

features beloved Galaxy mascot Cozmo in his home turf of space (Cozmo lives in outer space when he is not at LA Galaxy games).




# GALLERY: LA Galaxy vs. Columbus Crew SC


heck out a photo gallery of the LA Galaxy's last match at StubHub Center, a 2-0 win over the Eastern Conference Columbus Crew SC. Late in the match, with the score tied 0-0, midfielder Baggio Husidic launched a long-distance rocket to put LA ahead. Giovani dos Santos then doubled the lead for LA with a chip over the Columbus goalkeeper. The win snapped a six-game winless streak for the Galaxy heading into the final stretch of the regular season.



















I am very happy to announce that I have decided to rejoin my hometown team the LA Galaxy for the remainder of the MLS season. While this decision may come as a shock to many, I want to explain how and why it was made.

Two weeks ago, I was working as an analyst on the LA Galaxy vs. Vancouver Whitecaps match and during that game, the Galaxy suffered injuries to three players: Jelle Van Damme, Steven Gerrard and Gyasi Zardes. Over the next few days, Nigel De Jong was transferred to Galatasaray and news broke that Gyasi would be out for the rest of the season. Since my retirement, I have remained in close contact with many of the staff and players on the Galaxy. I spoke with some of them that week and they jokingly asked if I was ready to make a return to the field to help fill some of the void left by the injuries and departures. I reminded them that I haven't played a meaningful soccer game in almost two years and I certainly couldn't fill the holes left by those players.

Over the ensuing days, I began to think about their inquiries and it struck me that perhaps this is something I should consider. I care so deeply about the Galaxy organization, and I believe I could help in a small way to aid the team in its quest for a 6th MLS championship. Further, the opportunity to have my son Talon on the field with me after a game was a feeling that I

would never be able to replicate.

I then had a candid conversation with Bruce Arena and we began down the path of deciding whether this made sense. We both agreed that if this was going to happen, the expectations would be minimal and he would use me in situations that made sense for the team. I've spent a lot of time speaking

with my family and close friends over the past several days, and we all agreed that this would be a wonderful opportunity and a win-win situation for everyone.


I know this won't be received well by everyone. That's ok. I've always made decisions in life based on two guiding principles: my own happiness and the happiness of those I love and care about. Being on the field again, being able to help an organization that has meant so much to me and having my son in my arms after a game will undoubtedly make me and all my loved ones happy. That's all that matters.

To my fans:

I thank you all for your unwavering support. I can't tell you how much I appreciate each and every one of you. I've been fortunate to lead an incredible life, and I can't wait to be on the field again and hear your cheers. Also, as all you parents know, having a child is truly a life-changing experience. Nothing would make me happier than standing on the field with Talon and the rest of my family celebrating the Galaxy's 6th championship on December 10th. I will do everything in my power to make that happen, and I hope we are all there celebrating together!







A Galaxy II returned to StubHub Center this weekend after a brutal stretch of scheduling that saw them play five consecutive games on the road. In that stretch, Los Dos went 1-3-1 but were able to maintain good standing for inclusion in the 2016 USL Playoffs. Ahead of the weekend, Los Dos sat in sixth place with 39 points and a 10-7-9 record, four points clear of eighth place, the final playoff spot.

After Los Dos' game last night against Sacramento Republic FC, the team has two home games remaining on the season: Wednesday, Sept. 14 against Rio Grande Valley FC and Saturday, Sept. 24 vs. Real Monarchs SLC.

With just two home games remaining on the USL Regular Season schedule, LA Galaxy II has put together the Endless Soccer Ticket Package. Fans who purchase the package will receive four tickets to either LA Galaxy II match, four LA Galaxy coolers and four coupons for free soda from Shasta Beverages. In other LA Galaxy II news, Jefrey Payeras went 90 minutes for Guatemala in their World Cup Qualifying matches against Trinidad and Tobago and St. Vincent and the Grenadines. The team drew 2-2 with Trinidad and Tobago and handily defeated St. Vincent and the Grenadines 9-3 behind five goals from former LA Galaxy star Carlos Ruiz. The two caps were Payeras' second and third appearances for the Guatemalan National team in his career. He debuted for Guatemala in a friendly against Panama on Aug. 10, 2016.

