

MARAUDERS IN THE COMMUNITY

SINCE THE TEAM'S INAUGURAL SEASON IN 2010, THE MARAUDERS HAVE AIMED TO ENGAGE CONSISTENTLY WITH THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. WITH NOW OVER A DECADE OF RESIDENCE IN MANATEE COUNTY, THE MARAUDERS PROUDLY SUPPORT A CORE OF FIVE LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS KNOWN AS THE FIVE PILLARS.



Boys & Girls Clubs of Manatee County provides a safe environment for after-school and summertime growth and learning for area youths. BGCMC began operating in 1946 in an old wood-frame building on the present-day site of LECOM Park, and currently has six Manatee County locations. This year, BGCMC is celebrating its 75th anniversary and plans to partner with the Pirates and Marauders on a Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) program.



With the challenges that the past year has brought, the Marauders are especially proud to support local police officers, firefighters, and paramedics for their efforts in the community. In 2019, the Marauders hosted a "Battle of the Badges" charity softball game between the Bradenton Police Department and Manatee Sheriff's Office, and plan to do the same later in 2021. The Marauders will also celebrate local first responders and frontline workers this summer on August 13.



The Marauders and Pirates partner with Manatee County Education on various initiatives throughout the year, including the "Adopta-School" program through Pirates Charities, providing virtual engagement from Pirates players and staff. The Marauders partner with Manatee County schools with an annual Back to School Night, with this year's special night scheduled for July 30, featuring a backpack giveaway. Also, proceeds from bids on the Marauders' special Nickelodeon Dora the Explorer jerseys on May 22 will benefit the Manatee Education Foundation.



Pace Center for Girls provides girls and young women with education and training focused on empowerment and preparation for future success. The Marauders are longtime supporters of the Lucky Duck Race for Pace, the center's annual charity event. In 2021, the Pace Center will receive proceeds from auctioned-off Margaritaville-themed jerseys from the Marauders game on June 12. The center also partook in virtual engagement with Marcy McGovern (Pirates Senior VP of Legal and People & Culture) and Alison Mauer (Pirates Director of Sports Nutrition and Fueling).



The Marauders support local youth sports, with a special focus on the Miracle League of Manasota, which has provided differently-abled children and adults from throughout Manatee and Sarasota Counties with the opportunity to enjoy America's pastime since 2012. Traditionally, both the Pirates and Marauders have held Fantasy Camps at the Miracle League, sending players and front office members to join in on gameday fun. Additionally, the Pirates and Marauders support the many youth baseball and softball leagues within Manatee County.

MARAUDERS IN THE COMMUNITY

Over the past several months, the Marauders front office has engaged with local community leaders and organizations to bring depth to their recognition of the Hispanic and Latino communities, the LGBTQ+ community, and the African American community. By holding regular ambassador committee meetings via Zoom, the Marauders are bringing authenticity to the planning of their promotional nights at LECOM Park, as well as expanding community outreach.

The Marauders are partnering with the Gulf Coast Latin Chamber of Commerce, who will help promote festivities for the weekend of May 21-23, in which the Marauders will continue their participation in Minor League Baseball's "Copa de la Diversión" (Spanish for "Fun Cup"), an initiative





aimed at celebrating teams' local Hispanic and Latin communities. The team will celebrate the ongoing efforts of Hispanic and Latino educators and first responders, thanking them for their efforts amid the ongoing challenges of the past year. There will also be a fourth Copa night coinciding with Back to School Night on July 30, with a backpack giveaway for the first 500 kids 12 and under.

During the themed weekend, as well as on July 30, the Marauders will take the field as the Bradenton Barbanegras ("Blackbeards"), donning festive, brightly-colored uniforms, and three local artists—Grupo Mango, Renesito Avich, and Mexican Fiesta — will provide pregame musical performances.



The Marauders are also partnering with various organizations representing the local LGBTQ+ community. Pride Night at LECOM Park is slated for June 11. Numerous LGBTQ+ organizations will be present with information tables on the Fan Plaza, and the Marauders will promote upcoming local LGBTQ+ events.

