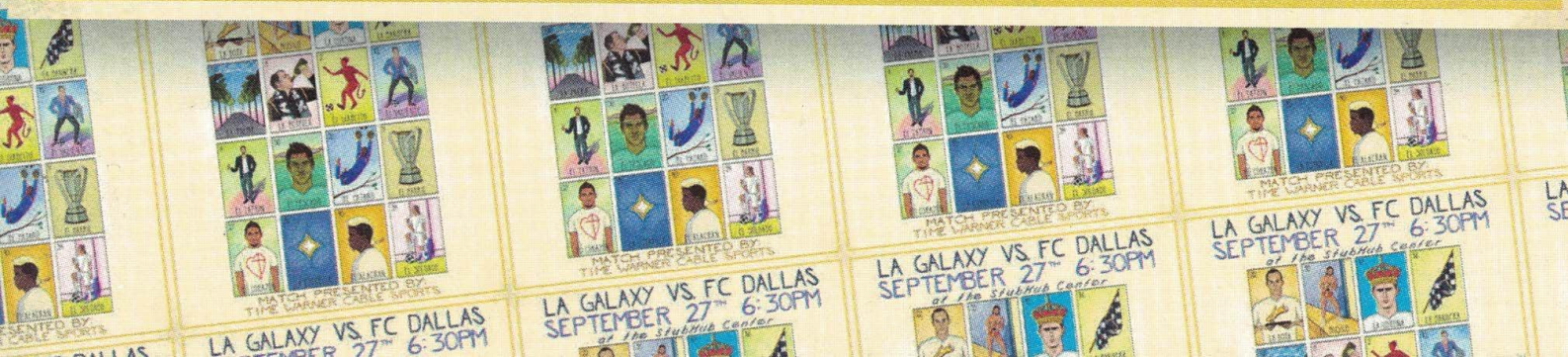

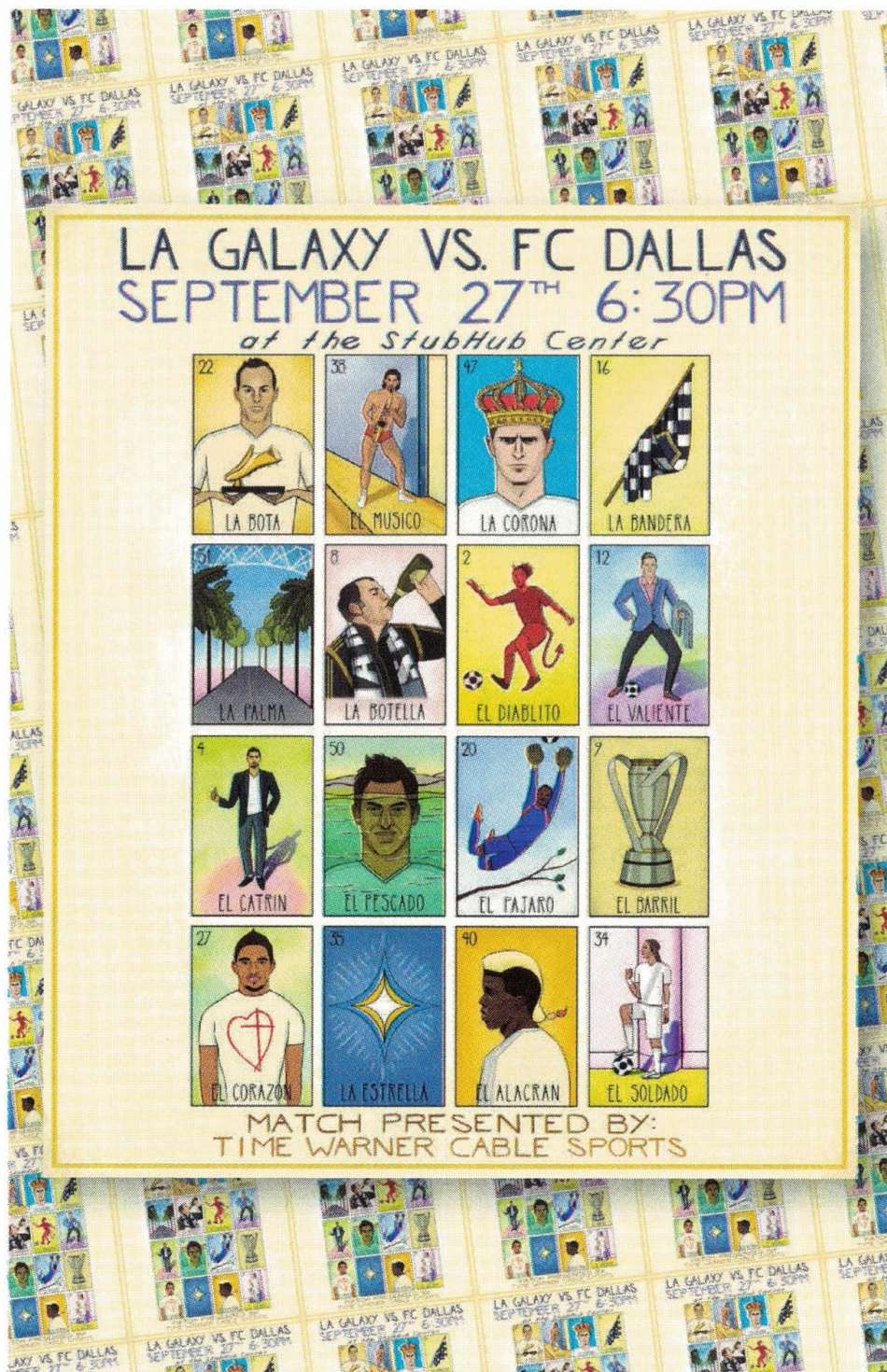

This week's match poster is designed by LA based illustrator Caitlin Kuhwald and inspired by the Mexican

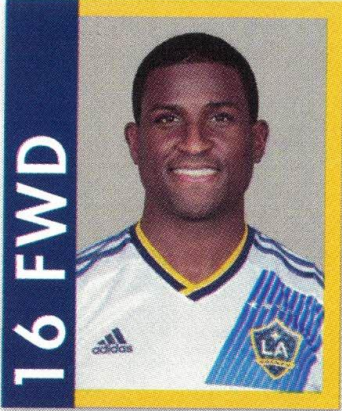
card game, Loteria.

# LA Galaxy II Tryouts Gave Javier Moran the Opportunity to Live His Dream

2015 Tryouts for Los Dos will take place in December

Javier Moran's career path was headed in a much different trajectory before the teenage midfielder from the San Fernando Valley entered the LA Galaxy II tryouts.

A star at St. Genevieve High School, where he tallied 63 goals and 25 assists in just 33 games, his numbers were certainly great, but not enough to draw attention from four-year college programs. Then, in February, the 5-foot-5 central midfielder was one of two players chosen out of more than 500 applicants to spend a week with Galaxy II during their preseason training camp.

Once Moran won the chance to train with Los Dos and found his way onto the Galaxy Academy's Under-18 squad, things changed for the teenager.

"I was initially planning to go to community college," Moran told LAGalaxy.com. "But once I won the Galaxy II tryouts and played with the Galaxy Academy, the coaches

at Cal State Northridge called my high school coaches. Then we started the process for me to attend the University."

The week training with Los Dos head coach Curt Onalfo's team was a transformative time in the 17-year-old's life, as he received his first opportunity to train with a professional setup. Immediately after his time with Galaxy II, Moran was invited to join the Galaxy U-18 team where he tallied three goals in 12 matches for the squad.

Although Moran's time with the Galaxy is complete, the midfielder will never forget his year within the club's setup.

"I was so happy that I got picked from the tryouts, especially since I was one of the youngest and smallest players. I was in awe the whole week with Galaxy II. Me and my dad (Jose Luis Moran II) call it CEthe week," Moran said. "We call it that because everyone in my family was so happy, especially my grandpa (Jose Luis Moran I), who has



always wanted someone in our family to play professionally. He cried a couple of times and so did my dad because we were just in awe."

"My time with the Academy was a very fun experience as well. They gave me my first opportunity to travel to a game, and I got the chance to see just how good some of the talent in Southern California is, while also meeting new people."

