Welcome back to Segra Park, home of the Columbia Fireflies!

On this Opening Night and through Opening Week, we are welcoming Fireflies fans back to the ballpark for the first game in 621 days.

It has been nearly two years since our last home game - August 29th, 2019 - a loss to Hickory in front of 6,533 fans on Grateful Dead Night, Little did we know what was to unfold in the months ahead.

Our dedicated staff planned an amazing promotional schedule for the 2020 season. Refreshed promotions and in-game entertainment, new uniforms and a fresh new look for our beloved Chicharrones de Columbia. The stars were aligned for our best season at Segra Park, and nothing was going to stop us from delivering a top-notch experience for our incredible fans across the region.

In February, the threat from Covid-19 began to hit home as cases were growing in pockets of the US. On March 8th, my wife and I went to dinner with old friends downtown and my friend Scott said: "you know this is probably the last time we would eat in a restaurant for a year." That was more prophetic than we could have ever imagined.

Just four days later, Minor League Baseball announced a delay to the start of the 2020 season. One week after that, we closed Segra Park and had most of our team work remotely while we held out hope for the good news about a rescheduled Opening Night – good news that never came.

On June 30th, Minor League Baseball sent a statement that read: "Major League Baseball (MLB) has informed Minor League Baseball that it will not be providing its affiliated Minor League teams with players for the 2020 season. As a result, there will not be a Minor League Baseball season in 2020."

To say that we were devastated by this news is an understatement.

To say that the support and love we felt from our community was incredible is also an understatement. Team sponsorship partners, season ticket members, group leaders and suite members allowed us to roll their payments in the 2021 season, affording us the financial breathing room we needed to bridge the 621-day gap. Thank you for entrusting us with your investment during these trying times. We are eternally grateful for your support.

Now that we're back to our core business of bringing people together for fun, family and Fireflies Baseball, vou'll notice that things are going to look a bit different.

Players: We have a new affiliate! While we enjoyed a long-standing relationship with the Mets, we are thrilled partner with the Kansas City Royals as we enter the first season of a minimum 10-year partnership with the 2015 World Series Champions. Because of Covid restrictions, please understand that players are not permitted to sign autographs at this time. We hope that this restriction will be lifted later in the season.

Masks: As part of our reopening plan, Major League Baseball has instituted a mask mandate for fans in the ballpark. This is not a Fireflies policy or a City of Columbia mandate – this is a condition of us being allowed to open the gates this season. Please be kind to our staff as and when they remind you to wear one and please understand that they are just doing their jobs.

Seating: You'll notice that we are providing our fans with a choice of seating options: socially distant seating or traditional seating. As you purchase your tickets, please be sure to pick the section in which you are most comfortable. Sections will adjust with demand, but we pledge to keep some amount of socially distant seating available throughout the season.

Cashless venue: To assure the safety of our fans and our staff, Segra Park is now a cashless venue, accepting debit and credit cards only at all points of sale – including parking. For fans that don't have bank cards, don't worry. You can stop by Guest Services and exchange cash for gift cards that can be used anywhere in the park. Gift Cards are available in \$5 increments and will have no expiration date so you can use it on any visit to the park in the future.

Mobile Food Ordering: To help reduce lines and expedite service, the Fireflies are now offering mobile ordering from the comfort of your seats. Please visit https://mobile.appetizeapp.com/fireflies to place your order and you'll get a text notification when it is ready for pick-up.

As always, our staff is always here to help answer your questions, help resolve issues and to make your experience at Segra Park memorable. Please let us know if there's anything we can do to make your visit even more special.



This is the place where players adjust to full-season baseball. Where someone finds out if they can handle the grind of playing six-or-seven times a week from spring all the way until summer begins to fade away. This is where many Royals farmhands will receive their first taste of professional ball after college and where some polished high schoolers will begin their journey to the Majors. While players are in Columbia, they can head to the Congaree National Park to see the Fireflies there blink synchronously—a feat that can only be seen at Congaree National Park, Allegheny National Forest and the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

QUAD CITIES RIVER BANDITS • ADVANCED-A • HIGH-A CENTRAL



If you find yourself in Quad Cities, you're on your way as a player. Typically, only very polished draft picks selected out of college will start at this level. Most other players will have spent time in a rookie league or extended spring training prior to making the jump. The game gets faster here and the defense cleaner. This is where pitchers will add a better secondary pitch and hitters will have to learn to be more selective at the plate if they want to advance. While players are in Quad Cities, they can take a river boat trip along the mighty Mississippi River that'll give great views of the surrounding cities in the tight-knit area. They can also visit Antique Archeology, or the original store for The History Channel's The American Pickers show.

NORTHWEST ARKANSAS NATURALS • AA • DOUBLE-A CENTRAL



Players will find themselves in Northwest Arkansas when they are nearly ready to make their Major League debut. A lot of top prospects will skip AAA and move directly from AA to the show. A lot of players will workshop a specific part of their game while in Northwest Arkansas so they can prepare themselves for the show. While in Northwest Arkansas, players can visit a handful of local wineries or breweries, including Sassafras Springs Vineyard or take a day trip along the historic Arkansas & Missouri Railroad. The A&M will allow you to spend three hours in historic Van Buren where you can peruse local cafes and shops and check out the historic downtown area.

OMAHA STORM CHASERS • AAA • TRIPLE-A EAST



Players who are tuning up for the Majors or who have been up in the bigs and need to work on a skill and take a break from Major League competition will compete in Omaha. Fans and players who visit Warner Park also have the opportunity to visit some great attractions such as the Durham Museum, which is a history exhibit that runs through a 1931 train station. You can also visit the Henry Doorly Zoo, which has the world's largest indoor desert and the largest indoor rain forest in North America.

MiLB: Did not play after being signed in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Was drafted twice prior to his senior year at Washington State, once in the 17th round of the 2019 draft by the Detroit Tigers, the other time in the 39th round of the 2015 draft by the Chicago Cubs. He wasn't picked in the 2020 draft that was shortened to five rounds.

Opponents hit just .217 against him and he received a chance to compete in the South Atlantic League for one appearance in Lexington prior to the end of the season. He didn't disappoint, the southpaw fanned 4 batters in 3.2 innings and allowed just one run to cross.

MiLB: Won the Royals' Organizational Pitcher of the Month for the Arizona League Royals in June 2019. During that time, he started three games and allowed just three runs in 12 innings. On Opening Day, he fanned five batters in four scoreless frames... His career-high in strikeouts came in an outing June 28, where he spun four innings and punched out seven hitters.

MLB Draft (KC)

Mil.B: Transitioned back to a starter's role in 2019, after only starting one game in 2018. He locked down a 4.55 ERA in 63.1 frames with the Idaho Falls Chuckars while setting down 77 batters via the strikeout. He closed out the season strong, allowing only three runs in his last 15 innings of work across three outings (1.80 ERA).



His strikeout numbers rose significantly as he adjusted to full-season ball, but he kept his power and had 29 extrabase hits, including three triples.

Acquired: Picked in the fourth round of 2019

MLB Draft (KC)

MiLB: Ranked the 20th-best prospect in the Royals system by MLB.com prior to the 2021 season... He hit .384 (15-39) during that stretch and tallied four consecutive multi-hit games with a double from June 29-July 3, 2019.