BUILDING BRIDGES

The Marauders have also partnered with the Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce to celebrate the local Black community. In observation of Black History Month in February, Marauders general manager Craig Warzecha hosted a weekly series of

Zoom interviews known as "Building Bridges." Warzecha visited with Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce President and CEO Tarnisha Cliatt, Pirates Senior Director of Player Personnel Steve Williams, former Bradenton Nine Devils outfielder Waymon "Fruitcake" Armstead, and Pirates outfielder Anthony Alford. All four spoke about their community involvement and their personal takeaways on Black History Month.







On August 21, the Marauders will host Bradenton Nine Devils Tribute night, recognizing the trails blazed by Bradenton's former Florida State Negro League team that played from 1937 through 1956. Armstead, a former Nine Devils outfielder, is scheduled to attend, and the entire evening will celebrate Black players' contributions to the game.

For each of these themed dates, the Marauders will honor individuals from these communities with opportunities to throw ceremonial first pitches and to participate in other pregame events and ceremonies.

With the support of these leaders and organizations, the Marauders look to make 2021 a success, both at LECOM Park and in the community at large.



A NATURAL LEADER

BRADENTON, Fla. — Think about the background and characteristics that make up a great leader. Whatever qualities you can come up with, new Marauders manager Jonathan Johnston likely fits the bill.

A former catcher who also served in the United States Navy, Johnston is well-acquainted with the true value of leadership.

"(My two brothers and I) were surrounded by baseball all the time and grew up with a love for it." Johnston recalls. "And I had another passion, which was service in the military and leadership in general. Those became intertwined and led me to the Naval Academy."

Johnston grew up in Trenton, New Jersey, a relatively short drive away from both New York City and Philadelphia. His father, Karl, coached American Legion ball in the area for 30 years, and Johnston and his brothers contributed as bat boys. Watching his father coach solidified those two passions-baseball and leadership.

"My father was certainly one of my main role models," Johnston says. "I knew I wanted to be a coach ever since I watched him coach, and I saw how he was able to help others

through the game of baseball."



As a young ballplayer, Johnston also looked up to a few major league catchers, most notably the Phillies' Darren Daulton and, later, Jason Varitek of the Red Sox, his favorite team growing up. But by his teenage years, it was Johnston's high school peers who encouraged him to take the next step in becoming a leader.

"I had a couple of teammates on my football team in high school (at the Peddie School in Hightstown, N.J.) who really influenced me and inspired me to seek out leadership and go into the Naval Academy," he explains.

"Those were the three guys that were probably the biggest influences on my early career, both in the Navy and in baseball," he says.

After completing his degree, Johnston was drafted in the 42nd round of the MLB draft by the Oakland Athletics, but he was unable to join the club immediately due to his Navy service obligations. He had embarked on his first deployment aboard the U.S.S. Peleliu, based out of San Diego, Calif. He served as an officer on the Peleliu until the spring of 2008, when he joined the A's during Spring Training.

At the end of camp, Johnston was assigned to the club's Single-A affiliate, the Kane County (III.) Cougars, where he played in 36 games before being called back into service, this time in Bahrain.

Their words resonated. After graduating from high school, Johnston enrolled in the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, Md., where he played four years as a catcher for the Midshipmen baseball program and graduated in 2006 with a degree in Ocean Engineering.

During those four years, his desire to learn and lead continued to grow. He credits many of his Navy baseball coaches—namely Paul Kostacopoulos, Scott Friedholm, and Jason Ronai—with helping advise and guide him during that pivotal period of his life.

He then spent the remainder of his service time aboard the U.S.S. Curts for nearly three years before returning to the A's in time for Spring Training in 2011.

Johnston speaks of his time in the Navy with gratitude, crediting his service with helping him further develop his leadership skills.

"The thing about being in the military in general is that it's a laboratory for leadership," he says. "You get a lot of opportunities to fail and succeed and learn."