Moran is slated to join the Cal State Northridge in the spring semester after he completes one final high school class. The attacker will be eligible to play in competitive matches for the Matadors in the fall of 2016.

As he prepares to begin his college career, Moran is grateful for the opportunity that he earned by winning the Galaxy II tryout.

"It's great because it works for the Galaxy, who can

find a new player, and for the community as well," said Moran. "It gives players a chance to shine in front of Galaxy coaches and have an opportunity to live their dream."

Galaxy II will hold three tryout sessions once their USL campaign is completed: December 12-13, 2015 in Las Vegas, January 23-24, 2016 at StubHub Center, and January 30-31, 2016 at StubHub Center.

## LA Galaxy II Begin 2015 USL Playoffs

**Los Dos finished the USL regular season in fifth place, clinching their second-straight playoff berth**

**L**A Galaxy II wrapped up their 2015 USL Regular Season last weekend with a 1-0 win over Colorado Springs Switchbacks ahead the 2015 USL Playoffs, that saw the team travel north for a match at Bonney Field against in-state rival Sacramento Republic FC on Saturday.

Curt Onalfo's side finished the USL Regular Season in fifth place in Western Conference standings with a 14-11-3 record, just two points shy of first place. During the regular season, the team was led in goals by Ariel Lassiter with 11 on the season, with fellow forward Jack McBean adding an additional six goals and five assists this year.

This season, Galaxy II defeated Sacramento once in four contests played head to head during the regular season, with Los Dos earning a dominant 4-0 victory on the road at Bonney Field behind goals from Jack McBean, Ariel Lassiter, Jaime Villarreal and Andre Auras in their most recent contest.

Galaxy II begin the 2015 USL Playoffs at Bonney Field, where the team was eliminated from last year's Western Conference Championship by the eventual champions. Los Dos fell to Sacramento 3-2 last season, falling one game short of a USL Championship appearance.

The winner of Saturday's match advances to the conference semifinals for a match against Orange County Blues FC in the next round of the USL Playoffs.

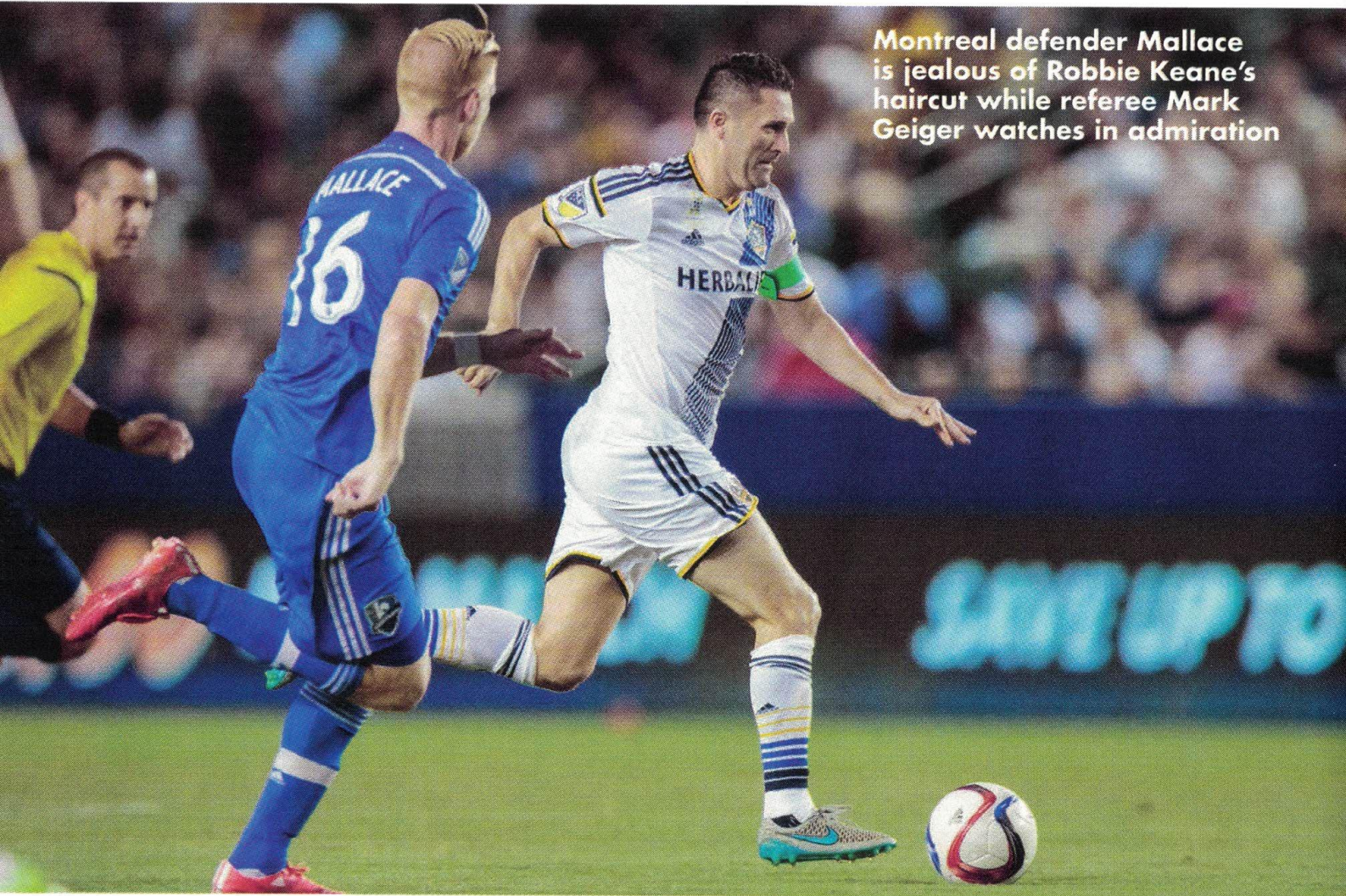
Under head coach Paul Buckle, defending USL Champions Sacramento finished in fourth place in the Western Conference with 46 points during the regular season, going 13-8-7 this year. They are led by forward Rodrigo Lopez, who has scored 10 goals and added five assists on the season.

