Serves as an assistant coach (2018-present) for the Australian National Team and runs the performance department for Baseball South Australia. Attended Angelo State University (2008-2010) in San Angelo, TX where he graduated with a bachelor's degree in sport science while earning NCAA All-American honors twice (2009-2010).



PITCHING COACH - MATT HOCKENBERRY

Born: Dillsburg, PA... Resides: Philadelphia, PA... Former pitcher. Is in his fourth season as a coach at the professional level - and third (including 2020) with the BlueClaws - after a four-year playing career. MASK POLICY

Per Major League Baseball guidelines, masks will be required at all times when fans are inside the ballpark, except when eating or drinking in their assigned seating location.



SEATING OPTIONS

Fans with tickets in the seating bowl will be spread out in socially-distant pods of two, four, or six. Each pod will be at least 6-feet from any other pod. Additionally, fans will be able to purchase private picnic tables along the concourse and socially-distant pods on the outfield berms.





BAG POLICY

Bags are not permitted inside the ballpark. The only exceptions are soft sided clutches/purses/wallets under 4" x 7" and medical or childcare bags under 12" x 16" x 6".



ENTRANCE PROCEDURES

Gates will now open 95 minutes prior to first pitch (for example, 5:30 pm for a 7:05 pm game) to help spread out entry times. Ticket takers will wear masks and gloves and sit behind plexiglass. Fans will line up in a socially-distant manner along the plazas. Ticket holders with Early Entrance will enter through the First Base Gate only beginning 2 hours and 5 minutes before the game (5:00 for a 7:05 pm game)..

SIGNAGE AND MESSAGING

Fans will be reminded to stay at least 6-feet from others not in their party or those seated at different pods within the ballpark.





MOBILE TICKETING

Fans are encouraged to utilize the mobile ticketing options provided by our ticketing partner, TicketReturn. Fans can access their tickets via email or their TicketReturn account, or safely email or text tickets to others as needed.



FOOD & BEVERAGE FOOTPRINT

The BlueClaws are blessed with an expansive facility with a 360-degree concourse. As such, we will be utilizing the space that we have to best serve the variety of food and drink options available to fans and thus limiting lines at the concession stands in the process.



MOBILE CONCESSIONS

The BlueClaws will provide mobile concession ordering for fans for the first time this year. Fans will be instructed to access a QR code in the park, or visit a page on BlueClaws.com that will enable them to order food and drink through their phone. Three pickup locations will be available inside the ballpark.



FOOD VENDORS

In addition to mobile ordering detailed above, fans will have the opportunity to order from masked vendors who will roam the seating bowl and the ballpark with food and drink options for fans, once again limiting the need for fans to move about the ballpark in order to obtain food and drink.

GENERAL PROCEDURES

Members of the BlueClaws Clean Team will roam the ballpark to sanitize areas throughout the game. After each game, the stadium will undergo a significant clean with state-of-the-art cleaning supplies. Fans can be confident that each time they enter the ballpark, they will be stepping into a freshly sanitized facility.



RESTROOMS

The BlueClaws have four Men's Rooms, four Women's Rooms, and two Family Restrooms on the concourse level. Each will be sanitized throughout each game. Additionally, every-other urinal will be blocked off to further encourage social distancing within each restroom.



HAND SANITIZING STATIONS

Hand sanitizing stations will be set-up throughout the concourse as well as the Luxury Suite Level for fans to use as needed throughout the game. Fans will be encouraged through in-park messaging such as signage and PA-reads to wash their hands frequently throughout their time inside the ballpark.



ADDITIONAL AREAS

Other areas throughout the ballpark such as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws Team Store will be sanitized throughout the game. Game pieces from the Boardwalk area (such as rings from Ring Toss or darts from Balloon Darts) and Mini Golf Course (clubs and balls) will be sanitized thoroughly between uses. Staff members will be wearing masks and gloves as well.

The BlueClaws are greatly appreciative of everyone's cooperation as we work together to provide a safe environment to enjoy Jersey Shore BlueClaws baseball!

NOTE #1 - MOVING UP A LEVEL

This year, for the first time, the BlueClaws will play as a High-A affiliate of the Phillies. We had been the Phillies Low-A affiliate for our first 19 seasons. Essentially, we have flipped places with Clearwater. Now, players will go from Clearwater to the BlueClaws to Reading to Lehigh Valley to the Phillies, whereas in years past, they had gone from the BlueClaws to Clearwater and then up the ladder.