After a stint in extended spring training and one month catching for Oakland's High-A team in Stockton, Calif., Johnston retired as a player in the summer of 2011 to pursue a career in coaching.

He says that there are considerable parallels in approach and values between the military and baseball, and that his experiences in the Navy helped him further develop a strong mindset well-suited for coaching.

"It's about helping people get better, letting them know you care about them, and just helping them achieve their goals," Johnston says. "That's leadership, that's service, and I was just lucky enough to be in the military where I had the opportunity to practice (those skills)."

Johnston began his coaching career in late 2011 at the University of California at San Diego, where he spent four seasons working largely with Tritons catchers before moving on to a similar role at the University of North Carolina at Asheville. There, he worked under head coach Scott Friedholm, who had coached him at the Naval Academy. After four years in Asheville, he returned to UCSD and helped lead the Tritons to a Division-Il College World Series appearance in 2019.

In 2020, Johnston landed an opportunity with the Pirates organization. He was tabbed to manage the Bucs' short-season affiliate in Morgantown, West Virginia before the Covid-19 pandemic wiped out the Minor League Baseball season and MLB brought wholesale changes to teams' affiliation structures.

Now, approaching his first managerial opportunity in a full-length season in Bradenton, he looks forward to the new challenge.

"I'm just looking forward to getting these guys to understand how to execute on a daily basis and win baseball games," Johnston says. "It's a great opportunity to make an impact on their careers and help them springboard to the next level."

With the recent additions of talented prospects to the Pirates organization via trades this past offseason, he says it's an exciting time for the Marauders in particular.

"As a staff, we're excited about the guys we get to work with, and I think we'll see a lot of learning going on quickly."

And with his well-tested leadership skills in hand, Johnston is ready to lead this year's group of Pirates prospects through a successful season.





BRADENTON, Fla. — The year is 1923. New York state has just revoked Prohibition law. The St. Louis Cardinals are wearing numbered uniforms for the first time. The first nonstop North American transcontinental flight has just been completed. And a brandnew ballpark has opened in Bradenton, Fla., near the intersection of 9th Street West and 17th Avenue West.

Whenever you visit LECOM Park, take some time to soak in the history. There's almost a century worth of stories rooted at this baseball cathedral, which will celebrate its 100th birthday in just two years.









According to legend, Hall of Fame Cardinals pitcher Dizzy Dean enjoyed Bradenton and its ballpark (then known as City Park) so much in the 1930s that he bought a local gas station and hung out there during his downtime, birthing the Cardinals' team nickname of the time, the "Gashouse Gang."

Then there's Hank Aaron, who played his very first major league games in Bradenton as a Milwaukee Braves rookie during Spring Training of 1954. Twenty years later, he shattered Babe Ruth's career home run record.

As the oldest active Spring Training stadium and the third-oldest ballpark in which Major League Baseball is played (only Fenway Park and Wrigley Field are older), LECOM Park, known as McKechnie Field from 1962 to 2017, has hosted generations worth of legends.

Before the Pirates settled here in 1969, MLB saw a trend of transience when it came to finding a spring home. The St. Louis Cardinals (1923-24; 1930-36), Philadelphia Phillies (1925-27), Boston Red Sox (1928-29), Boston Bees (1938-40), Boston/Milwaukee Braves (1948-62), and the Kansas City/Oakland Athletics (1963-1968) made Bradenton their spring home. This gave area natives and visitors alike the opportunity to watch stars ranging from Rogers Hornsby to Catfish Hunter. From Frankie Frisch to Eddie Mathews. From Warren Spahn to Reggie Jackson.

But the Pirates' residence is the second-longest active stay among MLB teams at its Spring Training ballpark, behind only the Detroit Tigers in Lakeland. Current Pirates stars like Ke'Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds tread on the same ground that Roberto Clemente and Willie Stargell once graced.

