TUESDAY: The Captains dropped their seventh straight game in a back and forth thriller, 10-9 to the Dayton Dragons. Dayton jumped out to an early 4-0 lead in the first three innings thans to six walks from Captains starter Hunter Gaddis. The Captains got two runs back in the bottom of the third on a Will Brennan home run. In the sixth Dayton extended their lead to 7-2 with three more walks, two singles and a double. Lake County got two runs back in the bottom of the inning on a José Tena RBI single to make the score 7-4. In the bottom of the seventh the Captains took the lead. Brayan Rocchio doubled home two runs bringing Aaron Bracho to the plate down by one run. He connected on a fastball and launched it over the wall in dead center for the two-run home run giving the Captains an 8-7 lead. Both teams traded runs in the eighth inning to make the score 9-8, Captains. In the top of the ninth the Dragons loaded the bases against Nick Gallagher. He induced a ground ball back to the mound but tried to turn a double play that would've ended the game, but threw the ball passed Tena at Shortstop allowing the Dragons to ite the game. Quincy McAfee drew a walk to force home the go ahead run and give the Dragons the lead for good 10-9.

LAST SERIES: The Captains were swept in a six-game series at West Michigan. Lake County was outscored 37-12 in the series (-25 run differential). The Captains' offense slashed .179/.265/.235 during the series and the pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA. Three of the games in the series were one-run losses, including a 1-0 loss in 10 innings on Wednesday, in which West Michigan won on a walk-off balk by Captains reliever Kellen Rholl. The most one-sided game of the series was a 17-5 final on Saturday, which included a pair of three-run home runs by #1 Tigers prospect Spencer Torkelson.

SKIDDING: The Captains have lost 10 of their last 11 games. Over those 11 games, Lake County is last in the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.278), slugging percentage (.285) and OPS (.563). The Captains have been outscored by 44 runs (75-31) during that stretch. They enter today with the lowest run total in the league in 2021 (93).

BANGED UP: The Captains currently have three players on the Injured List – OF George Valera, LHP Raymond Burgos and LHP Matt Turner. Valera and C Bryan Lavastida have not played since May 12. Lavastida was activated from the Injured List today.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is currently tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) lead in doubles (9). He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.407) and fifth in batting average (.316).

LIGHTS OUT: Today's game one starter Logan Allen has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the High-A Central League (HAC) at 0.83.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 85 times this season. That is the fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have two of the four lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – Brayan Rocchio (4.1% - 1<sup>st</sup>) and José Tena (5.7% - 6<sup>th</sup>).

100: 2018 Captains RHP Eli Morgan became the 100<sup>th</sup> former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland last Friday. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allen tossed a career high six innings of shutout baseball last Wednesday at West Michigan. He surrendered just three base runners with five strikeouts. The game remained tied at 0-0 all the way through regulation and forced extra innings for the first time in the Captains' season. The Captains did not score in the top of the 10<sup>th</sup>, and the Whitecaps walked it off in the bottom of the frame when **Kellen Rholl** balked to bring home the winning run from third base. The Captains lost, 1-0.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Allen was named a Preseason All-American by several outlets ahead of the shortened 2020 season and was also named the 2020 Conference USA Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Allen racked up five C-USA Pitcher of the Week honors during his career, including in 2020 after pitching a seven-inning, one-hitter with 13 strikeouts against George Mason. Allen was twice honored with All-CUSA nods as a position player. He was named as a utility player on the All-CUSA 2<sup>nd</sup> Team as a freshman and on the All-CUSA 1<sup>st</sup> Team as a sophomore. He was named a Freshman All-American by three different outlets in 2018.

TEAM USA: In 2019, Allen became the first FIU Panther ever selected to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Allen in the second round (56<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Allen was Cleveland's third selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1<sup>st</sup> Round – 23<sup>rd</sup> overall) and RHP **Tanner Burns** (CBA Round – 36<sup>th</sup> overall).

