
GALLERY: GIOVANI DOS SANTOS MAKES HIS LA GALAXY DEBUT

Giovani makes his LA Galaxy debut in the second half, entering in place of forward Alan Gordon






MVP? ROBBIE KEANE IN SCINTILLATING FORM

LA Galaxy captain now has 11 goals in his last eight MLS games


In his 100th regular season appearance, it was only fitting that Robbie Keane was the hero for the LA Galaxy. Again.

As he has repeatedly done during his career in MLS, Keane willed the Galaxy to victory last weekend with his brace in front of a capacity crowd at Toyota Stadium. The Irishman has now tallied a remarkable 66 goals and 40 assists in his 100 regular season appearances. His goal total is tied for the second highest of any MLS player after 100 games.

Despite leading his team to their second straight

road victory—and fourth straight win in all competitions—there was no celebration from Keane after the match. There was simply a calm satisfaction for a job well done.

"Listen, I always want to win. I always want to win and I always want to better myself every year," said Keane after scoring in his third straight match. "This year, might be a bit difficult because I was out for a little bit but if you look at goals per game and assists per game, it's up with the best years that I've had. ... If I can help the team do well and continue to score goals then everyone's a winner."



After the Galaxy went into the halftime frustrated with conceding a first-half goal from FC Dallas' Michael Barrios, it was the captain who came to the rescue. LA equalized in the 51st minute when Robbie Rogers found Keane unmarked in the penalty area for an easy header past Dallas' Dan Kennedy.

Keane completed LA's comeback just five minutes later when Giovanni dos Santos skirted past Dallas' defense and saw his attempt at goal deflect off a defender and back into his path. With the goalkeeper beaten, Dos Santos chipped the ball to an unmarked Keane who easily placed it into the back of the net to seal LA's first win in Frisco since the 2012 campaign.

"Going behind is always difficult, always chasing the game, but thankfully we had the break that came at a good time," Keane said. "We regrouped and got ourselves together and in the second half you saw a certainly different Galaxy team in the way we played, got the ball down quickly into feet. Into Stevie's feet, Gio's feet, my feet, and we caused problems getting that first goal back. If you look at the confidence in this team, we looked like

we were going to go win the game."


Added Sebastian Lletget, "[Keane]'s positioning is great. He's shown that through the years and he showed that again tonight. ... He is a great captain in all aspects. When you're down, he picks you back up and when you're up, he gives you confidence. He did that tonight again."

With the Dallas victory in the books, Keane finds himself in scintillating form as the Galaxy head down in the stretch run. In total, Keane has tallied 13 goals this season with a whopping 11 of them coming in LA's last eight games.

Although plenty will glance at these stats and think of a potential MLS MVP repeat, Keane is quick to shrug off such talk.


"I've been scoring goals and assisting since I've been in the league. Nothing has really changed this year apart from me feeling very good and very, very fit," Keane said. "Long may it continue."



LA GALAXY SPECIAL OLYMPICS UNIFIED TEAM EARN DRAMATIC 3-2 COMEBACK VICTORY OVER FC DALLAS

Galaxy Special Olympics Unified Team to play next at StubHub Center on September 26

Two second-half goals from Carlos Arriaza gave the LA Galaxy Special Olympics Unified Team a dramatic 3-2 comeback victory over FC Dallas at Toyota Stadium on last Saturday.

Arriaza's two goals earned the Galaxy the victory in their first of two matches against their Dallas counterparts scheduled for this year. Galaxy attacker Rafael Lopez found the back of the net for LA in the first half after goals from Zachary Parcher and Roy Bayona gave FC Dallas an early lead.

"It felt great to win," said Gabriela Fontanesi to LAGalaxy.com following the victory. "It was amazing to play in this big stadium and in front of so many fans. It was an incredible experience."

Like the first team who played immediately prior to the match, the Galaxy SOSC Unified Team went into the break behind.

Dallas struck in quick succession as tallies by Parcher in the seventh minute and Bayona in the 19th minute put the home side ahead. The Galaxy began their rally late in the second half when Lopez beat the Dallas 'keeper for LA's

first of the evening.

Just as Robbie Keane did in the first team match hours earlier, Arriaza took over the game when his team needed him most.

The 22-year-old Galaxy SOSC captain, in his final year of eligibility for Special Olympics Unified sports, pulled his team level in the 45th minute with a curling effort that sailed into the Dallas net. Two minutes later, Arriaza put the Galaxy ahead for good with a blistering rocket into the corner of the net for the game-winner.

"We worked hard. My team and I deserved a win so I worked really hard to get two goals. I did it not just for myself but for my team as well," Arriaza told LAGalaxy.com afterward. "We really wanted it. We couldn't stay behind. We had to catch up and we did. It was a great feeling to win."

The two teams will meet again on Sept. 26 on the main field at StubHub Center.