The historic ballpark has also hosted two previous minor league teams, the Bradenton Growers (Florida State League, 1923-26) and the Bradenton Explorers (Senior Professional Baseball Association, 1989-90). But when the Bradenton Marauders joined the Manatee County

community in April 2010, it kicked off a new era. The Marauders stormed onto the scene with a resounding 18-3 win over the Fort Myers Miracle in the team's inaugural game on April 8, 2010. In ten seasons of play, the Marauders have finished with a winning record seven times and have sent nearly 100 former players to the major leagues.

With the Pirates now having completed their 53rd Spring Training in Bradenton, the Marauders will eagerly welcome Minor League Baseball back to Bradenton in 2021 as LECOM Park nears it milestone anniversary.



FOR YOUR INFORMATION

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICES

A valid government issued photo ID with a listed birth date is required for the purchase of alcoholic beverages, regardless of age, inside of LECOM Park. "We card 21 to 101. No ID, No Beer." There is a limit of two alcoholic beverages per transaction for each person of legal drinking age.

ATM (AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE)

ATM machines provided by PNC Bank are available in the main concourse behind home plate and in the outfield building for fan convenience.

BAG SEARCH

Bags will not be permitted at LECOM Park with the exception of small clutch purses (4"x 6"), medical and diaper bags. All bags are subject to inspection upon entry of the ballpark.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of an emergency at LECOM Park, please follow the directions of Marauders employees, ushers, and law enforcement personnel and listen to the instructions given over the public address system.

FACE COVERINGS

Fans ages 2 years and older will be required to wear face coverings while in the facility. Coverings may only be removed to eat or drink while in a stationary location.

FAN INTERFERENCE

In the interest of player and guest safety, LECOM Park maintains a zero tolerance policy regarding fan interference with a ball in play or a player during the game. Failure to comply with the policy will result in removal from the ballpark.

FIRST AID LOCATION AND PROCEDURES

Should you have a medical emergency or need medical assistance, please alert the nearest LECOM Park employee. The Manatee Memorial Hospital First Aid Station is located on the third base side of the concourse across from the third base entry gate.

GATES OPEN

Gates open one hour prior to game time for Marauders ticket holders.

LOST AND FOUND

Found articles should be turned in to Guest relations, located underneath home plate. The Guest relations staff will record pertinent information and lost articles will be cataloged and maintained until the end of the season in the LECOM Park Ticket Office. To check lost and found on nongame days, call (941) 747-3031 and ask for LECOM Park Lost & Found.

LOST CHILDREN/MISSING PERSONS

Guests should report any missing person to a Marauders representative or Bradenton police officer. Gameday staff will work closely with LECOM Park security personnel to locate the missing individual.

MERCHANDISE

The Marauders Clubhouse Store is the premier outlet for Marauders merchandise in Bradenton. Hundreds of different items are available at the Marauders Clubhouse Store, located next to the LECOM Park Ticket Office. Fans may also view a full-scale merchandise catalog on the Marauders official website at marauders.milbstore.com.

RAINOUTS

In the event a regulation game is not played on its scheduled date, tickets may be exchanged for a subsequent Marauders game at LECOM Park during the 2021 season (subject to availability). A refund may also be requested. A rainout refund may only be requested if the tickets were purchased directly through the LECOM Park Box Office, tickets.com, or bradentonmarauders.com. Only the ticket holder who originally purchased the ticket is eligible for a refund. All refund requests must be submitted within 90 days of the date of the cancelled game. Original purchases via credit card will be refunded to the same card. Original purchases via check or cash will be refunded by check and take 8-10 weeks to process. Refund request forms can be found online at bradentonmarauders.com.

RESTROOMS

There are four men's and four women's restrooms located at LECOM Park. Two sets of restrooms are located on the first base side in the fan plaza, one set is located on the third base side, and there is one set in the outfield concessions building. There is one family restroom on the first base side in the fan plaza and one family restroom in the outfield building.

TOBACCO POLICY

In consideration of the health and comfort of others, the use of tobacco products including electronic chemical delivery devices such as e-cigarettes is not permitted in LECOM.

UMBRELLA POLICY

For the safety and viewing enjoyment of all fans, umbrellas are permitted in the ballpark, but may not be open during play.
