the beating heart of StubHub Center's raucous crowds.

If you have any doubts about this, then one of the group's most iconic songs should clear up any confusion.

"Blue, White and Gold.

The color that my blood shall always flow.

I sing for you, and only you.

Where ever I may be I sing for you."

Founded in 2007 by six members hungry for a new type of supporters group, the ACB have grown their membership to more than a thousand die-hards who pack StubHub Center's section 121 for each Galaxy home match. Their every action is designed to will the team and the crowd forward from their elaborate tifos and banners to the songs that pledge their undying loyalty to the club that they love.

"This means everything to us. Supporting my team is hard to explain in words because I have such an immense love for this team which represents this city," said Angel City Brigade capo John Arias. "This is the city that I was born in, the city that I was raised in, and the city that I love. ACB is Los Angeles because we're everywhere in Los Angeles.

"We're not just the South Bay or the San Fernando Valley. We're everywhere from all the way in the Inland Empire to Orange County. We are Southern California. We are LA. ACB is about bringing together a bunch of people from all corners into this stadium to support this team which represents our city."

What differentiates ACB from their counterparts from other groups is their style of support that encourages members to stand and sing for 90 minutes. Employing Latin American flair reminiscent of Barras in Mexico, El Salvador and Argentina, the ACB also borrow elements from European supporters groups to create a style that is uniquely Los Angeles.

At the group's core, the Latin influence is essential as they seek to identify with people from all walks of life in the City of Angels.

"From the beginning, the Galaxy have been embraced by Latinos. That's representative in ACB because we have members who have been around since the team was founded," said ACB member Roberto Mora. "The current makeup of ACB is a culmination of the last 20 or so years of soccer fans in Los Angeles.

"You have your fans in the suites rolling up in BMWs, but you also have the fans in General Admission who take the bus to games. The Galaxy fan fully embraces what Los Angeles is, and that is incredibly diverse."

The life of a supporter can be a demanding one with members spending long hours crafting elaborate displays,





scraping together money to pay for away trips or missing out on time with family so that they can watch their team take field no matter the locale.

"Everyone in ACB has their day job, everyone has their lives that they live, but at the end of the day, we come to the stadium and represent Los Angeles," said Arias. "No matter where we're from, we're all Los Angeles."

No player may be closer to the supporters group than fifth-year Galaxy midfielder Rafael Garcia.

Whether it's saluting the group after a match, taking pictures with members or interacting on social media, Garcia's respect for the organization has been obvious throughout his time with the club.

Garcia's connection with the ACB runs deep because the Galaxy midfielder sees himself in the faces of every singing supporter.

"I draw myself toward them because it's a local group that supports this team and they represent our community. They've done a fantastic job, and it's an honor to play in front of a group like that who is devoted to our team," Garcia said. "A 1000 percent, if I weren't playing, I'd be there with them. I grew up supporting the Galaxy since 1996 and the supporters groups weren't as numerous as they are now. I'd say that I'd definitely be a supporter if I weren't playing, and why not be a member of ACB."

At the end of the day, the way the Galaxy represent the city of Los Angeles is what's important to Arias and the Angel City Brigade.

"The Galaxy have been here since 1996," Arias said. "They represent what Los Angeles is, and that's a huge metropolis of people that live from the Valley to the South Bay and everything in between and beyond. People can talk all they want, but the Galaxy represent all of Los Angeles. Just like the ACB, we represent Los Angeles. That's why the Galaxy is the only Los Angeles club." A Galaxy II has started out the USL season with a 6-2-8 record for 23 points, placing them in second place in the USL Western Conference. With 31 goals on the season prior to Saturday's match against the OC Blues, Los Dos led all USL teams in goals scored.

Last Friday, LA Galaxy II earned a 2-0 win over Tulsa Roughnecks FC in the team's first home win since May 4. A goal from Adonis Amaya and a successfully taken penalty kick from Alejandro Covarrubias gave *Los Dos* all three points. LA Galaxy II are now 5-1-4 at StubHub Center on the season.

This Saturday, Los Dos will face off with the OC Blues in the two sides' second meeting of the 2016 season. Back on April 8, the two teams tied 1-1 at StubHub Center.

With the win, Los Dos moved into second place in the USL Western Conference standings, three points behind Vancouver Whitecaps FC 2 (8-2-5, 29 points).

