Art Solomon is the President and CEO of DSF Sports, the parent company of the New Hampshire Fisher Cats.

Under Art’s direction, the Fisher Cats have earned several distinctions throughout the baseball industry. Most recently, the Fisher Cats earned the Eastern League nomination for the 2012, 2013, and 2014 John H. Johnson President’s Trophy, which recognizes the top organization in Minor League Baseball based on franchise stability, contributions to the community, and promotion of the baseball industry.

In 2010, the club was honored with the prestigious Larry MacPhail Award as the nation’s best in promotional effort and community involvement. In 2009 the club won Baseball America’s Double-A Bob Freitas Award recognizing the Fisher Cats as the most outstanding franchise at the Double-A level for overall business operation and long-term success.

Art has reproduced his blueprint for successful minor league baseball teams into a new book called ‘Making It in the Minors’. It details the behind-the-scenes, often-untold stories about the business of baseball, from acquiring a franchise to developing marketing and branding strategies, and more. All proceeds from the book are being donated to Minor League Baseball Charities.

Only second to his love of family and baseball is Art’s commitment to strong and vibrant local communities. The Fisher Cats and the Fisher Cats Foundation have provided more than four million dollars in monetary and in-kind donations for thousands of non-profit groups since 2006. The headline event is the annual Granite State Baseball Dinner, which donated nearly \$140,000 for charity in 2015.

Earlier in his career, he worked for the anti-poverty programs in New Haven, Connecticut and in Washington D.C. While he was as a professor of Economics and Urban Studies at M.I.T., he served as the Executive Director of the Harvard-M.I.T. Joint Center for Urban Studies -- a leading think tank on the development of our cities and regions.

Widely regarded as one of the most successful investors, developers, and operators in the United States real estate market, Art holds a B.A. from Brown University, an M.A. from Trinity College, and a Ph.D. from Harvard University.

He is married to Sally Lapides and has three children, two step children and eight grandchildren.

GENERAL MANAGER

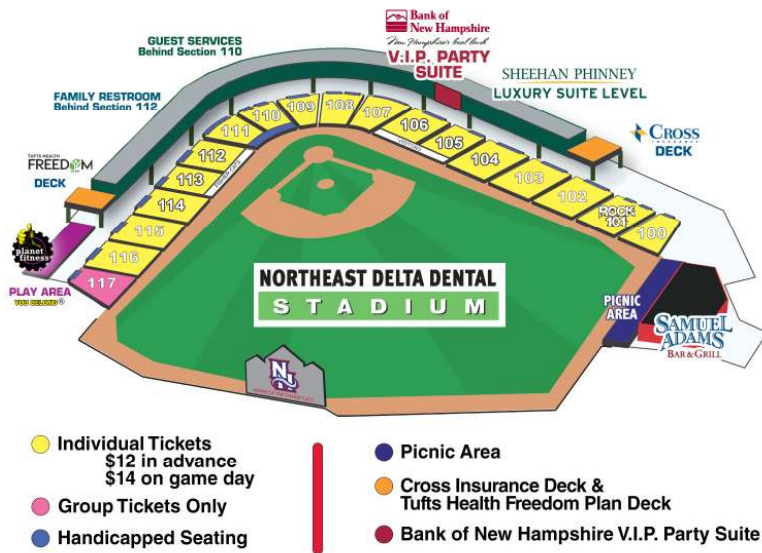


Jim recently returned to New England to head the Fisher Cats’ ticketing and operations efforts from the Tacoma Rainiers, Triple-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, before being tabbed as the General Manager in November of 2016. Born and raised in the Boston suburb of Milton, Mass., he began his career in baseball with the independent Worcester Tornadoes of the Can-Am League while studying at Holy Cross.

After graduating in May of 2008 with a B.A. in Economics, Jim spent one more season with the Tornadoes before making the leap across the country to become the Stadium Operations Manager for the Visalia Rawhide, the High-A affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks.

