After another challenging road game against a strong and determined opponent in inclement


weather, we are again eager to get back on the field at The Home Depot Center.



TONIGHT'S OPPONENT New York Red Bulls

e are less than two months into the 2011 MLS season and tonight's game I already stands to be one of the marguee games of the young season.

The New York Red Bulls arrive in Carson playing some of the best soccer that the league has seen in recent years, led by their captain Thierry Henry. The former Arsenal and Barcelona star had a sputtering start to the season, failing to score in any of New York's first four games. But since then, he has three goals and two assists in three games, helping New York take all nine points in wins over San Jose, D.C. United and Kansas City with his team outscoring their opponents 8-0 in those three games.

New York's recent turn of fortune has come on the heels of the addition of two new acquisitions to the starting lineup. Luke Rodgers, who was signed from Notts County during the offseason was, made one start in the first four games of the year, with that coming in place of an injured Henry. But following a 1-0 loss at Philadelphia on April 2, he was inserted to the starting lineup alongside Henry. The pairing has clicked, causing a constant threat to opposing defenses while Juan Aguedlo, who Rodgers replaced in the starting lineup, threatening off the bench.

The other move that helped turn New York into the offensive power that they have shown to be of late was the acquisition of Dwayne De Rosario from Toronto FC on April 1. De Rosario has added an additional attacking element to the Red Bull midfield along with Jamaican international Dane Richards on the right and Estonian Joel Lindpere on

the left. With that trio terrorizing opposition defenses, veteran midfielder Teemu Tainio is asked to sit in front of the back four and provide the first line of defense while also helping

to start the transition from defense to attack. However, he was forced to leave last weekend's win over Sporting Kansas City with a groin injury.

Even the Red Bulls' defensive-minded players like to get forward in the attack. Norwegian right back Jan Gunnar Solli had a breakout game in the 4-0 win at D.C. United, helping to set up three of his team's four goals. Additionally, the central defense pairing of Rafa Marquez and Tim Ream give head coach Hans Backe a pair of players that are comfortable on the ball and excel at playing the ball from the back.

The only question with the Red Bulls appears to be in goal where they have been forced to use three different players already this season. Bouna Coundoul has started the last five games and will likely get the call again tonight after keeping a clean sheet in each of his last three starts. He will be looking to add to his career 6-1-0 record against the Galaxy.

Key Man: Thierry Henry

For the first time in his MLS career, Thierry Henry comes to The Home Depot Center to take on the Galaxy. While the pairing of A.J. DeLaGarza and Omar Gonzalez helped keep him off the scoresheet in a friendly when he played for Barcelona in 2009, as well as last season at Red Bull Arena, no player has been in better form as of late. A complete striker, Henry will lineup centrally while also pulling out onto either flank to run at the Galaxy fullbacks. If LA can identify Henry early and limit the space he is given on the ball, they should be able to help minimize his impact on the game. But if he is given space and time to get into dangerous positions, he will put the Galaxy under pressure. •

LA GALAXY'S AST GAME

LA Galaxy 1, FC Dallas 2 **Sunday, May 1, 2011** Pizza Hut Park -Frisco, Texas

he LA Galaxy saw their five-game unbeaten streak come to an end in bizarre fashion with a 2-1 loss to FC Dallas at Pizza Hut Park on Sunday night. The game was played in a constant cold, wind and rain, making things difficult for both teams. Further complicating matters was a one hour and six minute stoppage in the 83rd minute because of lightning in the area.



Not many of the capacity crowd of

over 21,000 stuck around through the delay, but those that did were treated to an extraordinary finish as Brek Shea scored with a combination cross/lob in the 88th minute and Dallas was able to withstand a frantic late rally by the Galaxy to claim the victory.

After a scoreless first half, Dallas got on the board early in the second half when Fabian Castillo's volley eluded Donovan Ricketts and settled in the side netting for a 1-0 Dallas advantage in the 47th minute.

Trailing for the first time since the loss to Real Salt Lake, the Galaxy responded almost instantly with Landon Donovan scoring his third goal of the season. Juninho provided the telling pass, hitting a deep cross from 40 yards out on the left wing. The cross eluded the diving Kevin Hartman and was deflected over the line from close range by Donovan for his third goal in the last two games.

Both teams pressed for a winner as the rains picked up and the game appeared to be heading for a 1-1 draw before the lightning delay was called and Shea scored his winner.

Omar Gonzalez

Individual awards have been the standard for Omar Gonzalez since he joined the Galaxy as the No. 3 pick in the 2009 MLS SuperDraft. The MLS Rookie of the Year in his first season with the club, Gonzalez was named to his first All-Star Team in 2010 while also being named to the MLS Best XI and the Galaxy's Defender of the Year for the first time in his career.

But now in his third season, Gonzalez is focused on becoming more of a leader on the field and helping his team claim one award that has escaped them since 2005, the MLS Cup.

We caught up with the Galaxy's big center back after training earlier this week to see what he thought of tonight's game, his start to the season and his growth as a defender during his three years with the club.

How difficult was it to miss the first three games of the year while you were injured?

"That was the first time that I had to miss games through injury so it was tough to watch, especially because I was working so hard in the preseason to have a good season and get off on the right foot. But I just kept working to do my rehab and get back as quickly as possible. I did that and now I'm happy to be back on the field and contributing.

How much pride do you take in the team's defensive improvements since you returned from your injury?