In other LA Galaxy II news, forward Jack McBean was signed to LA Galaxy from Los Dos on June 22. McBean, LA Galaxy II's captain, led the USL in goals (12) before being awarded with a first team contract. That same day, McBean started in the team's 0-0 home draw with Colorado Rapids. McBean also started in the

Galaxy's 1-0 U.S. Open Cup win over Portland on the road Wednesday.



LA Galaxy sign 20 local players to form 2016 LA Galaxy Special Olympics Southern California (SOSC) Unified Soccer Team

ast week, the LA Galaxy announced the signing of 20 new players. These 20 players make up the 2016 LA Galaxy Southern California Special Olympics (SOSC) Unified Soccer Team that will compete against other MLS-affiliated Special Olympics Unified Teams during the year.

"We are thrilled to add 20 of the most talented players in the country to represent the Galaxy's Southern California Special Olympics Unified Team," said Head Coach and General Manager Bruce Arena. "We think this is a dynamic group both on and off the field that will represent our club as the premier soccer team in North America. We are confident this team will find success through their hard work, dedication and teamwork."

A link to each new signings' bio can be found on www.lagalaxy.com/unified/roster. All 20 players were on hand for a special ceremony at StubHub Center's Champions Lounge to announce their signed profes-

sional contracts with LA Galaxy coach Bruce Arena. LA Galaxy midfielder Steven Gerrard also attended the singing and presented each player with their new LA Galaxy jersey and offered support to the new signings ahead of the team's upcoming season. "I came to the biggest club in MLS for the opportunity to play alongside world-class players like these," said LA Galaxy midfielder Steven Gerrard. "These signings are yet another indication of the Galaxy's ambition to compete for championships year in and year out. I am honored to call them my teammates."

The LA Galaxy SOSC Unified Soccer Team Exchange program is a partnership between the LA Galaxy and Special Olympics Southern California that brings individuals with and without intellectual disabilities, ages 16-25,

together as teammates to participate in unique training, competition and social experiences.

The players signed will attend regular practices starting this month at StubHub Center. The team will face off against the Seattle Sounders FC Unified Soccer team on Saturday, July 9, at CenturyLink Field in conjunction with the first team match that weekend.

Following an open tryout, players for this Special Olympics team were selected based on 3 key factors: (1) their ability to work with and value teammates of all abilities, (2) their commitment to the Play Unified experience and to their fellow teammates, and lastly (3) their understanding of the game and rules of soccer. 

ole, who joined the Galaxy this offseason, began his professional career when he signed with Arsenal in 1998. He went on to make 228 total appearances, winning two Premier League Titles and three FA Cups for the North London side. Cole also featured for Arsenal's 2003-04 squad that went undefeated in league play. The defender transferred to Chelsea in 2006 and became one of the club's most accomplished defenders, making 229 appearances and winning two Premier League titles, one UEFA Champions League trophy and four FA Cups. In addition to his club career, Cole has featured extensively for the English National Team, making World Cup appearances in 2002, 2006, and 2010. The fullback also featured for England in UEFA Euro 2004 and 2012. In all, Cole made over 100 appearances for his country, making him the most capped fullback in English history.

he LA Galaxy have unveiled the commemorative match poster for the team's match tonight against Vancouver Whitecaps FC at StubHub Center.


This is the third season of the Galaxy's commemorative match poster series, an initiative in which the Galaxy work with local, national and international artists to design unique posters for each home match, with a limited supply available to benefit the LA Galaxy Foundation.

The 4th of July poster, designed by artist Jacob Sanders, plays off of Mount Rushmore National Memorial, a granite batholith formation in the Black Hills in Keystone, South Dakota. Sculpted by Gutzon Borglum and Lincoln Borglum, Mount Rushmore features 60-foot sculptures of the heads of four United States presidents: George

Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln. In Sanders' illustration, the four heads feature LA Galaxy Head Coach Bruce Arena, Landon Donovan, Gyasi Zardes and Cobi Jones. In 2015, Sanders created the LA Galaxy commemorative White House poster, The LA Galaxy Crossing the Delaware.

All of the proceeds from poster sales will go to the LA Galaxy Foundation. All commemorative match posters for the 2016 season will be available for purchase at www.lagalaxy.com/posters.