DIRECTIONS TO NORTHEAST DELTA DENTAL STADIUM

FROM NORTH: Take I-93 South to I-293 South. Follow I-293 South and take exit 5 (Granite St.) Take a left onto Granite St. and immediately move into the right lane. At light take a right on South Commercial St. Please follow the RIVERFRONT/BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

FROM SOUTH via I-93: Take I-93 North to I-293 North, then follow directions from the East below. Pick up the directions from where I-293 North passes the Mall of New Hampshire and Brown Ave.

FROM EAST: Follow Route 101 heading west to I-93 South. Go about a half a mile and stay right, exiting onto I-293 North (right hand exit off I-93S - this exit is not numbered). Once on I-293 North, go past the Mall of New Hampshire and Brown Avenue exits. After crossing the river, stay to the right as I-293N bears right. Turn right onto Granite St. Then take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the RIVERFRONT/FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

FROM WEST: Take Route 101 West to Route 293 North. Follow I-293N and take exit 5 (Granite St.) Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite St. Take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

FROM Rte 3/Everett Tpke: Follow Route 3 to the Everett Turnpike heading north. Just south of Manchester, this road becomes I-293 North. Follow I-293N and take exit #5 (Granite St.) Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite St. Take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The stadium is directly ahead.

Most regular season games, plus any potential playoff games, will be heard on the Fisher Cats flagship station, WGIR-610 AM in Manchester, and sister station WPKX-930 AM in Rochester (iHeart Radio). All games are streamed and links can be found on the Fisher Cats website, www.nhfishercats.com. Select games will also be carried by WZEI 101.5 FM (Lakes Region Media), WTPL 107.7 FM (Binnie Media), WTSR 1400-AM (Hanover/Lebanon), WTSV 1230-AM (Claremont) and WEEY 93.5 FM (Keene). Fisher Cats games are also video streamed (available by subscription) through www.milb.tv.

Tyler Murray, Tyler Zickel, Bob Lipman and Charlie Sherman will call the action this season. Erin Boss is the Executive Producer of the Fisher Cats Radio Network.

Tyler Murray, the Fisher Cats Manager of Broadcasting and Media Relations, starts his third season with the team. Before New Hampshire, Tyler called games for the Daytona Tortugas of the Florida State League where he earned the first-annual Broadcaster of the Year Award. Murray worked in the Florida State League for four seasons. After spending 2012 as a broadcast intern with the Daytona Cubs, the BU grad joined the Dunedin Blue Jays for two seasons.

Tyler Zickel will again serve as the primary road broadcaster in his second season with the team. “Zick” will also work as our on-field MC at home games. A native of San Diego, he spent three years with the Lake Elsinore Storm in Southern California. Prior to his MiLB career, Tyler graduated from Whittier College in Los Angeles with a degree in English.

Bob Lipman is back for a 15th season of calling Fisher Cats baseball. A Vanderbilt graduate, Bob is also the play-by-play voice of the University of New Hampshire football team. Prior to joining the UNH broadcast team, the six-time New Hampshire Sportscaster of the Year was the lead broadcaster for Dartmouth College football.

Charlie Sherman is back for his eighth year and will call select home games during the 2018 season. After a career in banking, he earned his statewide fame with a 14-year stint as the lead sportscaster on WMUR-TV in Manchester. After a seven-year run at WGIR, the Fisher Cats flagship station, Charlie took on new project as the head of the New Horizons, an organization which operates an adult homeless shelter, a soup kitchen, food pantry and Angie’s Shelter for Women. Charlie also works as an anchor at WBZ-AM.

Erin Boss has coordinated the radio broadcasts since 2007, when WGIR took over as the flagship station. She is a graduate of Hopkinton High School and Ithaca College, with a degree in journalism from the Park School of Communications and is the radio station’s Assistant Program Director. Erin oversees all broadcast elements, production of games and distribution of audio elements for broadcasts of the Fisher Cats, the University of New Hampshire and Southern New Hampshire University.

