


LA Galaxy welcome three new players after Opening Day


ast week, the LA Galaxy signed three new players as the club continues to bolster its roster for the 2019 season. Midfielder Joe Corona joined from Club Tijuana, LA Galaxy Academy and LA Galaxy II product Ethan Zubak signed his Homegrown contract and LA Galaxy II tryout winner Diedie Traore completed the dream with an MLS contract of his own. Zubak and Corona made their LA Galaxy debuts in the team's matchup with FC Dallas last weekend.

Corona, a 28-year-old U.S. Men's National Team veteran, joined the Galaxy after playing throughout Mexico since 2010. Born in Los Angeles, Corona began his professional career with Club Tijuana in 2010. In his first season with the club, he helped his side earn promotion to the Primera División after making 34 starts and scoring six goals. In all, he has made 195 appearances for Club Tijuana, scoring 11 goals and adding nine assists. He has also spent time on loan playing for Club América, Veracruz and Sinaloa in Mexico.

In addition to his professional career in Mexico, Corona has featured for the U.S. Men's National Team on both the youth and senior levels. The midfielder has made 23 senior appearances for the USMNT team, including caps during Olympic qualifying, CONCACAF Gold Cup and FIFA World Cup Qualifying matches.

20-year-old Zubak captained LA Galaxy II in 2018 and was a mainstay in the *Los Dos* attack for the third straight season, appearing in 31 games, starting in 24,





scoring 11 goals and two assists. Last season, Zubak scored the fastest hat trick in United Soccer League history.

The Corona, Calif., native made his *Los Dos* debut in August 2015 against Arizona United and was signed to the team ahead of the 2016 USL season. In total, Zubak has accumulated 83 appearances, 53 starts, 17 goals and six assists for LA Galaxy II, securing his spot on the USL 20 Under 20 list in 2018 and 2017.

Before signing with LA Galaxy II, Zubak was a member of the LA Galaxy Academy. With LA Galaxy Academy's U-17/18 team, Zubak led his team with 13 goals in 21 appearances during the 2015-2016 season. He also spent time playing for Arsenal FC Academy and Legends FC in California.


Traore, from Bondy, France, is the club's first player to sign a professional contract after being discovered through the organization's Open Tryout process. Traore traveled to Los Angeles from Paris to win an open tryout with LA Galaxy II in January 2018 at Dignity Health Sports Park. After making the 5,642 mile trip from Paris to Los Angeles, Traore then joined the LA Galaxy Academy, playing with the U-19s for the remainder of the 2018 season.

On July 25, 2018, LA Galaxy II signed Traore to his first professional contract. During the 2018 season, Traore made 13 appearances, 11 starts and recorded five assists, becoming *Los Dos'* leader in assists for the season. As a youth, Traore was a member of FC Metz's (France) Academy, a program whose graduates include Emmanuel Adebayor, Sadio Mane, Robert Pires, Miralem Pjanic and Louis Saha.

Zubak and Traore join Efrain Alvarez, Julian Araujo, Bradford Jamieson IV, Hugo Arellano, Daniel Steres and David Romney as first-team players who spent time developing through the LA Galaxy Academy or LA Galaxy II.













It's back to national team duty for the core of the LA Galaxy midfield.

exican National Team Head Coach Gerardo "Tata" Martino called up Jonathan dos Santos as part of a 29-man roster, the Mexican Football Federation announced Tuesday.

Dos Santos will join the Mexican National Team for two California friendlies later this March. Mexico faces Chile at 7:15 p.m. PT on Friday, March 22 at SDCCU Stadium in Şan Diego before heading north to take on Paraguay on Tuesday, March 26 at 7 p.m. PT at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif.

Also on Tuesday, U.S. Men's National Team head coach Gregg Berhalter called up LA Galaxy midfielder Sebastian Lletget. Lletget is one of 24 players Berhalter called in for his second camp, beginning March 17 in Orlando.


The USMNT takes its next steps with challenges against Ecuador on March 21 at Orlando City Stadium, then five days later against defending South American champion Chile on March 26 at BBVA Compass Stadium

in Houston. Both matches will be shown live at 5 p.m. PT on ESPN2, UniMas and UDN.

Lletget also earned a call up during this year's annual January camp for games against Panama and Costa Rica, where he logged his first minutes with the USMNT since 2017, when he suffered a season-ending Lisfranc fracture after scoring his first national team goal earlier in the match. Against Costa Rica, Lletget was influential in the team's 2-0 win, scoring a goal and adding an assist during the victory. In all, Lletget now has seven appearances and two goals with the USMNT.

"Our goal is to make progress. Building on the themes of last camp, building on the style of play of last camp, but also now evaluating a new group of players," Berhalter said. "I think we made progress in the first camp and I think it's now asking if we can take it to another level. When we are done with this camp, it's really important that we have a good idea of our strongest group of players heading into the Gold Cup."