NOTE #2 - SOME NEW OPPONENTS

From 2001 through 2019, the BlueClaws played in the South Atlantic League. Now, we are playing in the High-A East League's Northern Division. Our divisional opponents are the Aberdeen Ironbirds (Orioles), Brooklyn Cyclones (Mets), Hudson Valley Renegades (Yankees), and Wilmington Blue Rocks (Nationals). We will also play a few teams from the Southern Division this year.



NOTE #3 - ANOTHER FIRST-ROUND PICK COMES TO THE SHORE

BlueClaws shortstop Bryson Stott is the 11th first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws. He was taken 14th overall in the 2019 draft out of UNLV. The Las Vegas native spent his first professional season with Williamsport in 2019 and also spent time at the Phillies alternate-site in Lehigh Valley during the summer of 2020.

The Phillies 2018 first-round pick, 3B Alec Bohm, played for the BlueClaws in the first month of the 2019 season and now the Phillies starting third baseman.

NOTE #4 – LOCAL PRODUCTS JOIN BLUECLAWS

The BlueClaws have two local products on this year's Opening Day roster. RHP Mike Adams is from Egg Harbor and played at Holy Spirit High School and Wagner College. The 26 year old was running a pitching performance center before signing with the Phillies in January. LHP Brian Marconi is from Marlton and played at Cherokee High School and George Mason University. He signed with the Phillies in 2019.

O&A WITH BLUECLAWS MANAGER

Chris Adamson was in spring training last year, preparing to manage the BlueClaws, when the baseball world shut down. He went back to his native Australia, and is back again, set to manage the BlueClaws in 2021. We sat down with Adamson, who goes by "Tank," to talk about his background.

Q: What was last spring like? A: We were there [in Clearwater] for about a month and there was a day where it started to slow down a little bit. They told us we were heading home and I was back in Australia two days later.

Q: What kinds of things did you do to stay in touch with everyone? A: The Phillies did an outstanding job in keeping people engaged. We've had to do a lot of Zoom calls between four and six every week which has been quite good so we can talk shop a bit and stay in tune with everything. We checked in with the players to make sure they are doing OK in these tough circumstances.

Q: How did you end up with the Phillies in the first place?

A: It probably started a little bit with some of the guys coming down in Australia – Cole Stobbe was one of them – and the dialogue started with me reporting on those guys and talking to the Phillies about their progress both on and off the field. So it was a little bit of a two-way street in terms of communications. From there I was in Japan with the national team and I got a text from Josh Bonifay, and a few phone calls later, here we are. Q: I know you're heavily involved in the analytics side of the sport as well. How did that come about for you? A: When I was studying in the states I got a degree in sports science with a focus in biomechanics as well. When I moved back to Australia, I was playing but also working at what was like a small college where I was in charge of teaching about anatomy, physiology, and biomechanics. So I had a pretty good idea about how the body worked and moves and I think it helped with my coaching. I'm definitely thankful for that opportunity.



Q: For awhile you ran Baseball South Australia. What went into that and what did you learn from the experience? A: Baseball South Australia – I was coaching the senior team and was looking after their younger players, running academies, doing coach education, and those things. Having a full time job in baseball in Australia was pretty rare so it was a great experience.

Q: How would you describe your managerial style?

A: The number one thing for me is communication and being able to build relationships with players and those around them. There are people from all different backgrounds. Spending time and building relationships is one of those key things. Unless the player knows that you are about him as a person and a player, the knowledge is a secondary thing. For us I want them to know that we're there for their best interest. That's one of the biggest things I try to focus on.

Q: Who were some Australian players you looked up to?

Growing up in Australia – Dave Nillson was my guy, being a catcher. Whenever you see an Australian in the big leagues punching above their weight, that's pretty cool. I'm family friends with Grant Balfour and seeing him go out there is pretty cool.



Q: Did you play any other sports? A: I grew up playing rugby my whole life. My dad played a lot of rugby too. Going down the baseball path was not necessarily the most logical one but I played rugby and cricket too. That's been one silver-lining through the whole thing [being at home] that I've been able to watch some rugby.

Q: Who is your favorite rugby team? A: The Penrith Panthers – all of New Jersey will be on the Penrith Panthers bandwagon.

Q: How'd you get into baseball? A: There was a kid on my street that was older than me and I tagged along to go to muni ball (tee ball) and they had a pretty good setup and good coaches and it was something I enjoyed straight off the bat. It was also a great social thing, and seeing the Dave Nisson's and Greame Lloyd's was exciting too. It was a bit left of center for an Australian kid back then but now it's pretty common.



Q: How did you get the nickname Tank?