Meacham managed the Fisher Cats from 2014-2016. Allenson returned to New Hampshire where he was the skipper in the 2013 season, his first season as a Manager in the Blue Jays organization. New Hampshire went 68-72 that year. As a player, Allenson appeared in 402 games with Boston from 1979-1984. His final season as a player, 1985, included 62 games with the Triple-A Syracuse Chiefs and 14 games with the Blue Jays. He also coached for all or part of seven seasons in the Major Leagues with the Red Sox, Brewers and Orioles.

TOP PROSPECTS PLAY IN NEW HAMPSHIRE: The Blue Jays sent many high-rated prospects to New Hampshire to start the season, generating a lot of pre-season excitement. While the team's offense showed steady improvement through the season despite not having a real home run threat, the young starting staff struggled to find the consistency needed to avoid the worst record in franchise history (59-80). That noted, there were solid performances from several pitchers and six players from the 2017 team made Major League debuts with the Blue Jays. (Anthony Alford, Richard Urena, Chris Rowley, Tim Mayza, Carlos Ramirez, and Luis Santos).

ALL-STARS CONVERGE IN MANCHESTER: For the third time, New Hampshire hosted the Eastern League All-Stars on Wednesday July 12 at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium. An exciting home run derby was won by Bowie's Aderlin Rodriguez 14-13 in the finals over Erie's Gabriel Quintana. The East scored seven times in the sixth inning in a 7-1 win over the West. New Hampshire's Gunnar Heidt drove in two runs with a double and Ryan McBroom of the Fisher Cats also knocked in a run before the home crowd of 6,012.

WHO'S THE ACE?: Four pitchers were in the conversation as being the "best" of 2017. Army veteran Chris Rowley started the season in the bullpen, but dominated when moved into the starting rotation on May 20. He allowed three ER in 25.1 IP in his last four New Hampshire starts. Reliever Carlos Ramirez, while injured for a long stretch of the season, did not allow an earned run in 18 games with New Hampshire while holding opponents to a .123 average. Southpaw Tim Mayza struggled at the start of the season, but pitched well enough in June to earn a Triple-A promotion, and eventually a job in the bullpen for the Blue Jays. Late in the season, southpaw Ryan Borucki was the best starting pitcher. In his final start with the Fisher Cats on August 26, he blanked Hartford over seven innings with seven strikeouts.

MOST IMPROVED PLAYERS: Richard Urena probably developed more than any player on the team. He continued to show improvement defensively and has about the best range we've seen at shortstop. Offensively, he was hitting as low as .217 by late May, and finished at .247. His 36 doubles fell one short of the franchise record and indicate he may be developing a power stroke. In his first season in the Blue Jays organization, Tim Lopes put together a solid season and could eventually find his way onto a Major League roster. He finished with 50 RBI and stole 19 bases. With 111 hits and 69 walks, Jonathan Davis had a .361 OBP. He covers a lot of ground in centerfield and can move forward with a better success rate stealing bases.

DOUBLE-A FOR AA: Anthony Alford, injuries aside, had a terrific 2017 season.. In May, he became the first position player in Fisher Cats history to be promoted from Double-A to the Majors. His .310 average with the Fisher Cats would have been .001 off the all-time best (he didn't qualify on AB). Alford showed tremendous speed, almost leading the team in stolen bases (18 for 21), fielded his position well, and had a .406 OBP.