TWO-WAY: Allen was a two-way player at Florida International University, playing first base when he wasn't pitching. He was even named to the All-CUSA 2<sup>nd</sup> Team as a freshman and the All-CUSA 1<sup>st</sup> Team as a sophomore, both as a utility player. In three seasons at FIU, Allen played 50 games at first base. He batted .297/.362/.410 (.773 OPS) during his career with six home runs, eight doubles and 23 RBI. As a freshman, when Allen played the most as a two-way player, he posted a career-best .390 OBP.

**NOT THAT LOGAN ALLEN:** Allen shares the same name as Cleveland's big league left-hander **Logan Allen**. The younger Allen said last year, "he reached out to me after the draft, and we talked... It's really funny. Maybe there can be some marketing possibilities one day."

**PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED:** Originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the sixth round of the 2016 draft out of University High School (Orange City, FL).

COLLEGE COACH: Allen has known his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, since he was five years old. Allen played "Pony Baseball" and travel baseball with Melendez's oldest son. Melendez helped coach the boys from a young age. "We consider [Logan] very dear to our family and he's like another son to me." Logan's brother, Hunter, also played college baseball for Melendez at Alabama State from 2014-16 (Hunter is now the assistant softball coach at FIU).

**CHANGEUP:** Allen's changeup – a circle change grip – is regarded as his best secondary pitch. According to his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), the development of that changeup goes back to Allen's youth. Melendez said he did not allow Allen to throw anything but a fastball and a changeup (no curveballs) until Allen was 12 years old. *MLB.com*'s scouting report of Allen's changeup notes "his changeup is his bread and butter, a potentially future plus circle change he sells really well with good fade and sink that misses bats and elicits weak contact on the ground."

**DELIVERY:** Eric Longenhagen of *FanGraphs* notes Allen's athleticism as a two-way player has helped him maintain a "well-balanced, repeatable delivery." Allen's college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who also coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), says of Allen's delivery "when [Logan] first started pitching at seven, you kind of saw the mechanical aspect of his pitching was a little bit more advanced than anybody else."

**2019:** Zapata pitched for the Cleveland's Arizona League "Red" team in 2019. Cleveland operated two teams in the AZL that season – Red and Blue – where the Red team featured a generally younger roster on average. Zapata became a starter for the first time in his career after previously starting just two games in 2018. The right-hander posted a 4.93 ERA and appeared to struggle in the first inning before settling down and then fading again later in the game. Zapata posted a 6.30 ERA in the first inning, but shut down opponents in the second (2.70) and third (0.90). In the fourth, however, Zapata's ERA climbed to 6.75. He had a 7.04 ERA in the fifth and a 7.36 mark in the sixth.

**2018:** In his first professional season, Zapata pitched in three games for Cleveland's Dominican Summer League team before being transferred to a co-op team operated jointly by Cleveland and the Milwaukee Brewers. He posted a combined 5.50 ERA across the two teams, but enjoyed his most success in July with a 3.24 ERA and a .185 batting average against. Zapata had extreme left-right splits that season, at least according to ERA. Against righties, Zapata posted a 3.93 ERA, compared to a 7.31 mark against lefties. His batting average against, however (.295 vs. RHH; .297 vs. RHH), does not paint such a stark picture. Zapata is the first player from the DSL Cleveland/Milwaukee co-op team to reach the Captains.

SIGNED: Cleveland signed Zapata as a non-drafted international free agent on January 22, 2018 when he was 19 years old.

**BASEBALL HOTBED:** Zapata was born in Baní, a capital town of the Peravia Province in the Dominican Republic. According to a 2019 article in <u>Baseball America</u>, no Dominican city produces more baseball players per capita than Baní. Approximately 4.58% of major leaguers from the Dominican Republic are from Baní, which makes the city the fifth-highest producer of baseball talent in the Dominican Republic. Current major leaguers from Baní include former Captains **José Ramírez** and **Francisco Mejía**.
