YESTERDAY: The Captains came from behind to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps for the third consecutive night. Raynel Delgado's two-run, go-ahead double highlighted the Captains' three-run eighth inning, as Lake County won a back-and-forth affair, 3. The game featured three ties (1-1, 2-2, 3-3). West Michigan led twice (2-1, 3-2) and the Captains led twice (1-0, 6-3).

MORE ON LAST NIGHT: The Captains took a 1-0 lead on a Whitecaps error in the first inning, but West Michigan tied the score in the fifth on a solo homer by Corey Joyce and took a 2-1 lead in the top of the sixth on an RBI single by Danny Cabrera. Lake County tied the score at 2-2 in the bottom of the sixth on an Aaron Bracho RBI single. The Captains nearly took the lead later in the sixth when Delgado doubled down the left field line, but Cabrera threw out Bracho trying to score from first to end the inning. The Whitecaps came back to take the lead again in the top of the seventh on an Eliezer Alfonzo RBI single. The Captains loaded the bases with nobody out in the bottom of the seventh, but could only push across one run on a Brayan Rocchio single that plated Austen Wade to even the score at 3-3, but right fielder Bryant Packard threw Joe Donovan out at home to end the inning and keep the game tied. Delgado's two-run double gave the Captains the lead in the bottom of the eighth and Wade singled home Delgado to give the Captains their largest lead of the game at 6-3. Reliever Jared Janczak got the win after pitching a perfect eighth and Nic Enright nailed down the save with a one-two-three ninth. Whitecaps reliever Bryce Tassin allowed two runs in one inning to take

REDEMPTION: The Captains have won three straight games against West Michigan after being swept in a six-game series during heir first meeting with the Whitecaps. At LMCU Ballpark in May, Lake County's offense averaged just 2.0 runs per game and slashed .179/.265/.235. The Captains' pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA at West Michigan. During this series at Classic Park, the Captains are slashing .253/.349/.316 and are averaging 4.3 runs per game. The Captains' pitching staff has posted a 1.67 ERA during this home series

HOME COOKIN': The home team has won each of the first nine games between the Captains and Whitecaps this season. West Michigan swept a six-game series against the Captains from May 25-30 at LMCU Ballpark. The Captains have won the first three games of this six-game series at Classic Park.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Six of the first nine games between the Captains and Whitecaps have been decided by three runs or fewer. There have been four one-run games, one two-run game and one three-run game. The Captains are 3-3 in all close games during the series and 1-3 in the one-run games.

RED HOT JUNE: Since returning from a groin injury on June 1, Quentin Holmes has gone 10-for-26 (.385) with a home run, a triple, five RBI, four walks and three steals. Brayan Rocchio has a 1.046 OPS in June with three homers and six doubles. José Tena is hitting .314 (16-for-51) in June with four doubles, two triples and nine RBI. Austen Wade has a .455 on-base percentage, thanks to nine walks in 10 games. Will Brennan has nine extra-base hits (two homers, six doubles, one triple) in 14 games for a .536 slugging percentage and an .858 OPS.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) lead in doubles (15). He is also econd in hits (39), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (18) and sixth in batting average (.300).

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains SS Ernie Clement became the 101st former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 13. Nine former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and RHP Eli Morgan (2018) and Clement. That ties the record for the most former captains to debut in a single year, matching 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first paseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

LAST TIME OUT: Burns took a tough luck loss in a 2-1 Captains defeat at West Michigan last Friday. The righthander retired the first nine Whitecaps he faced before allowing his first baserunner on an error by third baseman Victor Nova to lead off the fourth. Dillon Dingler followed with a two-run home run. Burns allowed just those two runs, one earned, over five innings.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by Perfect Game. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by Baseball America. Collegiate Baseball. D1 Baseball and Perfect Game. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS Carson Tucker (1st Round -23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016. eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of FanGraphs says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Logenhagen, also of FanGraphs, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Logenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Logenhagen said. Baseball America sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.
