Energy FC finished their season-opening two-game road trip with 1 1 draw against Colorado Springs. On a cold and snowy evening at Weidner Field, the Switchbacks FC struck first with a goal in the 20th minute by Mastanabal Kacher. Energy FC responded quickly when Alex Dixon collected a loose ball inside the 18 and sent it past Switchbacks FC keeper Dan Jackson. Energy FC goalkeeper Cody Laurendi made two saves on the evening.

Rio Grande Valley has played two contests thus far this season and is 0-2-0. Both losses have come by the score of 1-0 with both goals being surrendered in the first half. This marks the second straight weekend RGV has visited the Sooner State. Last Saturday, Rio Grande Valley traveled to Tulsa.

This week, Energy FC hosts their 2017 home opener. This is Energy FC's fourth home opener in franchise history. All-time, Energy FC is 1-2-0 in home openers. Rio Grande Valley is the third home opener opponent for Energy FC. Each of the last two seasons, Energy FC has opened their home schedule against the Colorado Springs Switchbacks FC. The team's inaugural home opener was against Orlando City when that club was a member of USL.

This marks the fourth regular season meeting between OKC and RGV. Energy FC are 0-1-2 in those three matches. The last time these teams met was in the Western Conference Quarterfinals of the USL Cup playoffs. Energy FC used two stoppage time goals en route to a 3-2 win.

Energy FC head coach Jimmy Nielsen enters his fourth season with Energy FC, which makes him the longest tenured coach in the Western Conference. The only coach Energy FC has known, Nielsen owns a 31-26-27 mark in regular season contests and a 36-29-27 mark that included Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup games.

Prior to last week's game, FC Dallas loaned midfielder Coy Craft to Energy FC. Craft appeared in 11 games with Energy FC last season, logged 576 minutes and scored three goals. Craft has been training recently with the U.S. National U-20 team in their preparation for the 2017 FIFA U-20 World Cup. With FC Dallas, Craft was selected to be in the 18 on seven different occasions, including starts in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and CONCACAF matches.

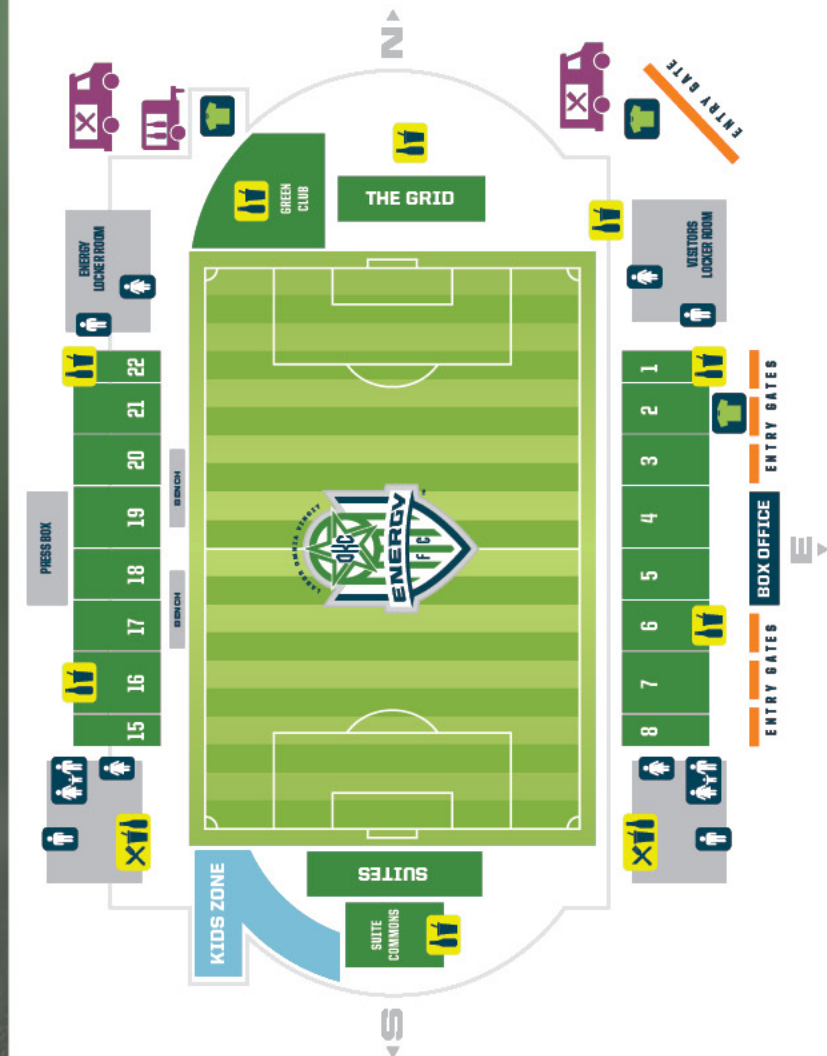

- Timely and accurate information related to the game.

