SUNDAY: The Captains to the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 7-6, to split the six-game series at Parkview Field. Lake County battled back rom a 6-1 deficit after Fort Wayne scored six runs in the bottom of the sixth. The Captains answered with a three-run third that ncluded a two-run homer by Brayan Rocchio. An RBI single by Will Brennan pulled the Captains within a run in the fifth and Victor Nova tied the score at 6-6 in the eighth with an RBI single of his own. The TinCaps scored what proved to be the winning run n the bottom of the eighth. Reinaldo llarraza reached on an infield single, stole second, moved to third on a ground out and scored when Yorman Rodriguez bounced a single through a drawn-in infield.

AST SERIES: The Captains split a six-game series with the Fort Wayne TinCaps at Parkview Field. After winning the first two ames by scores of 8-3 and 3-2, the Captains lost game three in 10 innings, 5-4, on a walk-off bloop double by Justin Lopez. The Captains bounced back with an 8-5 win on Friday, but lost the last two games by scores of 10-2 and 7-6.

REDEMPTION: The Captains were swept in a six-game series during their first meeting with the West Michigan Whitecaps. Lake County's offense averaged just 2.0 runs per game during the series and slashed .179/.265/.235. José Tena was the Captains' lone offensive bright spot during the series, hitting .368 (7-for-19) with three doubles. The Captains' pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA during the series. The Captains lost three games during the series by just one run.

WELCOME BACK: Since returning from a groin strain that kept him out from May 7 through May 31, OF Quentin Holmes has one 10-for-19 (.526) with a home run, a triple, five RBI, three walks and three steals.

COMING ALIVE: The Captains ended May by suffering a six-game sweep at West Michigan, in which they averaged just 2.0 runs per game. Since then, the Captains have averaged 6.08 runs per game and have gone 7-5 to open June. Quentin Holmes, who returned from a groin injury on June 1, is 10-for-19 (.526) with a homer, a triple, four RBI, three walks and three steals. Will Brennan nas hit .341 (15-for-44) with two homers, six doubles and a triple for a 1.029 OPS during the month). Brayan Rocchio is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with a .995 OPS, three homers and four doubles. José Tena is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with three doubles and two riples. Joe Naranjo has a .439 on-base percentage, thanks to eight walks and a 10-for-33 (.303) month with two doubles.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) lead in doubles (15). He is also second in batting average (.322), second in hits (38), fourth in extra-base hits (18), sixth in OPS (.911), eighth in on-base ercentage (.394) and tied for ninth in total bases (61).

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 134 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central eague. The Captains also have two of the 10 lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League –José Tena (5.5% - 8th) and Bravan Rocchio (5.8% - 10th).

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains SS **Ernie Clement** became the 101st former Captain to reach the major leagues when he lebuted for Cleveland on June 13. Nine former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and RHP Eli Morgan (2018) and Clement. That ties the record for the most former captains to debut in a single year, matching 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

LAST TIME OUT: Gaddis tied a career-high with seven strikeouts and earned the win at Fort Wayne last Tuesday. Gaddis had three blemishes over five innings – two were Jonny Homza solo home runs (first and fifth innings) and the other was a Seamus Curran RBI double (fourth inning). The Captains' offense gave Gaddis plenty of run support, including home runs by **Bryan Lavastida**, **George Valera** and **Brayan Rocchio**, to win, 8-3.

PROSPECTING: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

GEORGIA STATE STAR: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

PANTHER PRO'S: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

TEAM USA: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