THE FUTURE LOOKS BRIGHT, HERE AND IN TORONTO: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, two of Baseball America's Top 10 prospects, will suit up for New Hampshire in 2018, along with an additional five of the Top 30 prospects in the Blue Jays organization, and a total of six players taken in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

3B Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. enters the season as the highest-rated prospect in Fisher Cats history, ranked No. 3 in all of baseball by Baseball America and MLB.com. The 19-year-old made headlines on Tuesday, March 27, hitting a walk-off home run in the Blue Jays Spring Training finale at Olympic Stadium in Montreal, where his Hall of Fame father played for eight seasons. Guerrero, Jr. hit .323 with 21 home runs between Class-A Lansing and Advanced-A Dunedin last year, and was named the best hitting prospect in baseball in the latest issue of Baseball America magazine. The Blue Jays signed Guerrero, Jr. for \$3.9 million on July 2, 2015.

SS Bo Bichette is the No. 8 prospect in the game according to Baseball America, and won the 2017 Minor League Batting Title with a .362 average as a member of the Lansing Lugnuts and Dunedin Blue Jays. His father Dante Bichette spent 14 seasons in the major leagues (including two with the Boston Red Sox in 2000-2001), and hit .299 with 274 career home runs. The 20-year-old Bichette was taken in the second round of the 2016 Draft out of Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg, Fla.

EASTERN LEAGUE NEWS: The 2017 Championship won by the Altoona Curve was the second in team history. Akron defeated Trenton for the title after dispatching Bowie in the Western Division Championship series. Trenton held off Binghamton in a battle of the Eastern Division's top two teams. ..After years of delays, the Hartford Yard Goats opened 2017 in the beautiful Dunkin' Donuts Park and averaged more than 5,800 per game. The team remained the Double-A affiliate for the Colorado Rockies...The Eastern League schedule, which had been at 142 games since the Fisher Cats joined in 2004, was been trimmed to 140 games for the 2017 season. Each team now plays 70 home games and 70 away. The playoff structure remains unchanged with the top two teams in each division playing each other in a best-of-five series in advance of a best-of-five Championship series. The Western Division will host Games 1 and 2 of the finals in 2018. There were no no-hitters in the Eastern League in 2017.

JOHN SCHNEIDER

MANAGER
FIRST SEASON

John Schneider becomes the first Fisher Cats player to manage the team. He's also the youngest skipper in the history of the franchise. Schneider takes over after leading Advanced-A Dunedin to its first Florida State League title in 2017. There, he saw the development of the young prospects including Vladimir Guerrero and Bo Bichette.

Schneider, as a catcher, played for the Fisher Cats in 2005 and 2006. After playing for the University of Delaware, he signed with the Blue Jays after being selected in the 13th round of the 2002 draft.

Schneider is one of nine men to have skippered the Fisher Cats: Mike Basso (2004-05), Doug Davis (2006), Bill Masse (2007), Gary Cathcart (2008-09), Luis Rivera (2010), Sal Fasano (2011-12), Gary Allenson (2013, 2017) and Bobby Meacham (2014-16) are the others.

HUNTER MENSE

HITTING COACH
FIRST SEASON

Hitting coach Hunter Mense will begin his first year with the Fisher Cats and the Blue Jays organization. He most recently worked as the hitting coach for Short-Season Tri-City (San Diego). Prior to that he was hitting coach for the University of Missouri, where he went to school.

Mense was selected by the Marlins in the 17th round of the 2006 draft. He advanced as far as Triple-A in his five seasons in the Florida organization.

ANDY FERMIN

POSITION COACH
SECOND SEASON

Andy Fermin returns to the Fisher Cats staff in 2018 as a position player coach. The 28-year old spent seven years playing in the Blue Jays minor league ranks, making stops at six different levels in the system.

Fermin appeared in a total of 55 games for New Hampshire in 2014 and 2015. His father, Felix Fermin, played for the Pirates, Indians, Mariners and Cubs from 1987-1996.

VINCE HORSMAN

PITCHING COACH
THIRD SEASON

Pitching coach Vince Horsman is back with the Fisher Cats for a third season. The native of Nova Scotia made his MLB debut with the Blue Jays in 1991, pitching four games for Toronto. Horsman pitched three seasons for Oakland, who claimed him off waivers in Spring Training in 1992, before spending the 1995 season with the Minnesota Twins.

