**YESTERDAY:** The Captains extended their winning streak to three games with an 8-4 win over Dayton. Captains starter **Tanner Burns** earned his first professional win with six shutout innings. **Will Brennan** had another big day at the plate with three RBI, including a two-run double to open the scoring in the third and an RBI single that capped a four-run Captains eighth inning. **Brayan Rocchio** and **Mike Anditis** also homered in the win. All of Dayton's runs came in a four-run ninth inning against reliever **Kevin Kelly**. Dragons starter **Noah Davis** took the loss. He allowed three runs over 5.2 innings, due in part to five walks and two hit batsmen.

**COMING ALIVE:** After scoring just 12 runs and suffering a six-game sweep last week at West Michigan, the Captains have already scored 24 runs in the first four games of this series against Dayton. The Captains are slinging .255/.381/.464 during the series (.844 OPS). **Will Brennan** has gone 6-for-14 (.429) with two home runs, two doubles, 10 RBI and a 1.467 OPS. **Joe Naranjo** has gone 3-for-10 with a team-leading five walks for a .533 on-base percentage.

**BRENNAN BASHING:** Captains OF **Will Brennan** leads the High-A Central League (HAC) lead in batting average (.330) and doubles (11). He is third in wRC+ (161), third in OPS (.939), tied for third in hits (29), tied for fourth in extra-base-hits (13) and fifth in on-base percentage (.416).

**BANGED UP:** The Captains currently have three players on the Injured List – OF **George Valera**, LHP **Raymond Burgos** and LHP **Matt Turner**. Valera has not played since May 12. Lavastida was activated from the Injured List yesterday and played his first game since May 12. OF **Quentin Holmes** was activated from the Injured List on Tuesday and played his first game since May 6.

**LIGHTS OUT:** The Captains enter today third in the High-A Central League (HAC) in ERA (3.86) and WHIP (1.29). **Logan Allen** has the second-lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the High-A Central League (HAC) at 1.63 and the fourth-lowest WHIP (0.90). **Tanner Burns** has the third-lowest WHIP (0.89).

**SWING AWAY:** The Captains' offense has walked just 103 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have three of the nine lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – **Brayan Rocchio** (4.8% - 2<sup>nd</sup>), **José Tena** (5.2% - 5<sup>th</sup>) and **Raynel Delgado** (6.3% - 9<sup>th</sup>).

**100:** 2018 Captains RHP **Eli Morgan** became the 100<sup>th</sup> former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland last Friday. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014), **Jean Carlos Mejia** (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

**DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY:** The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first basemen, six different second basemen, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. **Raynel Delgado**, **Brayan Rocchio** and **José Tena** have each played three different infield positions. **Victor Nova** and **Daniel Schneemann** have played two different infield positions and left field.

**YOUNGSTERS:** The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B **Joe Naranjo** (20), INF **Aaron Bracho** (20), INF **José Tena** (20), INF **Brayan Rocchio** (20) and OF **George Valera** (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

**HIGH-A:** The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**NEW SKIPPER:** Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Coulter pitched two innings in relief on Sunday at West Michigan. The right-hander allowed one run on three hits with three strikeouts and no walks. The lone run Coulter surrendered came in the seventh inning when he allowed a leadoff single to Daniel Cabrera and was pulled from the game. **Jared Janczak** then gave up a two-run home run to Dillon Dingler to score Coulter's runner, Cabrera. The Captains lost, 7-1. Coulter did not factor in the decision.

**FIRST START:** Kevin Coulter makes his first career start tonight after making 24 relief appearances in his first two pro seasons. Coulter has served as a piggyback pitcher. The right-hander's longest career appearance is four innings (May 13, 2021 vs. Fort Wayne). Coulter fills in for LHP **Matt Turner** who was placed on the Injured List last week with left elbow soreness.

**2019:** Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

**BEAR DOWN:** Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

**THREE SPORT STAR:** While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
