

# REHAB REHASH

# Sean Manaea (July 8, 2019)

Oakland A's right-hander Sean Manaea is coming back from rotator cuff surgery that he underwent in September of 2018. He last pitched on August 24, 2018 for the A's at Minnesota where he worked five innings, allowing an unearned run on five hits. For Oakland in 2018, he went 12-9 with a 3.59 ERA in 27 starts, including an April 21 no-hitter versus the Boston Red Sox at the Coliseum. Manaea has made one other appearance in a Ports uniform when he made a rehab start on June 24, 2016 versus San Jose where he allowed two runs on two hits over 3 2/3 innings. Manaea (0-1) started the game on Monday night for Stockton and allowed four hits in the first inning, including RBI singles from Luis Basabe and Alex King that gave the Rawhide a 2-0 lead. A pair of errors in the second inning committed by third baseman Trace Loehr led to two unearned runs in the second as Visalia doubled its lead to 4-0. Manaea worked into the third and gave up a pair of singles and was lifted with two on and one out. Brady Feigl came on and gave up back-to-back RBI singles to Tim Susnara and Jorge Perez that made it a 7-0 Rawhide advantage. Two of the three runs in the third were charged to Manaea, who

suffered the loss after going 2 1/3 innings and allowing six runs (four earned) on seven hits while striking out two.

# Jharel Cotton (July 9, 2019)

Oakland A's right-hander Jharel Cotton is returning from Tommy John surgery that took place in March of 2018 and a setback that required right hamstring debridement surgery on June 6 of this year. Cotton has made three appearances (two starts) with Stockton this season and has allowed five runs on six hits (including three homers) in seven total innings worked for the Ports. His last appearance came on May 28 in relief versus Modesto when he tossed two perfect frames while striking out three. Cotton (1-1) took over in the seventh for Stockton on a rehab assignment and set the side down in order in his first inning. In the eighth, Cotton issued a leadoff walk to Alex King, King would score with two outs in the inning on an RBI double by Jancarlos Cintron that gave Visalia a 2-1 lead. Cotton would pick up the victory by game's end and allowed one run on one hit while walking one and striking out one in his two innings. He threw 31 pitches, 20 for strikes.