"I'd like to think that I have played a big part in that, but I think that everyone has been playing better since the loss to Salt Lake. When those kinds of games happen you tend to look at yourself and everyone has done that and stepped it up. I just wanted to get off on the right foot when I returned so I think that has helped a lot."

Since Leonardo's injury, you have been paired with A.J. DeLaGarza in central defense. How has that partnership developed?

"A.J. is always great to play with because he is up for any challenge, he always plays well and I've been playing with him for so long that everything is just comfortable. You always know that you are going to get his best every game. Also, we know each other so well that we sometimes don't even need to say anything and we're in the right position."




You seem to be attacking the ball more on set pieces, is this something that you have spent time working on?

"Throughout the preseason that is something that I worked on and even now, after practice I'll stay out and get some headers in, work on my timing and really attacking the ball."

Everyone talks about your size, but you can really jump too.

"I've got some hops. It's great to see photos where you can see that I'm getting up pretty



high, I just hope to see a few more of those that end up with me scoring."

You're now in your third year with the club, how do you think that you have improved as a player and what aspects are you trying to still work on?

"I think that this year, ever since I came back from my injury, one of my biggest improvements has been in leading the back line and getting guys in the right positions. I think that I've done well with that. On the other side, I need to be better with the ball and getting it to the feet of our midfielders and forwards a bit better. I also want to score a few more goals."

Finally, you missed this game last year because of a suspension, how much are you looking forward to tonight's game?

"Last year was tough to watch because it was such a big game. Playing New York is always fun, so not being able to play sucked. But I'm here to play this year and I look forward to playing against a team with so many great play-

ers that are playing really well right now. I think that this is going to be a game that everyone wants to play their best in, so it's going to be a lot of fun." •

he all-time leading scorer in New York Red Bulls history, Juan Pablo Angel faces his former club for the first time as a member of the Galaxy tonight. In fact, this is the first time that Angel will face one of his former clubs in a league game, having played previously for Atletico Nacional, River Plate and Aston Villa before joining the Red Bulls in 2007. We caught up with LA's Designated Player to see what he had to say about facing his former team for the first time...

Will it be odd for you facing your former team?

"I had four years there and it will be the first time that I have the chance to play a team that I used to play for in the league so I guess that it will be a strange feeling for me."


Facing His Old Friends

You will likely be matched up with either Rafa Marquez or Tim Ream, both of whom were your teammates last season. Does that familiarity with them help you as a forward?

"I have known Rafa for a long time and we have played against one another with our national teams, but when he was with us in New York last year he was playing as a midfielder. But I know Rafa and I know Tim and they know me. There are no secrets. They know how I move, I know how good they are, so it balances out. Anything can happen.

How much would it mean to you to score a goal against your former club?

"As long as it helps to win the game and get three points for my team, I will be



happy. I will always be very grateful for my time with the Red Bulls, but I play for the Galaxy now. I will always try to do my best to win every game that we play and this is another one."

Finally, from what you have seen this year, what are the strengths of this year's Red Bull team?

"This is by far the best team that I have seen in five years for me. They have a very well-balanced team with a lot of strength and ability. When you look at their team now, they have a good player at every position on the field, but also a good backup and I think that is very important. They are definitely going to be contenders this year, that is for sure." •





Tonight's game will be Bruce Arena's 11th game as head coach of the Galaxy against one of his former clubs. Since being named the Galaxy's General Manager and Head Coach in August 2008, Arena has compiled a 6-1-3 record against his former teams, going 3-0-3 against D.C. United and 3-1-0 against the Red Bulls. Arena was the head coach at D.C. United from 1996-1998 and with the Red Bulls from 2006-2007.



After failing to score in 11 consecutive regular season and postseason games for the Galaxy, Landon Donovan has now scored in each of his last two games, tallying three times.

Last Sunday's loss to FC Dallas was just the second time since the start of the 2010 season that the Galaxy have lost their first game of a month. The 2010 MLS Supporters' Shield winners, the Galaxy were 6-1-1 in their first game of a month last season and were 2-0-0 this year, beating Seattle on March 15 and Philadelphia on April 2, before falling to Dallas.

David Beckham played 83 minutes in the loss to Dallas, completing an extensive week of travel for the Galaxy midfielder. On April 27, Beckham flew from Los Angeles to London in order to attend the Royal Wed-

ding on April 29. The morning after the wedding, Beckham flew from London to Dallas, arriving in the area prior to the rest of his Galaxy teammates before retuning home with the team on May 2, which was his 36th birthday. All totaled, Beckham flew a total of 11,410 miles on his journey.

Sunday's game in Dallas was just the second time this season that all three of the Galaxy's Designated Players, Juan Pablo Angel, David Beckham and Landon Donovan, each started a game. Of the three, only Donovan played the full 90 minutes with the others being removed following a one hour and six minute lightning delay in the 83rd minute. All three also started the 1-0 home win over Philadelphia on April 2.

Just three Galaxy players have appeared in all nine of the club's games this season. Todd Dunivant is the only one to start all nine while Chad Barrett and Sean Franklin have played in each.

Sunday's loss to FC Dallas snapped the Galaxy's five-game unbeaten streak, a run that saw them go 3-0-2 in the month of April. Since the start of the 2009 season, the Galaxy have had four unbeaten streaks of five games or longer, including a 12-game streak to open the 2010 season that matched LA's longest unbeaten streak to open a season ever.


