## 2020-21 Regular Season Lightning Notes

### REGULAR SEASON RECAP

Tampa Bay finished the 2020-21 regular season 36-17-3 (75 pts.), ranking third in the final Central Division standings and tied for eighth in the overall NHL standings. The Lightning's .670 point percentage in 2020-21 was the third highest in franchise history behind only the 2018-19 season (.780) and the 2017-18 season (.689). By comparison, last season's Stanley Cup championship team finished with a .657 point percentage. The Bolts scored 3.21 goals per game, fourth-highest goals per game average in franchise history, and allowed 2.59 goals per game, sixth-lowest goals allowed per game average in franchise history. The Lightning averaged 23.84 hits per 60 minutes, second highest in franchise history behind only the 2018-19 squad (25.48); the Bolts top three highest hits per 60 averages have come in the last three seasons (also: 23.70 in 2019-20)...Tampa Bay finished the 2020-21 regular season 26-0-0 when leading after two periods; the last two NHL teams to conclude a season with a 1.000 win percentage when leading after two periods went on to win the Stanley Cup (PIT - 39-0-0 in 2015-16 and CHI - 25-0-0 in 2014-15).

### AN ERA OF DOMINANCE

Since the start of the 2017-18 season, no NHL team has more regular season wins (195) and a higher regular season point percentage (.703) than Tampa Bay (Boston is second in both categories with 176 wins and a .676 point percentage).

### THE BIG(GEST) CAT

Tampa Bay goaltender **Andrei Vasilevskiy** finished the regular season 31-10-1. his fourth-consecutive season with 30+ wins. Vasilevskiy led the NHL for victories in 2020-21; it's the fourth-consecutive season Vasilevskiy has finished first or tied for first in the NHL for wins...Vasilevskiy is the first NHL goalie to finish first or tied for first for wins in the NHL four years in a row since Martin Brodeur (2002-03 to 2006-07)...Vasilevskiy set a career high for goals-against average (2.25)...Vasilevskiy's 2.25 GAA was the third best in franchise history behind only **Ben Bishop's** 2.06 GAA in 2015-16 and 2.23 GAA in 2013-14...Vasilevskiy's .925 save percentage matched a career best (also: 2018-19) and was tied for the second-best in franchise history (best: **Ben Bishop** - .926 in 2015-16)...Since 2018, Vasilevskiy has more playoff wins (29) than any other NHL goalie by a wide margin.

### POINTING THE WAY

Lightning center **Brayden Point** tallied 23 goals and 48 points this season to lead the team in both categories. Point finished a season as Tampa Bay's goal or scoring leader for the first time in his career. Point scored 14 goals during Tampa Bay's run to the Stanley Cup in the 2020 Playoffs, the most goals scored by a Lightning player in a playoff season in franchise history. Point's 33 points in the 2020 Playoffs were the second most in a playoff season in Lightning history behind only **Nikita Kucherov's** 34 points from the same year. Point enters tonight's contest on a five-game playoff point streak (5-3--8 pts.), having pointed in each of the final five games of the 2020 Stanley Cup Final.

### HED OF THE CLASS

Bolts defenseman **Victor Hedman** notched nine goals, 36 assists and 45 points during the regular season, leading the Lightning for assists for the fourth time in his career (also: 2016-17, 2015-14 and 2013-14). Hedman ranked fourth among NHL defensemen for assists in 2020-21 and tied for third for scoring.

Hedman finished second in the NHL for power-play assists (23) and primary power-play assists (14), trailing only Connor McDavid in both categories, and ranked tied for fourth in the League for power-play scoring (1-23--24 PP pts.). Hedman became the second Lightning player ever to win the Conn Smythe Trophy when he recorded 10 goals, 12 assists and 22 points in 25 games in the 2020 playoffs. Hedman's 10 goals in the 2020 Playoffs are the third most ever by a defenseman in NHL playoff history.

## MILESTONES

**Ondrej Palat** (32 career playoff goals) needs one goal to tie **Martin St. Louis** for second-most playoff goals in Lightning history. **Ondrej Palat** (10 career playoff power-play goals) needs one power-play goal to pass **Martin St. Louis** and tie **Steven Stamkos** for most playoff power-play goals in Tampa Bay history. **Tyler Johnson** (8 career playoff game-winning goals) needs one game-winning goal to pass **Martin St. Louis** and take over as Tampa Bay's all-time playoff game-winning goal leader. **Victor Hedman** (17 career playoff goals) needs three goals to become the 15th defenseman in NHL history to score 20 playoff goals for one franchise and third active defenseman to do so, joining Kris Letang (21) and Brent Burns (20).
