2017 MILB RECAP

The Bisons have drawn at least 500,000 fans at Coca Cola Field each year since becoming a Blue Jays affiliate in 2013 and the previous season was no exception. More than 525,000 fans came out to see the Bisons play during the 2017 season, an average of over 8,000 per game in the seats. The Buffalo fans were treated to an incredibly talented roster throughout the season, as 40 different players with previous Major League experience put on a Bisons jersey. 12 more players were called up from Buffalo to make their Major League debut during the season.

CF Roemon Fields paced the Bison's offense from the leadoff spot, finishing fifth in the International League's batting title chase and leading the league with 43 steals. Behind the plate, Buffalo received strong offensive contributions from C Raffy Lopez and C Mike Ohlman, who tied for the team lead with 12 homers each, and late season call-up C Danny Jansen (.328/.423/.552).

On the mound, Carlos Ramirez threw 14.0 scoreless innings out of the Buffalo bullpen to complete an incredible minor league season. In 37.2 innings between New Hampshire and Buffalo, Ramirez did not allow an earned run, leading to a much-deserved September call-up for the converted outfielder. LHP Tim Mayza was nearly as dominant, allowing just two runs in 19.1 innings, good for an ERA of 0.93 and an August call-up to Toronto.

A team-record 14 former Fisher Cats made their MLB debuts in 2017, including six who began the season in New Hampshire. OF Anthony Alford became the first position player in franchise history to make the jump from Double-A to the majors, and finished the season with a team-high .310 batting average in 68 games.

RHP Chris Rowley, a former first lieutenant in the U.S. Army, headlined the pitching staff in the first half of the season with a 1.73 ERA and 0.81 WHIP before winning his big league debut on August 12. SS Richard Urena, LHP Tim Mayza, and RHP Carlos Ramirez also suited up for the Blue Jays by season's end, promising a bright future in Toronto.

In a pitching rotation loaded with prospects like RHP Sean Reid-Foley and RHP Jon Harris, it was LHP Ryan Borucki who stole the show after joining the team in July. Through his first three Double-A starts, he allowed one run in 21 innings (0.43 ERA) with 18 strikeouts and three walks.

The Fisher Cats hosted the Eastern League All-Star Game in 2017, with the hometown East All-Stars earning a 7-1 win behind New Hampshire stars like IF Gunnar Heidt, RHP Dusty Isaacs and breakout prospect C Danny Jansen.

The Dunedin Blue Jays won their first championship in franchise history in 2017, sweeping a winner-take-all road double header against the Tampa Yankees to take home the Florida State League's North Division title and a share of the league title after Hurricane Irma forced the cancelation of the championship series.

The Dunedin squad outscored the rest of the Florida State League by a considerable margin (642 runs compared to 580 by the next closest team) thanks to a power-packed lineup. RF Connor Panas led the FSL in home runs with 18 and added 3 more during the championship series. Mid-season call-ups 3B Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.333 average, 6 homers) and SS Bo Bichette (.323 average, 10 stolen bases) helped spark the team down the stretch. IF Juan Kelly led the FSL in runs batted in (68), and 2B Cavan Biggio paced the league in runs scored (75).

On the mound, RHP Jordan Romano finished second in the FSL with 138 strikeouts. RHP Josh DeGraaf (3.32 ERA), RHP T.J. Zeuch (3.38 ERA), and LHP Ryan Borucki (3.58 ERA) combined with Romano (3.39 ERA) to give Dunedin a formidable starting staff. The team boasted one of the league's best bullpens in the second half thanks to the additions of LHP Kirby Sneed (8 saves, 1.36 ERA), RHP Jackson McClelland (7 saves, 1.07 ERA), and RHP Zach Jackson (4 saves, 2.03 ERA).

The left side of the 2017 Lansing Lugnuts infield was the talk of the Class-A Midwest League. 19-year-old SS Bo Bichette and 18-year-old 3B Vladimir Guerrero Jr. amassed hits, headlines, and hardware, representing the Lugnuts and Blue Jays in both the MWL All-Star Game and MLB All-Star Futures Game. Bichette, who batted .384 with 109 hits and a 1.071 OPS in 70 games in Lansing, finished the year by capturing the league batting crown, the MWL Most Valuable Player award, MWL Prospect of the Year award, and Minor League Baseball Offensive Player of the Year. Guerrero, the toughest batter to strike out in the circuit, added a .316 average and .888 OPS in 71 games – and caught a surprise ceremonial first pitch from Vladimir Guerrero Sr. on Father's Day.

As a team, the 63-73 Lugnuts threw an Opening Day Block Party, won their 1500th game in franchise history, dropped Easter Eggs from a helicopter, paused play to watch the Solar Eclipse, and drew the largest July 3-4 crowd for any team below the Triple-A level: 11,449.

Alongside the Bo and Vlad Jr. Show, the Lugnuts received memorable performances from IF Bradley Jones, who posted a .560 slugging percentage in 49 games and was named the MWL April Player of the Month; OF Edward Olivares, who hit for the fifth cycle in team history on April 24th; OF Nick Sinay, who set a new Midwest League single-season record with 38 hit-by-pitches; and trustworthy relievers Zach Jackson, Jackson McClelland, Kirby Sneed, Nick Hartman, and Jared Carkuff, each of whom earned a promotion thanks to consistent dominance.

