and how we carry ourselves."

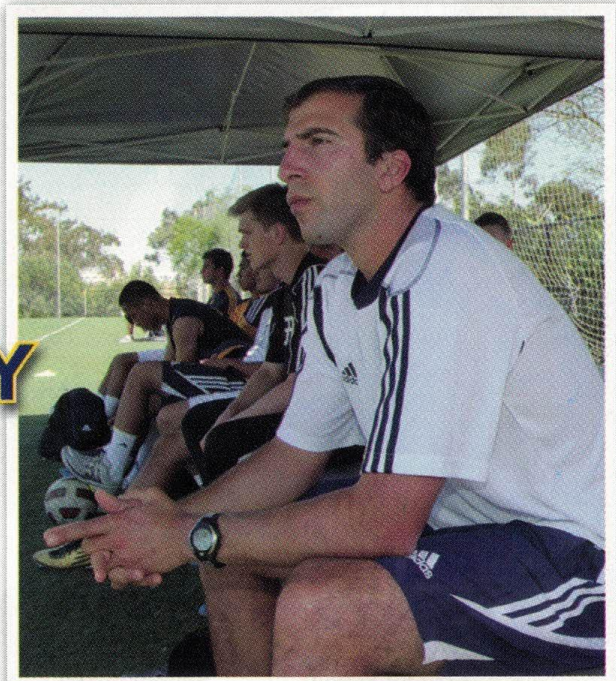
Given the goal of the Academy to develop and grow young players, could the season still be deemed a success if the team missed the playoffs?

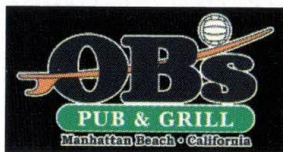

Tonight's game will be the Galaxy's first without both Landon Donovan and Donovan Ricketts, who each joined up with their respective national teams earlier this week ahead of the CONCACAF Gold Cup. Since the start of the 2009 season, the Galaxy are 7-5-3 without Donovan in the lineup and 4-2-3 without Ricketts. However, the pair have only-ever missed the same game three times with LA claiming a pair of 1-0 wins in 2009 when both players were at the Gold Cup before falling 4-1 to Real Salt Lake on March 26, a game that Ricketts missed through injury and Donovan missed while with the U.S. National Team for a friendly against Argentina.

In the four games that Landon Donovan has missed this season, the club has scored four goals, with Juan Pablo Angel, Chad Barrett, Omar Gonzalez and Mike Magee each scoring once.

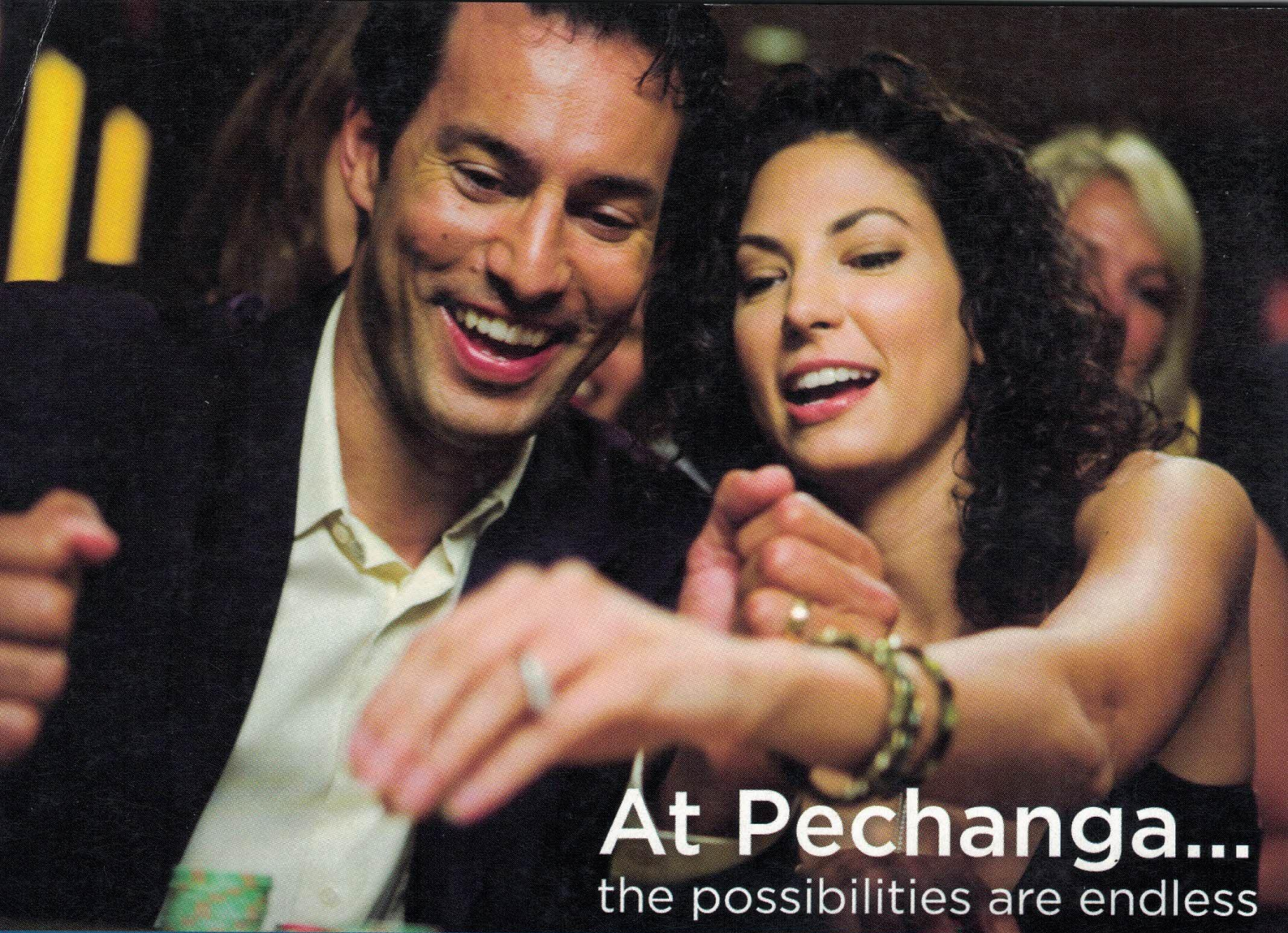
The Galaxy are 2-1-1 in the four games that Josh Saunders has started this season, winning the season opener at Seattle and then again against Sporting Kansas City on May 14 while drawing 1-1 with New England in the home opener and losing 4-1 to Real Salt Lake.

Bruce Arena was the D.C. United head coach from 1996-98, leading the team to a pair of MLS Cup championships in 1996 and 1997. Under Arena, United had a 61-35 record in the regular season and 14-3 in the postseason. Arena, who left United in following the 1998 season to become the head coach of the U.S. National Team, returned to MLS in 2006 and has faced United 11 times, tallying a 4-3-4 record, including a 2-0-3 mark as the Galaxy head coach.

Mike Magee scored the Galaxy's only goal in the 1-1 draw at D.C. United on April 9. That goal was his fourth regular season goal as a member of the Galaxy, with all four coming on the road. He has also added two postseason goals, with one coming in MLS Cup 2009 and the other coming against Chivas USA in a game in which the Galaxy were the road team.

First year Galaxy players Paolo Cardozo and Miguel Lopez will each celebrate birthdays next week. Lopez will turn 23 on Thursday, June 9 while Cardozo will turn 22 that same day. The pair were teammates in Argentina last season with Quilmes before joining the Galaxy in January. •
