YESTERDAY: The Captains came from behind for the fourth straight night to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps on Friday by the final score of 9-4. After West Michigan jumped out to a 3-0 lead on two home runs – a two-run shot by Rey Rivera in the second and a solo homer by Danny Cabrera in the third – the Captains scored nine consecutive runs. **George Valera** led the offensive charge. His two-run home run in the fourth put the Captains on the board and began a three-hit night that also included a single and an RBI double. **Brayan Rocchio's** two-run single gave the Captains the lead in the fifth and they never looked back. Five Captains contributed multiple hits in the ballgame – Valera (3), **Will Brennan** (2), **Raynel Delgado** (2), **Joe Naranjo** (2) and **Victor Nova** (2). After starter **Tanner Burns** lasted two innings, **Kevin Coulter** pitched four strong innings to earn the win. Coulter struck out seven and held the Whitecaps to just one run on two hits. **Alec Wisely** picked up the save, allowing one unearned run over three frames. Whitecaps reliever Zac Shepherd took the loss after allowing five runs in 1.2 innings.

BABY COME BACK: The Captains have come from behind to win all four games of this series against West Michigan. Lake County erased a 2-0 deficit in game one, a 2-0 deficit in game two, 2-1 and 3-2 deficits in game three and a 3-0 deficit in game four. In the first three games of the series, the Captains' comeback came in the eighth inning or later.

REDEMPTION: The Captains have won four straight games against West Michigan after being swept in a six-game series during their first meeting with the Whitecaps. At LMCU Ballpark in May, Lake County's offense averaged just 2.0 runs per game and slashed .179/.265/.235. The Captains' pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA at West Michigan. During this series at Classic Park, the Captains are slashing .293/.373/.398 and are averaging 5.5 runs per game. The Captains' pitching staff has posted a 2.00 ERA during this home series.

HOME COOKIN': The home team has won each of the first 10 games between the Captains and Whitecaps this season. West Michigan swept a six-game series against the Captains from May 25-30 at LMCU Ballpark. The Captains have won the first four games of this six-game series at Classic Park.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Six of the first 10 games between the Captains and Whitecaps have been decided by three runs or fewer. There have been four one-run games, one two-run game and one three-run game. The Captains are 3-3 in all close games during the series and 1-3 in the one-run games.

WELCOME BACK: In six games since returning from an oblique injury, **George Valera** has posted a 1.119 OPS (.435 OBP, .684 SLG) with two home runs and one double.

RED HOT JUNE: Since returning from a groin injury on June 1, **Quentin Holmes** has posted a .974 OPS with a home run, a triple, five RBI, four walks and three steals. **Brayan Rocchio** has a 1.051 OPS in June with three homers and six doubles. **Will Brennan** has 10 extra-base hits (two homers, seven doubles, one triple) in 15 games for a .541 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS. **Austen Wade** has a .455 on-base percentage, thanks to nine walks in 10 games.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF **Will Brennan** is leads the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (16). He is also second in hits (41), tied for third in extra-base hits (19) and sits fourth in batting average (.304).

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains SS **Ernie Clement** became the 101st former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 13. Nine former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014), **Jean Carlos Mejia** (2018) and RHP **Eli Morgan** (2018) and Clement. That ties the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, matching 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first basemen, six different second basemen, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. **Raynel Delgado**, **Brayan Rocchio** and **José Tena** have each played three different infield positions. **Victor Nova** and **Daniel Schneemann** have played two different infield positions and left field.

LAST TIME OUT: Mock was hit hard in his Captains debut. The right-hander started on Saturday at Fort Wayne and surrendered a two-run home run to Agustin Ruiz two batters into the ballgame. He then allowed five more runs to score in the third on an RBI single by Dwanya Williams-Sutton, an RBI double by Tirso Omelas and a two-run homer by Justin Lopez. Mock allowed seven runs in 2.2 innings to take the loss in a 10-2 defeat.

BOUNCING AROUND: Mock started the season with Low-A Lynchburg and Double-A Akron. Mock began the year in Lynchburg and made four appearances, all in relief. He posted a 1.98 ERA and held opponents to a .184 batting average. Mock then made two relief appearances and one start with Akron. The right-hander never allowed more than one run in any outing. He struck out 12 in nine innings with a 3.00 ERA.

2020: Built his own mound with his Dad during the pandemic, constructed with 2x12's and plywood with rubber horse stall mats on the incline.

2019: Made his professional debut in the Arizona League. Mock made six appearances before being called up to Short-Season Mahoning Valley. He posted a 3.21 ERA with 37 strikeouts and 14 walks in 33.2 innings.

PENN STATE: Mock steadily improved over his three seasons at Penn State. After going 0-6 with a 7.75 ERA as a redshirt freshman, Mock lowered his ERA to 5.97 in 2018. Mock transitioned to a full-time starting role as a junior and had his best season with a 3.93 ERA in 2019. Mock averaged 10.3 K/9 and 2.32 K/BB during his Penn State career.

THEY ARE: When Cleveland selected Mock in the 2019 Draft, he became the fifth Penn State pitcher to be drafted in a five-year span (2015-2019). Mock is joined by Dante Biasi (Royals; 6th Round – 2019), Justin Hagenman (Dodgers; 23rd Round – 2018), Sal Biasi (Royals; 11th Round – 2017) and Jack Anderson (Mariners; 23rd Round – 2016).
