2016-17 SEASON: Was selected by the Los Angeles D-Fenders of the NBA G League in the third round (47th overall pick) of the 2016 NBA G League Draft on Oct. 30...was placed on waivers by the D-Fenders on Nov. 9...claimed by the Canton Charge of the NBA G League on Nov. 16...appeared in 40 games (one start) for the Charge, averaging 4.8 points on .592 shooting to go along with 3.4 rebounds in 11.6 minutes...reached double figures in scoring eight times...had a career-high 17 points on 8-9 (.889) shooting and six rebounds in 22 minutes on April 1 at Fort Wayne...played in two NBA G League Playoff contests for Canton, averaging 9.0 points on .750 (6-8) shooting, 6.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocks in 14.2 minutes.

PROFESSIONAL CAREER: In **2015-16**, signed with Telekom Baskets Bonn in Germany on July 18...played in eight total games for Telekom Baskets Bonn, averaging 3.0 points on .615 shooting and 1.6 rebounds in 10.9 minutes...appeared in two games during the German BBL season, averaging 4.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.0 assist in 18.4 minutes...played in six contests during the Eurocup, averaging 2.7 points and 1.2 rebounds in 8.4 minutes.

COLLEGE CAREER: Played four years collegiately at Daemen College...averaged 15.0 points on .583 shooting, 8.4 rebounds and 2.8 blocks in 25.3 minutes over his college career...in Daemen history, ranks 1st in blocks (330), 2nd in rebounds (1,004), 2nd in field goals made (669), 2nd in free throws made (459), 3rd in field goal percentage (.583), 4th in points (1,799) and 4th in rebounds per game (8.4)...as a senior in **2014-15**, appeared in 31 games (all starts), leading the team in scoring (20.0 ppg), rebounding (12.0 rpg) and blocks (110)...in single-season Daemen history, his 620 points were 4th and his 20.0 ppg average was 6th...also ranked 4th in field goals made (219), 4th in field goal percentage (.607) and 6th in free throws made (180)...scored in double figures in all 31 contests and concluded his college career with 61 straight games in which he reached double figures...named First Team All-ECC and ECC Defensive Player of the Year...named USCAA Division I Player of the Year while leading Daemen to the USCAA Division I National Championship...in **2013-14** as a junior, led the team in scoring (18.9 ppg), rebounds (10.0 rpg) and blocks (111)...became the first Daemen player to average a double-double over an entire season since 1998-99...became the second player in program history to record 100 blocks in a season...named First Team All-ECC, ECC Defensive Player of the Year and a First Team USCAA Division I All-American...during his sophomore season in **2012-13**, appeared in 30 games (29 starts), averaging 14.3 points on .597 shooting, 8.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks in 21.7 minutes...led the team in average rebounds (8.0 rpg) and total blocks (59) while finishing second in scoring average (14.3 ppg)...earned Second Team USCAA Division I All-American honors...named to the USCAA National Championships All-Tournament Team after averaging 13.7 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks in the tournament, helping Daemen finish as runners-up...as a freshman in **2011-12**, played in 31 contests (six starts), averaging 7.2 points on .522 shooting, 3.6 rebounds and 1.6 blocks in 14.8 minutes...named to the American Midwest Conference All-Freshman Team.

PERSONAL: Son of Gilbert and Annfurly... has an older brother, Gilbert Jr. and older sister, Adesawa...hobbies include bowling and video games...majored in Business Administration with a concentration in Sports Management.

COLLEGE CAREER: Over 71 career games (30 starts) at Iona, Connecticut and Chipola, averaged 6.3 points, 2.0 rebounds and 1.8 assists...in **2016-17**, joined Iona as a graduate transfer...appeared in 35 games (28 starts)...averaged 10.9 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 30.2 minutes...named Metro Athletic Atlantic Conference (MAAC) Player of the Week on Nov. 28 after earning MVP honors of the 2016 CGI Great Alaska Shootout, where he averaged 17.7 points, 4.7 assists 3.3 rebounds and 1.0 steal...helped the Gaels win the MAAC Tournament title and clinch an automatic berth in the NCAA Tournament...as a senior at Connecticut in **2015-16**, appeared in 18 games, averaging 2.2 points in 5.8 minutes...transferred to Connecticut in **2014-15** as a junior...appeared in 18 games (two starts), averaging 3.9 points and 1.3 rebounds in 15.1 minutes...missed the second half of the season due to a leg injury...as a redshirt sophomore at Chipola College in **2013-14**, played in 30 games (all starts), averaging 18.7 points, 3.6 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 1.6 steals...reached double figures in 27 games, including 13 contests with at least 20 points...named NJCAA First Team All-America, FCSAA All-State Player of the Year and Panhandle Conference Player of the Year...led Chipola to a 26-6 record and the NJCAA Region VII Championship...helped Chipola reach the Elite Eight of the NJCAA National Tournament...did not play during his freshman season at Chipola in **2012-13** to focus on academics.

