# ON THIS DAY IN PC

## July 4, 2012: Ports 14, Blaze 3

The Stockton Ports went on the road and spoiled the party for the Bakersfield Blaze in front of a sellout crowd. Stockton lit up Bakersfield pitching for a season-high 17 hits en route to a 14-3 win at Sam Lynn Ballpark. Every Ports player had at least one hit in the contest, and all but one Stockton batter (Robinson) came around to score at least one time. Josh Whitaker finished his night with a team-high four RBI as he went 2-for-5 with a double and a home run. Oberacker scored three times for Stockton.

## July 5, 2011: Ports 17, Mavericks 4

On a rare night in High Desert where the wind was non-existent, the Stockton Ports offense still found a way to put up crooked numbers. The Ports pounded out a season-high 17 runs and matched a season-high 19 hits while launching six home runs en route to a 17-4 rout of the High Desert Mavericks. The Ports' 20th win in their last 21 games was also their 11th straight versus a South Division opponent. All four High Desert runs came off Ports starter James Simmons who went 2.2 innings and allowed eight hits while

striking out three. Stockton took the lead in the 4th and never looked back. On his 22nd birthday, Conner Hoehn came on and pitched two scoreless innings to close out the game for Stockton. With a home run on Tuesday as part of a season-best 5-for-6 effort with 5 RBI, Michael Choice had homered in four straight games. Petey Paramore, with his 2-for-5 effort, drove in four runs on the night.

## July 6, 2011: Ports 13, Mavericks 6

For the second straight night, the Stockton Ports reached their season-high hit total. For the fifth straight night, Michael Choice hit a home run. These seem to be the winning combinations these days as the Ports won their 21st game in their last 22 and earned their fifth series sweep in the last six series, beating the High Desert Mavericks on Wednesday night by a final of 13-6. The Ports are now 20-4 against South Division opponents. Ports starter Rob Gilliam (10-4) would earn his league-leading 10th win, going five innings and allowing six runs on 10 hits while striking out seven. All 10 hits he allowed were singles. In the series, the Ports hit 14 home runs, while the Mavericks were held homer-less. Gilmartin finished the

night 4-for-6 with two home runs and 6 RBI. Choice went 3-for-5 with a home run and 3 RBI, and Gil from the nine-hole went 3-for-5 with 2 RBI. Coleman (2-for-5) and Ryan Lipkin (3-for-4) each had an RBI on the night.

## July 7, 2014: Ports 7, Giants 0

For the third time since the All-Star break, Renato Nunez had a multi-home run game for the Stockton Ports. Nunez drove in six of the seven Stockton runs with a pair of homers, including a grand slam, as the Ports beat the San Jose Giants by a final of 7-0. Nunez went 2-for-4 with 6 RBI for Stockton, matching the most RBI in a game by a Ports player, a mark set by Daniel Robertson on Friday night in Stockton's 17-6 win in San Jose. Omar Duran worked two-and-a-third scoreless innings in relief the Ports starter, while Kris Hall pitched around a leadoff walk in the ninth inning to preserve Stockton's fifth shutout victory of the season.

## July 8, 2009: Ports 12, Rawhide 10

Wednesday night's game started as a laugher for the Stockton Ports. By game's end, the Ports narrowly avoided disaster. With

Stockton holding a 12-2 lead, the Visalia Rawhide scored eight unanswered runs and got the potential winning run to the plate in the bottom of the ninth. In the end, however, the Boys of Banner Island were able to hang on for a 12-10 victory at Recreation Park. Michael Richard went 4-4 with three runs scored and two walks for Stockton. Ben Hornbeck (4-3) earned the win for the Ports, striking out eight in six innings of three-run ball.

## July 9, 2016: Ports 11, Giants 5

For the third straight night, the Stockton Ports scored five runs in the fifth inning. On Saturday night, it propelled them to an 11-5 win over the San Jose Giants at Municipal Stadium. The Ports victory was their first of the season in San Jose and it evened their four-game set with the Giants at a game apiece. The two first inning runs were the only runs allowed by Ports starter Heath Fillmyer (4-5), who went on to pick up the victory after working five innings and allowing four hits while striking out two. Fillmyer retired the final eight batters he faced. James Harris went 3-5 with two runs and an RBI, while Sandber Pimentel went 3-5 with four RBI and a three-run homer.

# PORTS SHINE IN MIDSUMMER CLASSIC

The North Division scored early and often in front of 4,846 fans at San Manuel Stadium to defeat the South Division, 7-1, in the California League All-Star Game on June 18.

The Ports sent six players to the contest, and all six saw action. **Nick Allen** led off and started at shortstop, and, despite going 0-3 with a strikeout, made a spectacular running play at short to nab a runner at first. **Lazaro Armenteros** batted sixth and started in left field, and reached three times – he walked, singled, reached on an error, and scored twice.

**Jameson Hannah**, who was a late, but well-deserved addition to the roster (replacing an injured Modesto Nut), went 1-3 with a two-RBI triple in the second inning. He later grounded out, scoring Armenteros again. Teammate **Alfonso Rivas** took over at first base for Visalia's Yoel Yanqui in the fifth inning, and reached base in both plate appearances – a single and a walk.

Both the North and South used nine pitchers each. Ports right-handers **Brady Feigl** and **Mitchell Jordan** each tossed clean innings –

Feigl with two punchouts in the fourth, and Jordan with one in the second inning. Neither allowed a baserunner.

The Home Run Derby format featured three sluggers from each division, and each was paired with a local youth baseball player. The combined home run total of the Cal League player and youth player factored into the scoring. Here's an excerpt from MiLB.com reporter Josh Jackson's game story: "The hometown South won Home Run Derby... Representing the North were Modesto's Cal Raleigh (five in the three-minute first round, Visalia's Camden Duzenack (six in round 1, five in the final round) and **Armenteros** (seven). Lancaster's Casey Golden (seven in Round 1, seven in the final round), Rancho Cucamonga's Connor Wong (two) and Lancaster's Luis Castro (zero) represented the South."