Horsman joined the Blue Jays organization in 2005, and has made stops with Pulaski, the GCL Jays, Lansing (2010-2014), and Dunedin (2015) before joining New Hampshire. In 2017, Vince helped guide pitchers Tim Mayza, Chris Rowley and Carlos Ramirez to their MLB debuts.

DREW MacDONALD

ATHLETIC TRAINER
FIRST SEASON

For the first time in nine seasons, the Fisher Cats have a new Athletic Trainer with Bob Tarpey receiving a promotion to Triple-A Buffalo. Drew spent the last five seasons with Class-A Lansing.

MacDonald originally interned with Toronto in 2009 before joining the Baseball Canada Junior National Team. A native of Teeswater, Ontario, he moved up to Lansing after stops in Bluefield (2011) and Vancouver (2012).

RYAN MAEDEL

STRENGTH & CONDITIONING
FIRST SEASON

Ryan Maedel, a 2007 Southern Wesleyan (SC) graduate from Ontario, Canada, receives a promotion in the Blue Jays organization to the Fisher Cats. Maedel was named strength coach of the year in the GCL during the 2013 season. He was in Lansing in 2014-16 and was with the Florida State League champs in Dunedin last year.

Long-time Strength Coach Brian Pike joins Bob Tarpey in the same position at Triple-A Buffalo in 2018.



2018 MEDIA POLICIES

Credential Requests:

Sources requesting daily media credentials are to contact Tyler Murray at (603) 606-4130 or tmurray@nhfishercats.com.

Media sources are recommended to contact Tyler at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled game time to ensure that your request will be processed on time for that day's game.

Media that request a daily pass are required to pick up their credentials with the rear parking lot attendant.

Under no circumstances shall the Fisher Cats discriminate, in any fashion, against any accredited member of the media based on race, color, creed, or national origin. If a member of the media violates team policies, the New Hampshire Fisher Cats reserve the right to revoke the media credential.

Media Parking:

Due to limited availability of parking resources, members of the media are instructed to notify Tyler Murray of their need for parking no later than 4 hours before the start of that day's game.

If a member of the media arrives at the game unexpectedly, the Fisher Cats can not assure a parking space.

Members of the media with advanced parking authorization will park in the lot to the south of the ballpark behind the right field grandstand.

Television crews are instructed to follow the same instructions as outlined in the MEDIA PARKING provisions.

Entering Northeast Delta Dental Stadium:

All members of the media are to enter the ballpark at the rear gate next to the Suite Holder Parking/Entrance. If you experience any difficulties, or have any questions, please notify the parking lot attendant.

Press Releases:

The New Hampshire Fisher Cats are in the practice of e-mailing all press releases to all media sources. If the ball club does not have your email address, please contact Tyler Murray at (603) 606-4130 or at tmurray@nhfishercats.com.

Press Box:

The Northeast Delta Dental Stadium Press Box is located behind homeplate on the suite level (top level) of the Stadium. The elevator to the Press Box is located in the entry corridor at the bottom of the stairwell near the Suite Holder Parking/Entrance.

Press Box Work Area:

The working print media have a room reserved for their use. This room is located all the way to the left of the back of the Press Box. If you would like to make other seating arrangements, please communicate this request to Tyler Murray at (603) 606-4130 or tmurray@nhfishercats.com.

Press Box Technology:

The Press Box is equipped with DSL, a wireless router and digital phone locations.

Photographer/Camera Work Locations:

Media sources that require the use of still photography and video imagery are allowed to work in Northeast Delta Dental Stadium. The Fisher Cats ask that you respect the fans by making sure that your work area is chosen with the fans' sightlines in mind. The intimacy of the Ballpark makes it difficult to shoot without blocking a fan's sightline, so please be aware of this guideline.

