**YESTERDAY:** The Captains rode seven early runs and a three-hit night by **Quentin Holmes** to an 8-5 win over the Fort Wayne TinCaps on Friday night at Parkview Field. Lake County's big inning came in the first when the Captains scored four, including an RBI triple by **José Tena** and an RBI double by **Joe Naranjo**. Holmes highlighted his 3-for-5 night with a two-run homer in the fourth. The Captains held off a late surge by Fort Wayne. The TinCaps scored three runs in the sixth, added a run in the eighth and brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth after Jonny Homza's RBI double cut the Captains' lead to three runs. **Kevin Kelly** nailed down the last two outs with a strikeout and a fly out to seal the win. Captains starter **Tanner Burns** fired five shutout innings to earn the win. The Captains hung the loss on Gabe Mosser with seven runs against the TinCaps' starter over four innings.

**WELCOME BACK:** Since returning from a groin strain that kept him out from May 7 through May 31, OF **Quentin Holmes** has gone 8-for-14 (.571) with a home run, four RBI, three walks and three steals.

**APPLESAUCE:** The Captains are 8-2 against the TinCaps with a +27 run differential (53-26). Lake County is slashing .256/.315/.430 (.745 OPS) with 11 home runs during the season series. **Quentin Holmes** is 7-for-9 in this series with a home run, four RBI and a stolen base (he did not play in the previous series against Fort Wayne). **José Tena** is hitting .353/.389/.706 (1.095 OPS), including three home runs, during the season series. **George Valera** is hitting .375/.455/.750 (1.205 OPS) with a homer against Fort Wayne. The Captains' pitching staff has a cumulative 2.38 ERA and has averaged 12.5 K/9 (126 K, 90.2 IP), while holding Fort Wayne to a .184 average.

**COMING ALIVE:** The Captains ended May by suffering a six-game sweep at West Michigan, in which they averaged just 2.0 runs per game. Since then, the Captains have averaged 6.5 runs per game and have gone 7-3 to open June. **Quentin Holmes**, who returned from a groin injury on June 1, is 8-for-14 (.571) with a homer, four RBI, three walks and three steals. **Brayan Rocchio** is 11-for-34 with a .969 OPS, two homers and four doubles. **José Tena** is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles and two triples. **Joe Naranjo** has a .455 on-base percentage, thanks to seven walks and a 8-for-26 month with two doubles.

**BRENNAN BASHING:** Captains OF **Will Brennan** leads the High-A Central League (HAC) league in doubles (12). He is fourth in batting average (.309), ninth in on-base percentage (.387) and 10th in OPS (.878).

**SWING AWAY:** The Captains' offense has walked just 125 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have two of the nine lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – **Brayan Rocchio** (4.0% - 1<sup>st</sup>), **José Tena** (5.9% - 8<sup>th</sup>).

**100:** 2018 Captains RHP **Eli Morgan** became the 100<sup>th</sup> former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on May 28. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014), **Jean Carlos Mejia** (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

**DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY:** The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first basemen, six different second basemen, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. **Raynel Delgado**, **Brayan Rocchio** and **José Tena** have each played three different infield positions. **Victor Nova** and **Daniel Schneemann** have played two different infield positions and left field.

**YOUNGSTERS:** The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B **Joe Naranjo** (20), INF **Aaron Bracho** (20), INF **José Tena** (20), INF **Brayan Rocchio** (20) and OF **George Valera** (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

**HIGH-A:** The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**NEW SKIPPER:** Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

**BOUNCING AROUND:** Mock makes his Captains debut tonight after pitching with Low-A Lynchburg and Double-A Akron at the start of the season. Mock began the year in Lynchburg and made four appearances, all in relief. He posted a 1.98 ERA and held opponents to a .184 batting average. Mock then made two relief appearances and one start with Akron. The right-hander never allowed more than one run in any outing. He struck out 12 in nine innings with a 3.00 ERA.

**2020:** Built his own mound with his Dad during the pandemic, constructed with 2x12's and plywood with rubber horse stall mats on the incline.

**2019:** Made his professional debut in the Arizona League. Mock made six appearances before being called up to Short-Season Mahoning Valley. He posted a 3.21 ERA with 37 strikeouts and 14 walks in 33.2 innings.

**PENN STATE:** Mock steadily improved over his three seasons at Penn State. After going 0-6 with a 7.75 ERA as a redshirt freshman, Mock lowered his ERA to 5.97 in 2018. Mock transitioned to a full-time starting role as a junior and had his best season with a 3.93 ERA in 2019. Mock averaged 10.3 K/9 and 2.32 K/BB during his Penn State career.

**THEY ARE:** When Cleveland selected Mock in the 2019 Draft, he became the fifth Penn State pitcher to be drafted in a four-year span (2016-2019). Mock is joined by Dante Biasi (Royals; 6<sup>th</sup> Round – 2019), Justin Hagenman (Dodgers; 23<sup>rd</sup> Round – 2018), Sal Biasi (Royals; 11<sup>th</sup> Round – 2017) and Jack Anderson (Mariners; 23<sup>rd</sup> Round – 2016).