For the fourth time in the last seven seasons, the Vancouver Canadians took home the Northwest League championship in 2017. The team also continued its dominance at the box office, topping the league in attendance for the third straight season with 239,527 fans passing through the gates of Scotiabank Field.

A pair of 1st round picks helped lead Vancouver to the championship. SS Logan Warmoth hit .306 during the regular season and knocked a go-ahead two-run single in the fifth inning of the deciding game of the championship series against the Eugene Emeralds, helping Vancouver to a 2-1 win in the title-clinching game. Fellow 1st rounder Nate Pearson posted a miniscule 0.95 ERA in 7 starts for the Canadians, allowing just 2 runs in 19.0 innings pitched while striking out 24 batters. In his last regular season start of the year, Pearson struck out 10 Spokane batters in just 4.0 innings while allowing just one hit.

Complementing strong offensive performances by C Riley Adams (.305/.374/.438) and SS Kevin Vicuna (.280 average, 14 steals), Vancouver boasted one of the best bullpens in the league. RHP William Ouellette led the league with 13 saves. RHP Chris Hall (1.49 ERA), LHP Jake Fishman (1.76 ERA), RHP Justin Dillon (1.96 ERA), and RHP Orlando Pascual (2.18 ERA) combined with Ouellette to fill out the Canadian's formidable relief core.

With a roster that featured both the Appalachian League Player of the Year and the league's Pitcher of the Year, the Bluefield Blue Jays finished the 2017 season with a 46-22 record, the best in the league. Although they fell to Pulaski in the playoffs, the Blue Jays returned the famed Mercer Cup to Bluefield during the regular season, winning their season series with their cross-town rivals, the Princeton Rays, 9-2.

The Blue Jays pitching staff finished second in the league with a 3.81 team ERA and 1.30 WHIP. LHP **Randy Ponder** led the rotation, taking home the Appalachian League Pitcher of the Year and All-Star honors thanks to a league-leading 2.51 ERA. The Bluefield bullpen was equally strong, finishing first in the league in saves (26) and holds (22). RHP **Ty Tice** was dominant as the team's closer, leading the league with 12 saves and posting a 1.05 ERA.

On the offensive end, **1B Ryan Noda** took home the league's batting title, posting an incredible .364/.507/.575 slash line and seven home runs. Along with his batting crown, Noda was award the Appalachian League Player of the Year and was selected to the All-Star team. **C Yorman Rodriguez** joined Noda on the leaderboards, finishing third in the Appy League with a .346 average.

MANAGER

CASEY CANDAELE

2018 is Casey Candaele's first season managing an affiliated baseball team. As a player, Candaele played 18 seasons in professional baseball, including nine in the Major Leagues with the Montreal Expos, Houston Astros, and Cleveland Indians. He finished 4th in National League Rookie of the Year voting in 1987, hitting .272 in 138 games in his first full season. During his career, he was known as a hard-nosed versatile player who appeared at every defensive position besides catcher and pitcher in the Major Leagues. He retired as a player in 2000 after over 2,100 games in the Majors and Minors. For the past two seasons, he has been the Seattle Mariners' First Base Coach and worked previously in the Texas Rangers' system as a Field Coordinator and Infield and Base Running Coach.



PITCHING COACH

MARK RIGGINS

Mark Riggins returns for his second season in Dunedin in 2018. A former Florida State League All-Star as a player, he retired and began coaching in 1984, ascending through the St. Louis Cardinals Minor League affiliates before being named their Major League Pitching Coach for the 1995 season. From 1996-2007, he was the Cardinals Minor League Pitching Coordinator. He took the same position with the Chicago Cubs from 2008-2010 and served as the Cubs Major League pitching coach in 2011. From 2012-2015, he was the Minor League Pitching Coordinator for the Cincinnati Reds and was named their Major League Pitching Coach to begin the 2016 season.



HITTING COACH

DONNIE MURPHY

Donnie Murphy joins Dunedin as the team's Hitting Coach in 2018. Like Candaele, Murphy played nine seasons in the Major Leagues as a player, appearing with the Kansas City Royals, Oakland Athletics, Florida Marlins, Chicago Cubs, and Texas Rangers between 2004 and 2014. Murphy retired as a player in 2015 and served as the A-Lansing Lugnuts Hitting Coach during the 2016 and 2017 seasons. In 2017, Murphy guided Lansing hitters to a first place finish in the Midwest League in on-base percentage (.351) and the second-best ranking in average (.268), runs (685), and on-base plus slugging (.742).



COACH

MICHEL ABREU

Coach Michel Abreu begins his second season coaching in Dunedin in 2018 following a 13-year playing career in the minor leagues and foreign leagues. An accomplished hitter, Abreu won the 2006 Eastern League (AA) batting championship (.332), the 2009 Puerto Rican League MVP, the 2012 Mexican League batting title, and the 2013 Japanese Pacific League homerun crown. Across 13 professional seasons, Abreu hit .309 with 239 home runs.

First Aid: If you need first aid or are aware of a medical emergency, an usher or security personnel will assist you. Please notify an usher or security officer if such aid is needed.

Foul Balls: Fans are permitted to keep balls that land in the seating area as souvenirs. However, fans are not allowed on the field to retrieve a ball or interfere with a ball in play. FOUL BALLS MAY BE DANGEROUS, PLEASE BE ALERT AT ALL TIMES AND BE AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL HAZARDS.

Gates Open: The gates at Dunedin Stadium will open one hour prior to the scheduled first pitch.
