SUNDAY: The Captains scored seven runs in the bottom of the second inning on Sunday behind two, two-run home runs from Raynel Delgado and Austen Wade. They scored three more runs in the fourth and put up four in the sixth to open up a 14-1 lead over Dayton. Joe Donovan led off the bottom of the fifth with a solo home run to left-field on what was his first professional hit. Lake County collected a season high 13 base hits in the contest. Dayton pushed across three runs in the seventh inning but their comeback fell short and the Captains held on to win 14-4 and take the series over the Dragons.

COMING ALIVE: After scoring just 12 runs and suffering a six-game sweep last week at West Michigan, the Captains scored 42 runs in the against Dayton. Will Brennan went 8-for-23 (.348) with two home runs, two doubles, 10 RBI and a 1.071 OPS. Joe Naranjo hit 4-for-13 with a team-leading seven walks for a .550 on-base percentage.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) league lead in doubles (11). He is fourth in batting average (.320), sixth in wRC+ (147), and ninth in OPS (.895).

LIGHTS OUT: Allen has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the High-A Central League (HAC) at 1.63, the fourth-lowest WHIP (0.90) and the sixth-lowest batting average against (.202). Tanner Burns has the third-lowest WHIP (0.89), the eighth-lowest ERA (3.04) and the ninth-lowest batting average against (.207).

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 115 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have two of the eight lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – Brayan Rocchio (4.4% - 3rd), José Tena (5.7% - 8th).

100: 2018 Captains RHP Eli Morgan became the 100th former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on May 28. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League - 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth season coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Gaddis walked a career high six batters last Tuesday against the Dayton Dragons. After working around a hit batter and a walk in the first inning, he allowed one run to score in the second. In the third, Gaddis walked four batters and left the game after walking in a run to make to make it 2-0 Dragons, with the bases still loaded. Two more runs came across to score for Dayton in the frame to give the Dragons a 4-0 lead. The Captains attempted a late comeback, even taking the lead in the bottom of the seventh, but could not hold on, falling 10-9 to Dayton to open the series.

PROSPECTING: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

GEORGIA STATE STAR: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

PANTHER PRO'S: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

TEAM USA: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
