



Serves as an assistant coach (2018-present) for the Australian National Team and runs the performance department for Baseball South Australia. Attended Angelo State University (2008-2010) in San Angelo, TX where he graduated with a bachelor's degree in sport science while earning NCAA All-American honors twice (2009-2010).



PITCHING COACH - MATT HOCKENBERRY

Born: Dillsburg, PA... Resides: Philadelphia, PA... Former pitcher. Is in his fourth season as a coach at the professional level - and third (including 2020) with the BlueClaws - after a four-year playing career. 
MASK POLICY


RESTROOMS



MORE POWER TO YOU



NOTE #1 - WALK-OFF THIS WAY

Jonathan Guzman delivered the first walk-off win in Jersey Shore BlueClaws history with his game-winning single in the win on May 22nd against Winston-Salem. The BlueClaws trailed the game 2-0 but got solo homers from Herbert Iser in the seventh and Keaton Greenwalt in the eighth to tie the game, setting the stage for Guzman's heroics in the 10th inning.

NOTE #2 - JUST GRAND

Going back at least 10 years, the Blue-Claws had not hit grand slams in back to back games. That is, until last week. On May 26th in Hudson Valley, Nate Fassnacht hit a 10th inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie in the 10th inning. Jhailyn Ortiz (more on him below) hit a grand slam on May 27th, one of two home runs he hit in that game. Ortiz now has 50 career minor league home runs.

NOTE #3 - HUNTER ON THE MARK

Hunter Markwardt joined the BlueClaws on May 13th and has made an immediate impact. Over his first 15 games, he hit .322 while hitting safely in 13 of those games. He added three hits in three of those games as well while playing strong defense in both centerfield and right field and stealing six bases. He was a 13th round pick in 2019 out of Oklahoma Christian.

NOTE #4 - BACK TO BACK AT HOME

The BlueClaws will have three different sets of consecutive home series this year: June 1 – 13 vs Brooklyn and Wilmington, June 29 – July 11 vs Hudson Valley and Wilmington, and July 27 – August 8 vs Brooklyn and Aberdeen. In all three instances, the BlueClaws will play 12 home games in 13 days. It's the first time the BlueClaws have played this many home games together since 2007 when they had a stretch of 13 home games in 14 days, split by Memorial Day.















At its core, baseball boils down to a few things. First, get on base. Next, when you can drive the ball, drive the ball. So far so good on both counts for Bryson Stott. The BlueClaws shortstop is in his first full season of play in the Phillies organization, after the 2020 season was wiped out for the 2019 first round pick.

Through May, the left-handing hitting Stott led the BlueClaws with five home runs and led all of High-A East with .453 on-base percentage. He drew 22 walks in the first 23 BlueClaws games, putting him seventh among all players across Minor League Baseball's 120 teams. Meanwhile, he has shown the ability to drive the ball not just to right field, but the other way into left field. His first BlueClaws home run, which came in the third game of the season, was deposited onto the berm beyond the left field fence at FirstEnergy Park.

"As I've gotten older, it's been more of an 'I can drive it that way so that's what I'm going to do," he said. "It's been a thing with me and [Phillies minor league hitting coordinator Jason] Ochart that I can hit for power that way and not have to rely on right field for home runs and doubles, so that's been big."

As for the walks, he added: "Staying in your strike zone has always been a big thing for me. It's always been there and

I hate striking out so being able to take my walks and understand the zone has been big for me and will continue to be big for me."

Stott is the 14th first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and follows Alec Bohm to the Shore, the third overall pick in the 2018 draft who began the 2019 season with the BlueClaws. Stott, however, already has a good amount of experience around the big league players. He spent parts of two spring trainings and last summer at the alternate site after the minor league season was cancelled.

"It was great, being around those guys, where you want to end up one day. Seeing those guys carry themselves and how they go about their business was the biggest thing for me," he said. "Didi's [Gregorious] awesome. Jean's [Segura] awesome. Just talking to those guys and picking their brains was fun.



"Not everybody got to go and play so being able to go was a blessing. Some days were three on three where coaches played the field and you'd get seven or eight at bats and not missing out on the development was a big thing."



Spring training this year also meant rooming with longtime friend Bryce Harper. The two Las Vegas natives met when Harper's older sister was a cheerleader for Stott's mother while in high school. Stott, meanwhile, was nine years old when Harper graced the cover of Sports Illustrated.