Los Dos snapped a three-game losing streak this weekend when they earned a 1-0 win on the road at Sand Creek Stadium over Colorado Switchbacks FC behind a first-half goal from Ariel Lassiter.

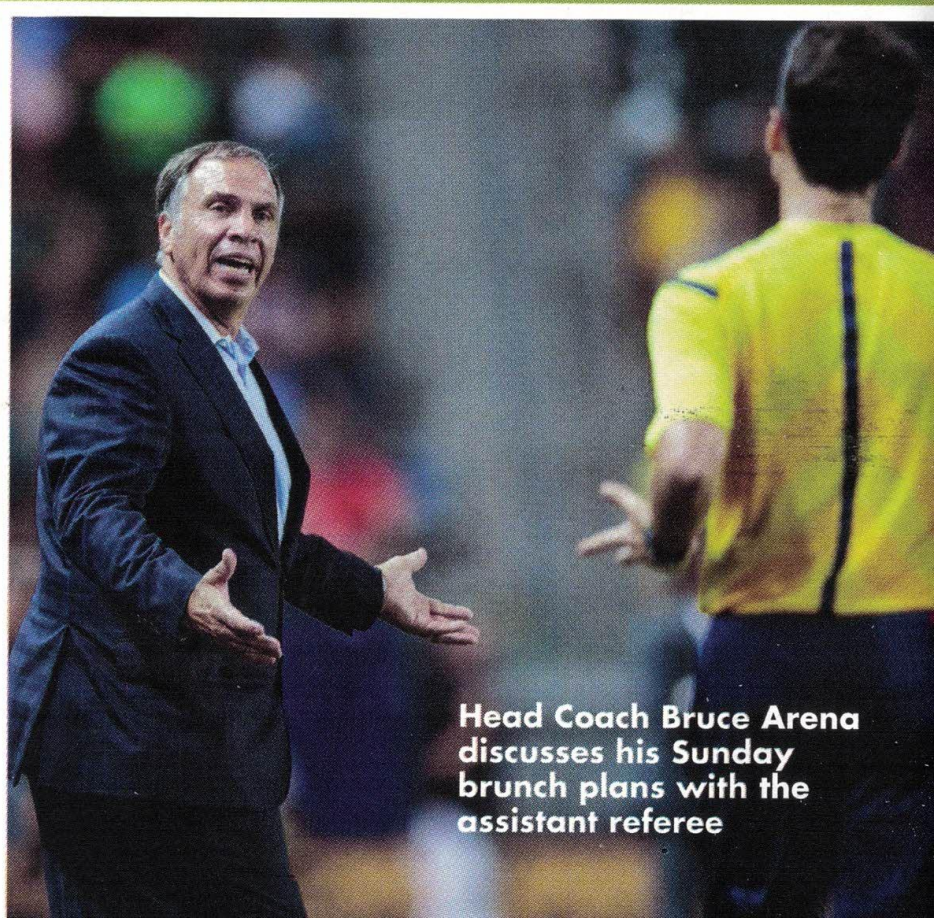

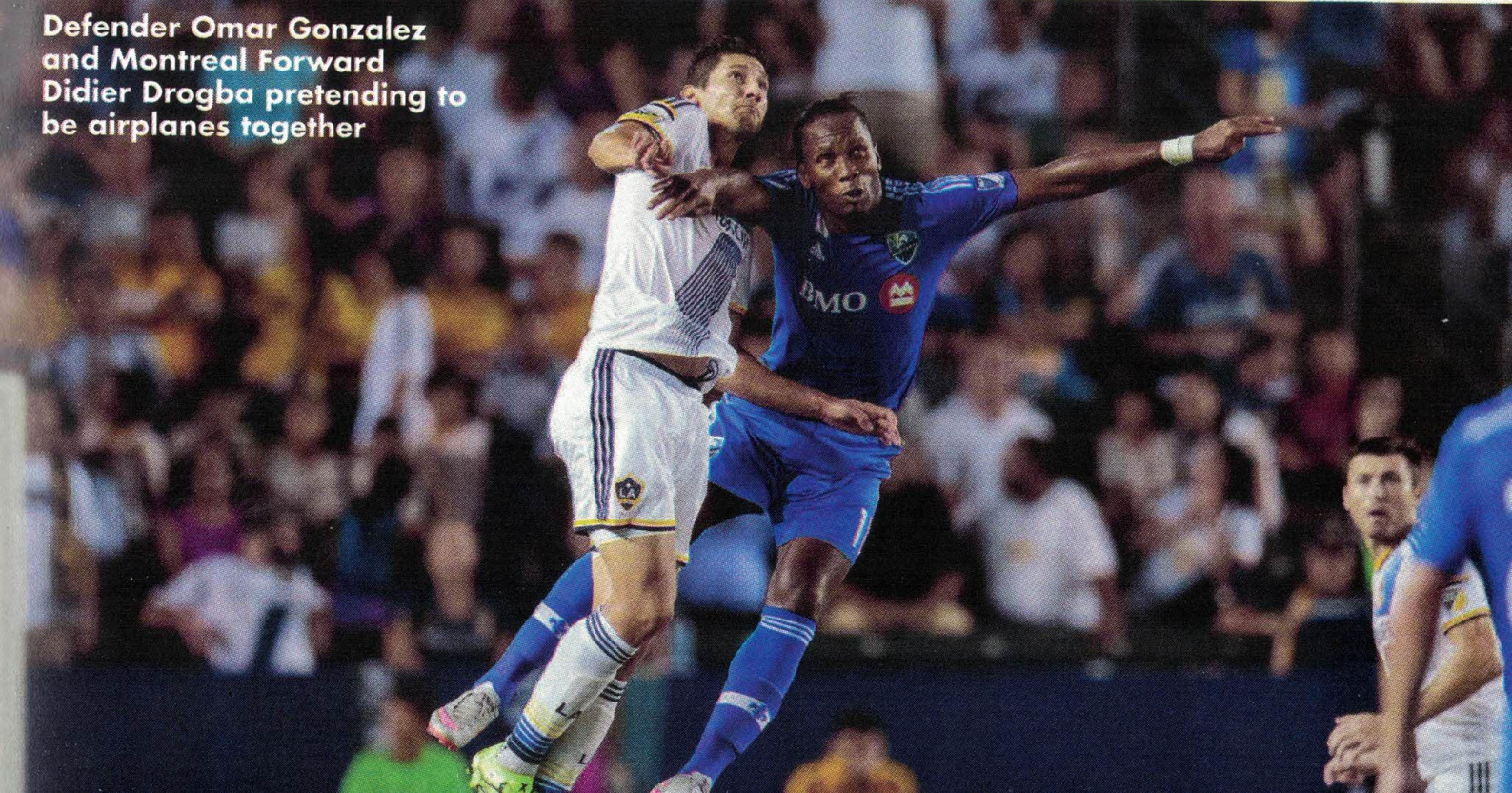

# DOUBLEHEADER: LA Galaxy Special Olympics Unified Team face FC Dallas Unified Team

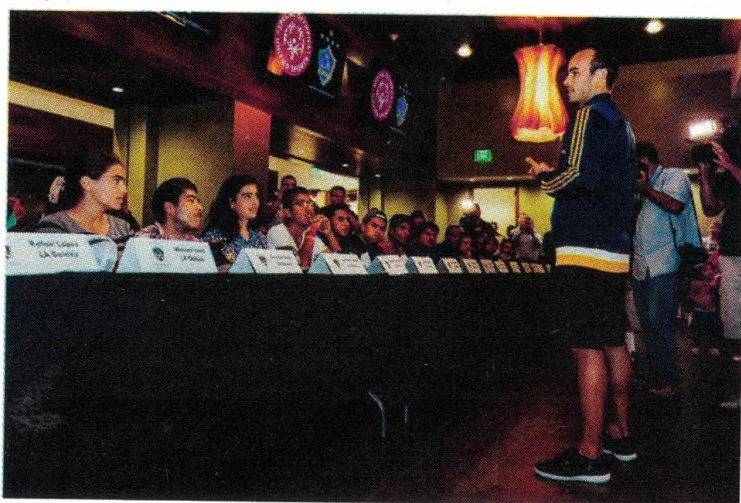
**LA Galaxy Special Olympic Unified Team will play final game of season at 8:30 p.m., immediately following the LA-Dallas game**

The LA Galaxy Special Olympics Unified Team will look to finish their inaugural season with a perfect record when they take on the FC Dallas Special Olympics Unified team Sunday at 8:30 p.m. PT, immediately following the Galaxy-Dallas MLS match.

The match is free and open to the public as all fans that attend the LA Galaxy's match against FC Dallas are encouraged to attend. In their previous matchup, the Galaxy SOCS Unified Team defeated the FC Dallas Unified team in a dramatic 3-2 comeback victory on the road at Toyota Stadium.

In their previous matchup, Carlos Arriaza's two goals earned the Galaxy the victory against their Dallas counterparts. Galaxy attacker Rafael Lopez found the back of the net for LA in the first half after goals from Zachary Parcher and Roy Bayona gave FC Dallas an early lead.

The LA Galaxy SOCS Unified Team is composed of athletes with and without intellectual disabilities from ages 14-22 to encourage teamwork, hard work and inclusion through the sport of soccer. The team will competes against