A: I've had that since I was about 8 or 9 years old. Essentially, I was a pretty big kid and I was running around, bigger than the other kids. I was slow as a wet week – if it's been raining all week it feels like the week goes forever. A coach just called me Tank one day and it stuck, to the point where a lot of people in baseball didn't know what my real name was. ◆

Baseball's Future is Here!






20TH ANNIVERSARY FEATURE OPENING NIGHT 2001

April 11, 2001 was a day that will live in Jersey Shore history - the day of the first BlueClaws home game. This year, the BlueClaws will celebrate their 20th anniversary season, but it really all traces to April 11th and what turned into a rain-shortened game against the Hickory Crawdads (Pirates).

Parking lots opened at 4:30 and on-field festivities began at 5:30 pm. Included were remarks from State Senator Robert Singer and Ray Coles from the Lakewood Development Corporation (presently the Mayor of Lakewood). Included in the pre-game festivities was the "Ceremonial First Pour" from the Coors Light RAT Trap in centerfield with representatives of Shore Point Distributing and 95.9 WRAT.

"I've seen him over the years as you run across people in baseball," said Mackanin said of Legg. "Certainly every time I do see him I bring up that picture." Mackanin recalled coming into Lakewood with the Crawdads to open the Jersey Shore's new ballpark. "I remember seeing a beautiful minor league facility. It was really fun to have a game there. It was beautiful. One thing that was lacking was a urinal in the visitor's dugout. If someone had to go to the bathroom they had to go through the stands to get to the clubhouse [the tunnel was not ready for the first homestand]. You always look forward to playing somewhere you've never been before. It's fun to see something like Lakewood."

Tina Kaye sang the National Anthem at 6:24 pm with both teams lined up on the baselines behind her. Doves were released and there was a scheduled flyover from the New Jersey Air Guard from McGuire Air Force Base.



Just after 6:35 pm, Ryan Carter, a lefthander from UCLA, threw the first pitch in GPU Energy Park (later FirstEnergy Park) history.

Geoff Brown was the BlueClaws General Manager from November of 1999 through January of 2013 and in a summer interview recalled the build-up to Opening Night and the various ups and downs leading into the big day.

"A month or so out, we realized in the concessions stands there weren't any pass through windows. You have your prep area in the back and the service area in the front but there was only one door. There were supposed to be three or four pass through windows so we had to go back in and knock holes in the walls," he said.



"I remember the night before, late, we were putting together those standing tables in the picnic area. They had just arrived and we were putting those together around midnight," he said. "The other thing I remember, and I recommended this because it went so well, we did a stadium flush. We brought in the morning DJ of 94.3 the Point and he came in with a bunch of listeners. We had a listener at every single toilet and flush at the same time. We wanted to make sure the plumbing would work with a full ballpark. I don't know what



would have happened if it didn't!"

Members of the press as well as the ballpark construction team recalled the first game as well.

Kevin Williams, WOBM / Townsquare Media - "Anyone who was anyone at the jersey Shore was there that night. Every elected official, it was really a big deal. You would have hoped for a nicer night but you know what the weather could be like. If it wasn't the home opener, it never would have been played...I had four tickets behind home plate in the first row. My kids were young at the time and they were all pepped up to go to the BlueClaws. My daughter, who was 10, she would come and sit, ask me for money and I'd see herein the seventh inning. I'd like to think that for a lot of those special moments, especially in the early years, I was there." (You can listen to our interview with Kevin here.)

Dan Cichalski, Asbury Park Press - "I know it was a crowded press box. In addition to me, we had a columnist or two and a news reporter. I don't know how early I got there but it must have been so early. You never would have expected a crowd like that for 50 degrees and drizzly. But 7,500 people weren't going to let the people miss the first game in BlueClaws history." Thomas DeBartolo, Monmouth Ocean County Building Trades - "We all went to the game, seeing the first game there. My family came and pointed out all the stuff that we worked on and had done. Normally you build a building and walk away from it and never go back. Every time I go back, I tell my wife ad nauseum that I put that up and I hung that. You keep coming back to the facility and seeing the stuff I worked on brings back good memories...I have fond memories of the job because we had good guys working on it. It went very smoothly. I thought at the time it was a little crazy to put a baseball stadium in Lakewood, and didn't think it would catch on. But they're always doing something over there. On my end, I'm very proud that I worked on the job and enjoy going back every year."



Bill Morros, Epic Management - "I remember roaming around and hanging out with Ray Coles and working our way through the luxury boxes and drinking a beer at every stop! I was lucky that the project got assigned to me. I'm a big baseball fan and it was satisfying to be able to be involved working on something that you enjoy watching as a fan." ◆