"There were umpires saying he'd be the first pick when he was 9 years old. Seeing him on SI with the eye black and then all the younger guys started wearing eye black," Stott recalled. "You wanted to do stuff that he was doing. He was the first of my generation looked at because he was Vegas baseball." •



20TH ANNIVERSARY FEATURE OPENING NIGHT 2001

April 11, 2001 was a day that will live in Jersey Shore history - the day of the first BlueClaws home game. This year, the BlueClaws will celebrate their 20th anniversary season, but it really all traces to April 11th and what turned into a rain-shortened game against the Hickory Crawdads (Pirates).

Parking lots opened at 4:30 and on-field festivities began at 5:30 pm. Included were remarks from State Senator Robert Singer and Ray Coles from the Lakewood Development Corporation (presently the Mayor of Lakewood). Included in the pre-game festivities was the "Ceremonial First Pour" from the Coors Light RAT Trap in centerfield with representatives of Shore Point Distributing and 95.9 WRAT.



In the photo above, BlueClaws manager Greg Legg shakes hands with Crawdads manager Pete Macakanin. The two would later be re-united within in the Phillies organization.

"I've seen him over the years as you run across people in baseball," said Mackanin said of Legg. "Certainly every time I do see him I bring up that picture."

Mackanin recalled coming into Lakewood with the Crawdads to open the Jersey Shore's new ballpark. "I remember seeing a beautiful minor league facility. It was really fun to have a game there. It was beautiful. One thing that was lacking was a urinal in the visitor's dugout. If someone had to go to the bathroom they had to go through the stands to get to the clubhouse [the tunnel was not ready for the first homestand]. You always look forward to playing somewhere you've never been before. It's fun to see something like Lakewood."

Tina Kaye sang the National Anthem at 6:24 pm with both teams lined up on the baselines behind her. Doves were released and there was a scheduled flyover from the New Jersey Air Guard from McGuire Air Force Base.



Just after 6:35 pm, Ryan Carter, a lefthander from UCLA, threw the first pitch in GPU Energy Park (later FirstEnergy Park) history.

Geoff Brown was the BlueClaws General Manager from November of 1999 through January of 2013 and in a summer interview recalled the build-up to Opening Night and the various ups and downs leading into the big day.

"A month or so out, we realized in the concessions stands there weren't any pass through windows. You have your prep area in the back and the service area in the front but there was only one door. There were supposed to be three or four pass through windows so we had to go back in and knock holes in the walls," he said.



"I remember the night before, late, we were putting together those standing tables in the picnic area. They had just arrived and we were putting those together around midnight," he said. "The other thing I remember, and I recommended this because it went so well, we did a stadium flush. We brought in the morning DJ of 94.3 the Point and he came in with a bunch of listeners. We had a listener at every single toilet and flush at the same time. We wanted to make sure the plumbing would work with a full ballpark. I don't know what



would have happened if it didn't!"

Members of the press as well as the ballpark construction team recalled the first game as well.

Kevin Williams, WOBM / Townsquare Media - "Anyone who was anyone at the jersey Shore was there that night. Every elected official, it was really a big deal. You would have hoped for a nicer night but you know what the weather could be like. If it wasn't the home opener, it never would have been played...I had four tickets behind home plate in the first row. My kids were young at the time and they were all pepped up to go to the BlueClaws. My daughter, who was 10, she would come and sit, ask me for money and I'd see herein the seventh inning. I'd like to think that for a lot of those special moments, especially in the early years, I was there." (You can listen to our interview with Kevin here.)


Dan Cichalski, Asbury Park Press - "I know it was a crowded press box. In addition to me, we had a columnist or two and a news reporter. I don't know how early I got there but it must have been so early. You never would have expected a crowd like that for 50 degrees and drizzly. But 7,500 people weren't going to let the people miss the first game in BlueClaws history." Thomas DeBartolo, Monmouth Ocean County Building Trades - "We all went to the game, seeing the first game there. My family came and pointed out all the stuff that we worked on and had done. Normally you build a building and walk away from it and never go back. Every time I go back, I tell my wife ad nauseum that I put that up and I hung that. You keep coming back to the facility and seeing the stuff I worked on brings back good memories...I have fond memories of the job because we had good guys working on it. It went very smoothly. I thought at the time it was a little crazy to put a baseball stadium in Lakewood, and didn't think it would catch on. But they're always doing something over there. On my end, I'm very proud that I worked on the job and enjoy going back every year."

Bill Morros, Epic Management - "I remember roaming around and hanging out with Ray Coles and working our way through the luxury boxes and drinking a beer at every stop! I was lucky that the project got assigned to me. I'm a big baseball fan and it was satisfying to be able to be involved working on something that you enjoy watching as a fan."