# Bruce Arena wins 200<sup>th</sup> career MLS game

A Galaxy players presented head coach Bruce Arena with a signed ball in celebration of Arena's 200th career MLS victory on Saturday night against the Columbus Crew.

Arena, however, had one minor complaint about the gesture.

"I told them I wish this could have been done about a month ago," he said with a straight face.

The 64-year-old Arena became the second coach in league history (Sigi Schmid is the other) to achieve 200 career victories, but he has had little if any time to reflect on the achievement with his team in the thick of an MLS Cup playoff race.

He probably wouldn't do so, anyway.

"He won't even acknowledge it," said Dave Sarachan, his longtime assistant and associate head coach. "But at some point in his lifetime when he finishes and can sort of step away and look at it from a different perspective, I think he might recognize and appreciate how hard it is to do what he's done and to do it for this long."


Those who work with him and play for him were quick to realize the magnitude of the occasion. Midfielder Jeff Larentowicz, in his 12th season and first with the Galaxy, said he was "happy to be a part of it." Sarachan said it was a remarkable accomplishment.

"When you look at coaches that are successful, a lot of times their record is .500," he said. "It's a hard league to win.

"When you look at 200, that's a pretty impressive number."

Arena's son Kenny, now a member of his father's Galaxy coaching staff, remembers when his dad earned career win No. 200 at the University of Virginia and, in keeping with a school tradition, received 200 pennies from the athletic department. Kenny Arena said he would have duplicated the gesture on Saturday but he was unable to get to a bank for some rolls of coins.





The younger Arena said the win over the Crew was a special moment but one he expected to happen much sooner. The Galaxy, however, went on a sixgame winless streak (0-1-5) before the 2-1 decision over Columbus.

Kenny Arena was asked to talk about some of the characteristics that have made his father so successful at his profession.


"He's just a combination of a lot of things and he does them all really well," he said. "I could name a lot of things, and especially now that I work with him I see all of them.

"He's also very strong mentally and he's able to carry the burden of a big club that demands winning and has big personalities. You could make a list of over 100 things that he is really good at. He has the ability to handle huge responsibilities, and that's why he's been able to be successful at every level as the magnitude gets bigger."

Arena said he hoped his father's achievement was an affirmation of his standing in the sport.

"It's another great accomplishment for him and obviously solidifies his career," he said. "Hopefully it's a little reminder that people can't take for granted great coaches, great players, anything. Sometimes after a while people forget how really good someone is.

"I think this is just a little reminder for everybody just how special his career has been."

# A.J. DeLaGarza caps off emotional week with his 200th career appearance | INSIDER

ARSON, Calif. – It was an emotional weekend for LA Galaxy defender A.J. DeLaGarza.


DeLaGarza captained the LA Galaxy in his 200th career appearance for the club in their 2-1 victory over Columbus Crew SC on Saturday. The appearance made DeLaGarza one of only five players to play 200 or more games for the Galaxy, joining club legends Cobi Jones, Landon Donovan, Kevin Hartman, and Mauricio Cienfuegos.

"It means I've been here a long time. It's an honor to be at the same club for a long time and to be at a club so established as the Galaxy who are the best franchise in MLS," DeLaGarza said on Monday. "It's an incredible feat. I can be proud of that, and I now look forward to appearance 201, 202, and keep it going as long as I can."

What made DelaGarza's achievement even more meaningful was the fact that it occurred on the weekend of the two-year anniversary of the passing of his son Luca due to complications of Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome. To honor his late son, DelaGarza wore a black armband with the name LUCA inscribed in bright stitching.

After a week of tributes celebrating Luca's birth, DeLaGarza was ecstatic to cap off his emotional week with an accomplishment on the field.

"I would have liked for it to happen last week, but it's good," DeLaGarza said with a grin. "It was a special week in my life and to cap it off with being captain, my 200th game, and most importantly, a win was big. Going into September, we need to start going on a roll."
