# LA Galaxy sign Zlatan Ibrahimović

ast week, the LA Galaxy announced that forward Zlatan Ibrahimović was signed to the club. The Swedish striker joins the five-time MLS Cup champions after a decorated career internationally and throughout Europe, where he has starred for Ajax Amsterdam, Juventus, Inter Milan, Barcelona, AC Milan, Paris Saint-Germain, Manchester United and his native Sweden while accumulating over 450 goals for club and country.

"Coming to play in the United States, it is only fitting for me to join the most successful team in Major League Soccer, the LA Galaxy," said Ibrahimović. "I am excited to join a club with a winning legacy that has embodied soccer in Los Angeles for over 20 years. I would like to thank everyone at the club for making it possible to play for the LA Galaxy. I am looking forward to joining my teammates, playing at StubHub Center in front of our fans and helping our team compete this season."

Throughout his career, Ibrahimović has won 11 league titles in four separate countries while representing Barcelona, Paris Saint-Germain, Manchester United, Ajax Amsterdam, AC Milan and Inter Milan in addition to leading his clubs to numerous other major championships, including the UEFA Europa League, FIFA Club World Cup, UEFA Super Cup, Italian Super Cup (3x), French League Cup (3x), French Super Cup (3x), a Dutch Super Cup and Dutch Cup, among others.

Overall, Ibrahimović has scored 421 goals for club, 62 goals for the Sweden National Team and tallied 159 assists in 730 club games.

"Adding one of the finest goal scorers in this sport's history to our roster will tremendously help our club in the hunt for a sixth MLS Cup," said LA Galaxy Head Coach Sigi Schmid. "As one of the winningest players of all time, we believe he'll have a very positive impact on our team. We are confident that Zlatan can be one of the most dangerous strikers in our league and we are excited to integrate him into our club."

Ibrahimović began his career with his hometown club, Malmö FF of Sweden, making his professional debut in 1999 at the age of 17. After helping Malmö earn promotion to the Swedish first division the following season, he was signed by Ajax for a club record transfer fee. In three campaigns with Ajax, Ibrahimović garnered further European recognition as he helped the Dutch side to two Eredivisie titles while shining in two UEFA Champions League campaigns. Sold to Juventus in August 2004, Ibrahimović scored 16 goals in his first season with the Bianconeri. The following year, Ibrahimović earned his first of 11 consecutive Guldbollen Awards, an annual prize recognizing Sweden's best male soccer player.

"The LA Galaxy are a club that have always attracted the biggest names and the most talented players

in the world," said AEG President and CEO Dan Beckerman. "Zlatan's signing is evidence of AEG's and LA Galaxy's persistent, global pursuit of top athletes that lift the profile of our club, our league and our sport in this country. As the most successful club in Major League Soccer history, the LA Galaxy are the perfect fit for one of the most decorated soccer players in the sport's history."

Ibrahimović made the move to FC Internazionale in 2006 and began his successful stint at the club by being named Serie A Player of the Year in his first season. In three seasons, he totaled 66 goals in 117 appearances and capped his three-year stay at Inter with 25 goals to claim Italy's 2008-09 scoring title. He lifted the league title in each year with Inter. Ibrahimović made the move to Barcelona in 2009, scoring 22 goals across all competitions and collecting a La Liga title in his one season there. He returned to Italy in August 2010 with AC Milan, reinstating himself as one of the league's most dominant scorers. He helped Milan to the Serie A title in his first year and followed suit with another Italian scoring title in the 2011-12 campaign.

"Signing Zlatan is a testament to the LA Galaxy brand and our incomparable success in MLS since 1996," said LA Galaxy President Chris Klein. "In addition to our rich history, we continue to invest in building a future that will see us continue to reach

new achievements. We aggressively pursued Zlatan and are extremely pleased to add him to our team."

In what would be his longest stay with a European side, Ibrahimović made the move to France in 2012, signing with Paris Saint-Germain in July of that year. Ibrahimović lifted the club to European prominence in his time there, winning the league title in each of his four seasons in Paris in addition to nine other major trophies. He won the Ligue 1 scoring title in three of his four seasons with PSG, highlighted by his final campaign with the club, in which he scored 38 goals in 31 league appearances. In July 2016, Ibrahimović was signed by English giants Manchester United, scoring 17 goals in 28 league appearances during the 2016-17 campaign and helping the team to a UEFA Europa League Championship just last year.

