YESTERDAY: The Captains lost to the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 10-2. Captains starter Eric Mock took the loss after allowing seven uns in 2.2 innings, including two home runs. Aqustin Ruiz gave the TinCaps a 2-0 lead two batters into the first inning with a tworun home run. Justin Lopez capped a five-run TinCaps third inning with a two-run homer. The Captains' lone runs came on a second-inning RBI single by **Joe Naranjo** and a seventh-inning RBI double by Will Brennan. Fort Wayne reliever Brandon Komar earned the win with two perfect innings to close the game.

WELCOME BACK: Since returning from a groin strain that kept him out from May 7 through May 31, OF Quentin Holmes has gone 8-for-14 (.571) with a home run, four RBI, three walks and three steals.

APPLESAUCE: The Captains are 8-3 against the TinCaps with a +19 run differential (55-36). Lake County is slashing .245/.307/.407 (.714 OPS) with 11 home runs during the season series. Quentin Holmes is 7-for-9 in this series with a home run, four RBI and a stolen base (he did not play in the previous series against Fort Wayne). José Tena is hitting .353/.389/.706 (1.095 OPS), including three home runs, during the season series. George Valera is hitting .300/.467/.600 (1.067 OPS) with a homer against Fort Wayne. The Captains' pitching staff has a cumulative 3.10 ERA and has averaged 12.6 K/9 (138 K, 98.2 IP), while holding Fort Wayne to a .201 average.

COMING ALIVE: The Captains ended May by suffering a six-game sweep at West Michigan, in which they averaged just 2.0 runs per game. Since then, the Captains have averaged 6.5 runs per game and have gone 7-3 to open June. Quentin Holmes, who returned from a groin injury on June 1, is 8-for-14 (.571) with a homer, four RBI, three walks and three steals. Brayan Rocchio is 11-for-34 with a .969 OPS, two homers and four doubles. José Tena is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles and two triples. oe Naranjo has a .455 on-base percentage, thanks to seven walks and a 8-for-26 month with two doubles.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (13), sixth in batting average (.307) and tied for sixth in extra-base hits (16).

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 129 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central eague. The Captains also have two of the seven lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – Brayan Rocchio (4.5% - 2nd), José Tena (5.7% -7th).

100: 2018 Captains RHP Eli Morgan became the 100th former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on May 28. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016)

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first aseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two ifferent infield positions and left field

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League - 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman made the longest start of his young professional career and earned the win against Dayton last Sunday at Classic Park. The right-hander lasted 5.2 innings and held the Dragons to one run on four hits. Hickman struck out five and walked one. Dayton's lone run against Hickman came in the first inning when the starter walked Jacob Hurtubise to begin the game. Hurtubise then stole second, advanced to third on a passed ball and scored on a ground out. Hickman never allowed more than one hit in an inning. The Captains gave Hickman lots of run support and Lake County beat Dayton, 14-4. **COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second

Team Preseason All-America by Perfect Game before the shortened 2020 season.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both Perfect Game and Baseball America ranking Hickman as the 65th best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

CAPTAINS AND VANDY: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

STAFF LEADER: In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

COACHES WORDS: Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does.'

STRIKEOUT BUMP: After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