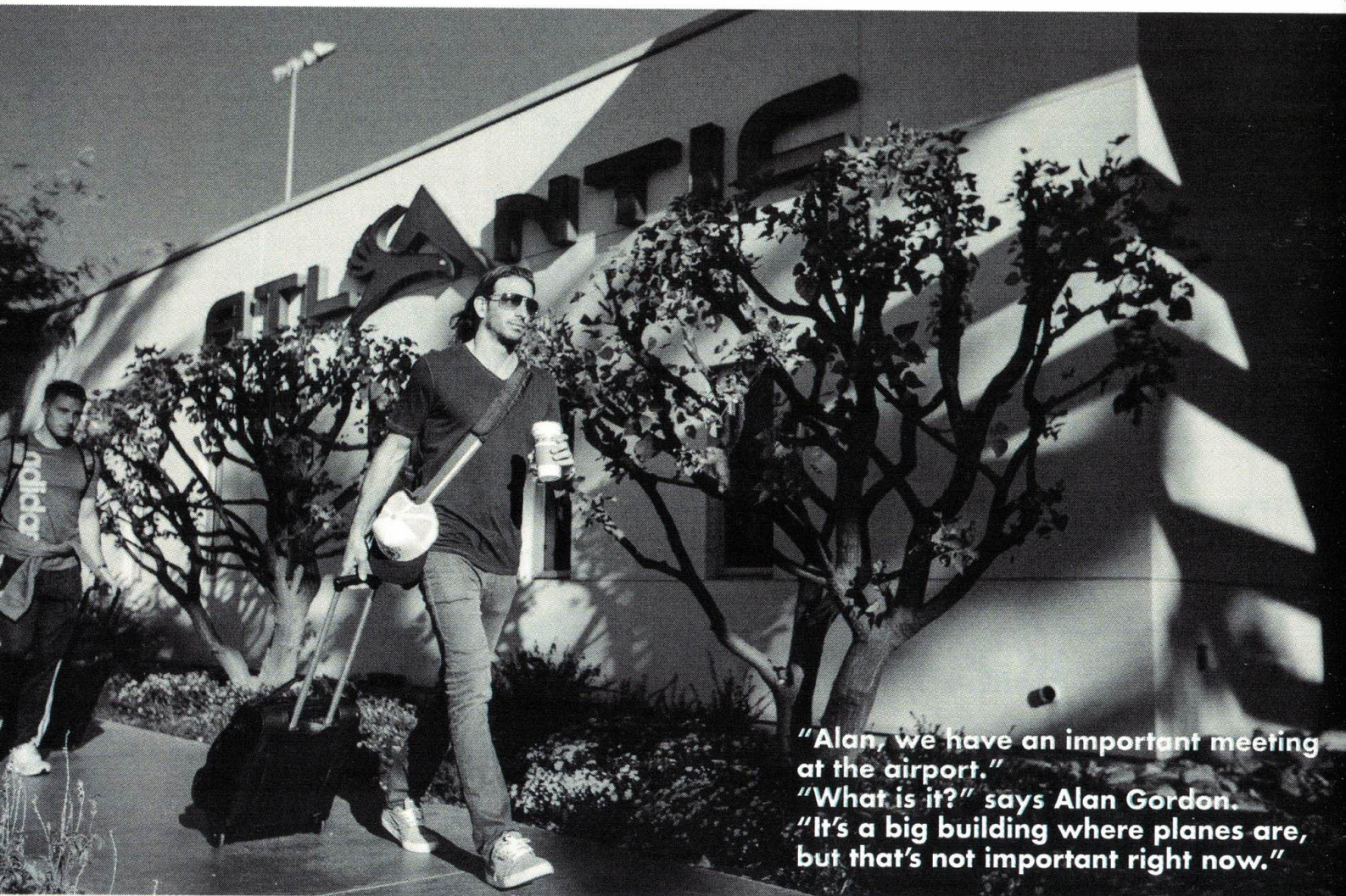

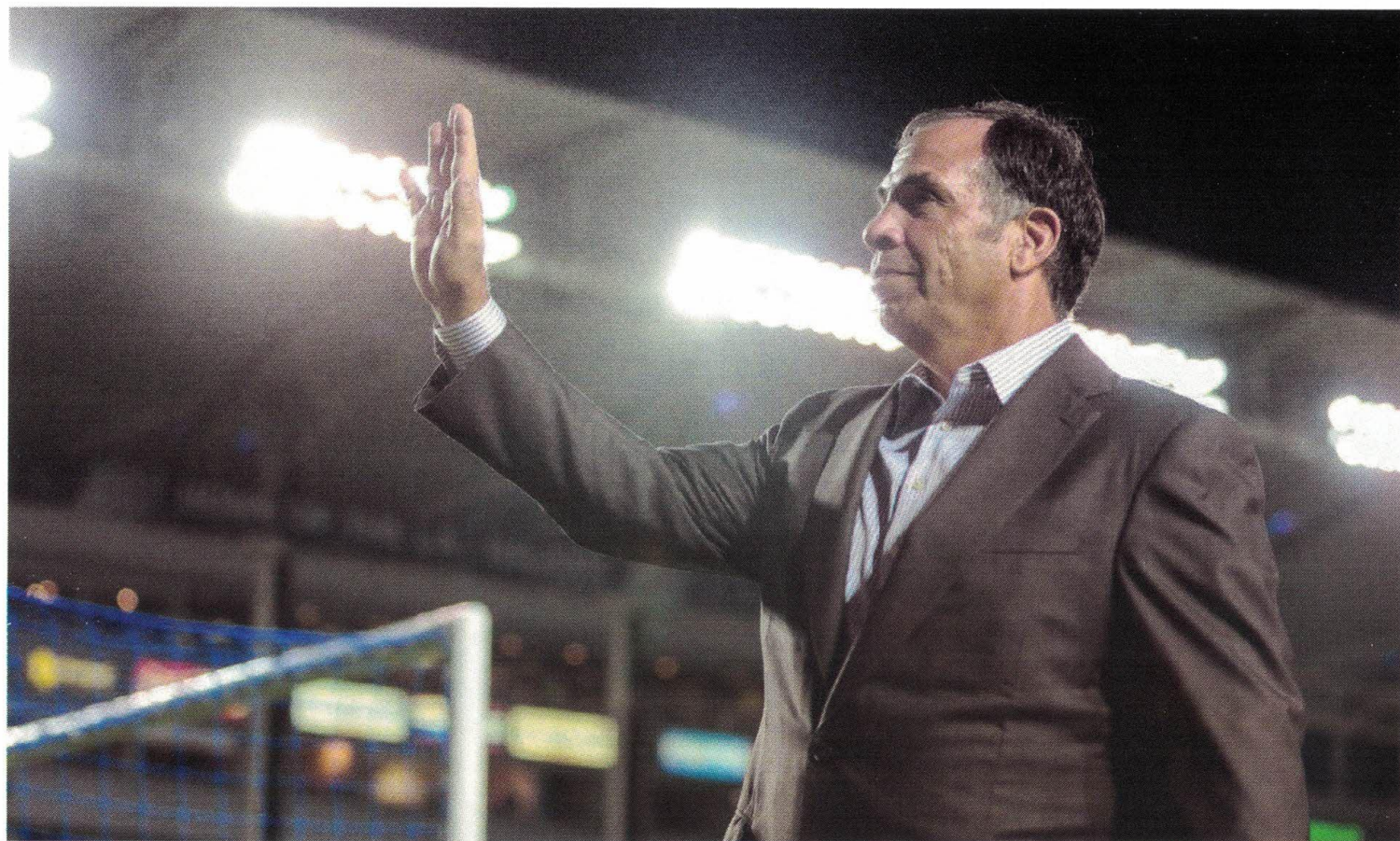

## LA Galaxy Head Coach Bruce Arena to Receive Spirit of Courage Award

Galaxy defender Robbie Rogers presented Arena with award honoring his role with LGBT athletes in professional sports

**L**A Galaxy Head Coach and General Manager Bruce Arena received the Spirit of Courage Award during the Courage Campaign Institution's Fifth Annual Spirit of Courage Awards on Thursday, Sept. 24 at Union Station in Los Angeles. The award, which recognizes those who exemplify courage in the fight for a more fair and just society, was presented to Arena by LA Galaxy defender Robbie Rogers.

Arena was honored for his role in welcoming Rogers to the LA Galaxy roster in 2013, making him the first openly gay athlete in a major professional U.S. sports league. On May 24, 2013, Rogers agreed to terms with the Galaxy

following a trade from the Chicago Fire in exchange for forward Mike Magee. Rogers made his debut for the Galaxy on May 26, 2013 in a 3-0 win over Seattle Sounders FC.

Rogers has gone on to make 43 appearances for the Galaxy since 2013, scoring one goal and recording six assists while becoming one of the top defenders in MLS. After making the move to defense full-time with a start against Chivas USA on June 8, 2014, the Galaxy have gone 23-8-12 in all MLS competitions in which Rogers appeared, including MLS Cup Playoffs and the MLS Cup Final.

Arena is one of the most successful coaches in MLS history, earning a record five MLS Cup titles during his coaching career. Bruce Arena is also 112-62-62 all time in MLS regular season games with the LA Galaxy, tied with Dominic Kinnear (Houston Dynamo) and Steve Nicol (New England Revolution) for the most wins all time with one team in MLS history. His 189 wins all time as a head coach in MLS are the second most of any coach in the league's history.