Camera Crews are allowed to work in the following locations:

- *In the camera bay in each dugout.
- *In the Press Box.
- *Anywhere in the publicly accessed areas of the Stadium (as long as you do not affect the sightline of any fans).

Camera Crews are NOT allowed to work in the following locations:

- *The roof of the Stadium
- *In areas blocking a fan's sightline
- *On the playing surface during the game
- *Restrooms
- *Concession Stands
- *Front Office
- *Restricted Locations



2018 MEDIA POLICIES

Player Interviews/Accessibility:

It is very important to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats and Toronto Blue Jays that all players are available to the media for reasonable periods of time, following our policies, before and after games. It is the player's responsibility to cooperate.

Special interview requests are to be submitted to Tyler Murray at (603) 606-4130 or tmurray@nhfishercats.com. Tyler will need 24 hours advanced notification to handle special requests.

Media members are not allowed access to the players on the field or in the clubhouse 60 minutes prior to the regularly scheduled game time.

Nearing the completion of the game, members of the media are to notify Tyler Murray of their desire to interview specific players or team personnel.

There is a 10 minute cool down period following the completion of each game. Media members are not allowed into the clubhouses during this time. The Fisher Cats will have a staff member notify the media when they are allowed to enter the clubhouses. Some games might require more of a cool down period due to team meetings or team business. This will require the media to wait a few minutes longer. The Fisher Cats will do their best to keep these instances to a minimum.

Live interviews of the team from the clubhouse or field are not permitted unless approved by Tyler Murray and Manager John Schneider.

Any media request pertaining to the use of live microphones in the dugouts or field personnel are to be approved by Fisher Cats President Mike Ramshaw and Manager John Schneider.

Access to the Visiting clubhouse falls under the same operating procedures except there is no need to notify Tyler Murray of your request to interview specific players. The Visitors clubhouse has no interview room and you will be instructed to simply enter the locker area. Visiting teams have a radio broadcaster who should also be available to lend some assistance.

Visitors in the clubhouses are to conduct themselves in a professional manner. There is to be no seeking of autographs, removal of property, or sampling of player food spreads.

Clubhouses are work places and business should be conducted in a timely fashion with minimum disruption of team personnel procedures. The clubhouse is a player's sanctuary, and we ask that you please treat it as such.

Field Access:

The working media is allowed field access during batting practice up to 60 minutes prior to the start of the regularly scheduled game time. The media are allowed in foul territory and around the batting cage if they are not impeding with on-field activities. The media is allowed in the dugout as long as they are not preventing the players and staff from doing their jobs. The media may be asked to move from their location at any time if the Fisher Cats organization needs to conduct business in those areas. There will be no media access on the field during the game.

Player Roster Moves:

Tyler Murray will notify the media of all roster moves. This will be done via email. If the roster move occurs when members of the media are around, Tyler will notify them verbally as well. Roster moves are decided and approved by the Toronto Blue Jays, not the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. All roster moves follow the procedure of notifying Major League Baseball, Minor League Baseball, and the Eastern League.

Player Status Health/Injury:

All members of the media are required to direct all questions pertaining to the status of a player to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats Manager John Schneider. No other member of the organization is authorized to comment on these issues.

Food:

Members of the media covering Fisher Cats games are given a complimentary meal and drink at each game. The Fisher Cats request that this food and drink is only for your consumption. The media meal is on a first come/first served basis and we ask that you be considerate to the other members of the media when taking your portion. No member of the working media will be served alcoholic beverages, nor are they allowed to consume alcoholic beverages.

Autographs:

Any media requests for autographs are to be cleared and approved by the Fisher Cats President Mike Ramshaw. Requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the team president.

Not Allowed:

Under Eastern League rules, no Food or Drink is allowed to be brought into Northeast Delta Dental Stadium. Large Tripods that might be considered trip hazards for fans. Alcohol Consumption by working media is prohibited.