If you see individuals acting in a way that violates the OKC Standard, please inform them and us of their unacceptable behavior. Everyone must be held accountable for their individual actions.

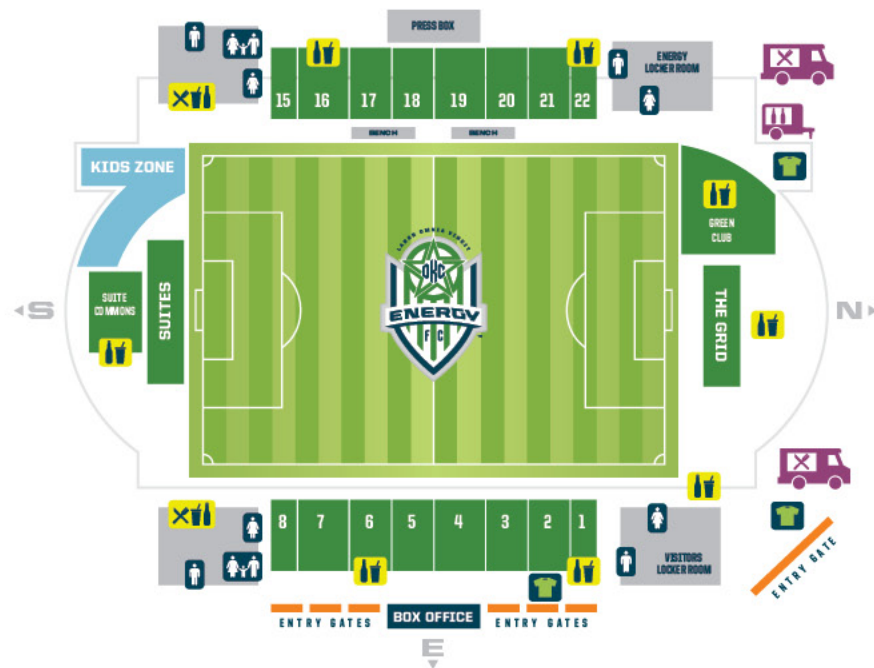

HEAD COACH JIMMY NIELSEN

OKC ENERGY FC INTRODUCED FORMER SPORTING KC GOALKEEPER JIMMY NIELSEN AS THE TEAM'S FIRST HEAD COACH ON DECEMBER 20, 2013.

Nielsen completed his final game as a professional, serving as goalkeeper for Sporting KC in their win over Real Salt Lake in MLS Cup 2013 on December 7. A veteran of nearly 600 professional games, Nielsen brings a wealth of experience to his new position.



Nielsen began his professional career with hometown club AaB Aalborg in Denmark, helping the team to the 1999 Danish Superliga championship. After a brief stint at Leicester City in 2007, he transferred to Danish club Vejle, for whom he made 63 appearances over two years. He was named Danish Goalkeeper of the Year in 1998 and 2004, and also represented his country at the U-19 and U-21 levels.

In February 2010, Nielsen joined Major League Soccer and became the starting goalkeeper for Sporting Kansas City. As a member of Sporting KC, Nielsen was a two-time MLS All Star, the 2012 MLS Goalkeeper of the Year, and goalkeeper for the 2012 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open championship club and the 2013 MLS Cup winning squad. He was named team captain prior to start of the 2012 season.

When Nielsen began his MLS career, he instantly became a fan favorite, whose signature bleach-blonde locks earned him the nickname "White Puma." But it wasn't just his play that endeared Nielsen to fans, though—it was his personality. He was known for stopping his car at local parks when driving by and joining in games with random children. Often, Nielsen would pull kids out of the crowd and have them kick balls at him as part of his pre-game warm-up.