PERSONAL: Son of Shalonda Gross and Sam Cassell Sr., who had a 15-year NBA playing career and is an assistant coach with the Los Angeles Clippers...has one brother, Caron...was teammates with Seven Adams of the Oklahoma City Thunder at Notre Dame Prep.

DRAFTED: Selected by the Atlanta Hawks in the second round (54th overall pick) of the 2016 NBA Draft.

2016-17 SEASON: Played in 42 games with Cleveland...averaged 4.0 points on .392 shooting...made his NBA debut on Oct. 29 against Orlando...tallied a career-high 14 points on 4-8 (.500) shooting and a perfect 2-2 clip on three-pointers, three rebounds, a career-high tying four assists and two steals in 23 minutes at Memphis on Dec. 14...finished with 13 points on 5-6 (.833) shooting from the field, two assists and two steals in 19 minutes versus Charlotte on Dec. 31...also appeared in 11 games (all starts) for the Canton Charge in the NBA G League, where he averaged 29.9 points, 3.4 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 1.5 steals in 36.1 minutes...poured in at least 25 points in each appearance with Canton...recorded a NBA G League career-best 41 points, going 11-20 (.550) from the field, 6-9 (.667) on three-pointers and a perfect 13-13 on free throws, five assists and a NBA G League career-best four steals in 37 minutes on March 4 against Fort Wayne...appeared in both playoff games for Canton, averaging 26.5 points and 7.5 assists in 35.4 minutes...posted a double-double with 32 points and 12 assists on April 5 vs. Raptors 905 in the NBA G League Playoffs...with the Cavs, led or tied for the team lead in assists two times, steals five times and blocks five times... missed one game on Oct. 25 due to concussion protocol...missed five games from April 12 to April 23 due to a left ankle sprain...was a DNP-CD 18 times and was placed on the Inactive List 22 times...was also on the Inactive List 18 times during the postseason.

COLLEGE CAREER: Played in 101 games over three years at Oakland...averaged 17.5 points, 4.3 rebounds, 7.8 assists and 1.6 steals in 35.9 minutes per game...owns the Horizon League's career assists mark with 788 over his tenure...as a junior in **2015-16**, appeared in 35 contests and averaged 24.4 points, 4.3 rebounds, 9.3 assists and 2.0 steals, while shooting .848 from the charity stripe...was the only player in the country to rank in the Top 5 in both scoring (fourth, 24.4 ppg) and assists (first, 9.3 apg) and became just the fifth player in Division I history over the last 20 years to average over 23 points and six assists in a single season...was the Horizon League Player of the Year and Third Team All-American by the AP, NABC and The Sporting News...scored 20 points in all but five games and recorded 10 or more assists 19 times...set a league record for most Player of the Week honors in a single season with seven and posted the only triple-doubles in school history with two...his first-ever triple-double in program history came vs. Detroit on Feb. 14, 2014 with 15 points, 11 assists and 10 rebounds...set a career-high with 38 points along with nine assists and six rebounds at Washington and then followed that performance with 37 points and nine assists vs. No. 1 Michigan State...played in 33 games as a sophomore in **2014-15**...averaged 18.1 points, 4.8 rebounds, 7.6 assists and 2.0 steals in 38.5 minutes...was the only player in the country to average at least 17.0 points and 7.0 assists...finished No. 2 in the NCAA with 7.6 assists per game...played 12 entire games and finished third nationally in minutes per game (38.5)...poured in a then career-high 37 points vs. Eastern Illinois, adding 11 assists...broke single-game league and school records with 24 free throw attempts vs. Valpo, and his 19 made ranks No. 2 in conference history...as a freshman in **2013-14**, played in 33 games with averages of 9.5 points, 3.9 rebounds and 6.4 assists in 32.4 minutes...ranked seventh in the NCAA in assists...the Horizon League Freshman of the Year.

PERSONAL: Full name is Kahlil Ameer Felder, Jr...named the Detroit Public School's Learner of the Year in 2013...graduated with a 3.6 GPA from Pershing High School...was on the National Honor Roll and Dean's List...son of Kahlil Felder Sr. and Tiffany Williams...his father played college basketball at Eastern Michigan (1990-92) and ranks inside the single-season record book with 129 assists in 1991-1992...cousin is former NBA and Michigan State standout Steve Smith.