In 2001, Ibrahimović debuted with the Swedish National Team at the age of 19 and has since earned recognition as the best soccer player in the country's history. An 11-time Guldbollen winner, Ibrahimović recorded 62 goals in 114 appearances for his country. He appeared for Sweden in multiple World Cups (2002, 2006) and UEFA European Championships (2004, 2008, 2012, 2016). In 2013, Ibrahimović won FIFA's Puskás Award. Ibrahimović retired from international soccer as the nation's all-time leading goalscorer following Sweden's exit in the 2016 UEFA European Championships.





# How LA Galaxy signed Zlatan Ibrahimović

# Last week, after a courtship that lasted three years, the LA Galaxy got their man.

os Angeles announced the signing of Zlatan Ibrahimović last Friday, who joins the Galaxy through the usage of Targeted Allocation Money. During the process, the Galaxy's front office and partner company AEG were omnipresent in the recruitment, but perhaps no one was as instrumental as the team's Technical Director, Jovan Kirovski.

The Galaxy's technical director was integral in the signing of Ibrahimović, relating to him through their shared experiences playing for top clubs across Europe.

"They see that I played in Europe at big clubs, forget the Champions League. They see that I was at Manchester United. They know that I understand what they're going through, what they've been through, and what they're going to because I played for the Galaxy too. That's massive for me. I tell them the truth, the pros and cons of everything. In the end, selling what the Galaxy is, who we are, and AEG... that's the biggest thing."

The communication began during Ibrahimović's final days at Paris St. Germain in 2016 through a chance meeting between the Swede, his agent, and club president, Chris Klein. Any interest on the part of either side was ultimately unfeasible, however, as the Galaxy's

roster already contained three Designated Players.

A little under a year later, Ibrahimović and his family visited StubHub Center with Kirovski serving as the tour guide, showing them the stadium. The trip culminated with a dinner between the Galaxy's technical director, Ibrahimović and club legend David Beckham at a swanky Beverly Hills restaurant.

As Ibrahimović traded Paris for Manchester United, Kirovski, an ex-United academy player, remained engaged and kept the relationship going with constant communication.

"Whether we did this deal or not, this is a threeyear project where we stayed engaged. We kept our relationships and we maintained them so that we had an option whether we wanted the player or not. In the end, we did and we're taking it."

During the early part of 2017, the interest intensified with the Galaxy looking to bring the forward in as a Designated Player. However, the move was scuttled after Ibrahimović suffered a major knee injury.

"During this time, I was constantly in contact with him, just staying engaged whether by phone or in person," Kirovski. "Nobody believed it would happen, but then all of the sudden things got real.

"It's not easy to sign a contract, but now, we finally



got it over the finish line."

The Ibrahimović signing is the latest capture for Kirovski who was instrumental in bringing Giovani dos Santos, Romain Alessandrini, and Jonathan dos Santos to the club. After the conclusion of Kirovski's playing career, the Escondido native joined Bruce Arena's coaching staff as an assistant coach, but after one year on the staff, was hired as Technical Director.

In the early part of his tenure as Technical Director, Kirovski was instrumental in the foundation of the team's USL affiliate LA Galaxy II. After that job was done, Klein found a different way to utilize Kirovski's impressive resume by tasking him with helping recruit the team's newest talent.

"Everyone has a unique skill set and you see that throughout our soccer operations group and coaching staff. I think one of the things that helps Jovan is that he's has played at a high level in Europe and understands what is important to some of these players—whether it be Ibra or David or Robbie or Gio— that have played there."

For Kirovski, his success isn't simply about the relationships or his resume, but the vast network of players, coaches, agents, and technical staff members from across the globe who help him bring players to StubHub Center.

"My job is constant— like the stock market, I have to know value of how much people pay— Sweden, France. I know what he can make in MLS, China, Germany. I know that and I am up-to-date with the market. You have to know the world markets in terms of how much people earn and the values of certain players.


"The key to what I do is my network, built up over my whole career. That's the key part."

And Klein agrees.

"He's honest in the way that he speaks to these guys, and having someone like that on our team is a great benefit to us and a great representation of the club."

With Ibrahimović officially a member of the Galaxy, Kirovski says he's hard at work securing the future of the Galaxy.

"There are other players we're talking to now, that have us planning ahead. We're already looking down the road at players for the next two years and three years. We're constantly keeping relationships going for that reason. It's important for our future as a club."


