On behalf of the St. Louis Blues, welcome to the 2021 National Hockey League postseason. We hope to make your job covering the Blues as easy and pleasant as possible. In order to help our operation run smoothly and make your jobs easier, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

### **Media Credentials**

Media credentials are issued to **working media only** and do not guarantee media seating. All season and individual game credential holders should enter through Security Base, located on 15<sup>th</sup> street. The media entrance opens an hour and a half prior to the start of each game. At this time, masks must be worn in Enterprise Center at all times. All credentials are non-transferable and any unauthorized use will subject the bearer to ejection from Enterprise Center and confiscation of the credential.

### **Individual Game Passes**

Individual game credentials should be requested via email to **Dan O'Neill** [doneill@stlblues.com](mailto:doneill@stlblues.com) a minimum of 24 hours prior to game time. Any request made within 24 hours of game time may not be accommodated. Pre-arranged passes must be picked up at Security Base located on 15<sup>th</sup> street. Credentials will be issued on an availability basis.

### **Gameday Media Availability**

The Blues will host media availability prior to and following each game. We kindly ask that any requests for interviews outside of the general press conference be made well in advance of the requested time. All press conferences will be conducted via zoom. The Blues will communicate information on how to join availabilities prior to and during each gameday.

### **Daily Practices**

Blues practices will be held at either Enterprise Center or Centene Community Ice Center and will be open to the media. Up-to-date practice information will be emailed daily. To be added to the Blues' email distribution list, please contact Dan O'Neill ([doneill@stlblues.com](mailto:doneill@stlblues.com)).

### **Press Box Access**

The main press box is located on the Penthouse Level. All media are required to display credentials at all times. Anyone refusing to display their credential will be subject to revocation. Due to protocols, the event level and dressing rooms will not be open to the media.

### **Broadcast Booth Positions**

Blues television broadcast booth position is located at section 320 on the Concourse Level. Visiting TV and Radio booth positions are located in the press box on the Penthouse Level.

**Press Notes**

Game notes and NHL statistics will be emailed to our distribution list for each game. The Blues will not offer hard copies of notes, statistics or game sheets due to COVID-19 protocols.

**Photography**

Photo credentials will also be issued in the same manner as other passes. Weekly papers and magazines on assignment may obtain passes by having the photo editor request a single-game credential to the media relations department 24 hours in advance. Photo positions will be assigned by the Blues' team photographer **Scott Rovak** (scottrovak@gmail.com) in conjunction with the public relations department. Photographers should check in with Scott prior to game time. All photographers must comply with space assignments and shooting regulations. Photographers must shoot from designated areas only.

**Statisticians**

Statisticians are available to assist television broadcasters by contacting the Blues' public relations department. These services must be arranged at least 24 hours prior to the game.

# Craig Berube

## Head Coach

Craig Berube was named Head Coach on June 25, 2019 after serving as interim head coach since Nov. 19, 2018. He originally joined the club as an associate coach on June 15, 2017.

After taking over as interim head coach, Berube led the Blues to a 38-19-6 record to finish the regular season, including a 30-10-5 mark and 65 points in the 2019 calendar year – the most points recorded by any team in that span. Berube guided the Blues from the bottom of the NHL standings on Jan. 3 to a fifth-place finish in the Western Conference, making them just the seventh team since 1967-68 to earn a playoff berth after ranking last overall at any point after New Year's Day. In the postseason, Berube helped the Blues capture the 2019 Stanley Cup Championship after defeating the Boston Bruins in seven games in the Stanley Cup Final. Prior to joining the Blues staff, Berube spent one season as the head coach of the American Hockey League's (AHL) Chicago Wolves (2015-16) and led them to a first-place finish in the Central Division.

Overall, Berube has enjoyed a 17-year coaching career. Prior to joining the Wolves, he spent two seasons as head coach for the Philadelphia Flyers, seven seasons as an assistant coach with the Flyers, as well as two seasons as head coach and three seasons as an assistant coach with the AHL's Philadelphia Phantoms.

As a player, the Calahoo, Alberta, native appeared in 17 NHL seasons, including stints with Philadelphia, Toronto, Calgary, Washington, and the New York Islanders. Berube posted 159 points (61 goals, 98 assists) and 3,149 penalty minutes across 1,054 regular season games. He is one of three players in NHL history to have appeared in over 1,000 regular season games and serve over 3,000 penalty minutes.
