Lake County lost the series finale, 7-1. Lake County starter Mason Hickman allowed five runs, three earned, over two innings to take the loss. Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby held the Captains scoreless on one hit over six innings to earn the win. Lake County's only run came in the ninth inning on an RBI ground out by Daniel Schneemann. The Whitecaps homered twice in the game. Daniel Cabrera hit a three-run home run off of Hickman in the second inning. Dillon Dingler hit a two-run home run off of Jared Janczak in the seventh.

LAST SERIES: The Captains were swept in a six-game series at West Michigan. Lake County was outscored 37-12 in the series (-25 run differential). The Captains' offense slashed .179/.265/.235 during the series and the pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA. Three of the games in the series were one-run losses, including a 1-0 loss in 10 innings on Wednesday, in which West Michigan won on a walk-off balk by Captains reliever Kellen Rholl. The most one-sided game of the series was a 17-5 final on Saturday, which included a pair of three-run home runs by #1 Tigers prospect Spencer Torkelson.

(HAC) in batting average (.179), on-base percentage (.271), slugging percentage (.254) and OPS (.525). The Captains have been outscored by 43 runs (65-22) during that stretch. They enter today with the lowest run total in the league in 2021 (84), which is also the second-lowest in all of High-A.

BANGED UP: The Captains currently have four players on the Injured List – OF George Valera, C Bryan Lavastida, LHP Raymond Burgos and LHP Matt Turner. Valera and Lavastida have not played since May 12.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is currently tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) lead in doubles (9). He is also sixth in on-base percentage (.407) and seventh in batting average (.311).

LIGHTS OUT: The Captains' pitching staff enters today with the second-lowest ERA (3.85) in the High-A Central League (HAC). Logan Allen has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the HAC at 0.83.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 84 times this season. That is the tied for the fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have two of the 10 lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League - Brayan Rocchio (4.3% - 1st) and José Tena (6.0% - 6th).

100: 2018 Captains RHP Eli Morgan became the 100th former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on Friday. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six ifferent second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's

LAST TIME OUT: Gaddis struck out seven Whitecaps and walked one last Tuesday at West Michigan, but took the loss in a 4-3 Captains defeat. Gaddis had a strong first three innings. He struck out the side in the first, allowed just one two-out single in the second and struck out the side again in the third. The right-hander had seven K's over the first three frames. In the fourth, however, West Michigan opened with back-to-back singles and both men came around to score on a ground out and a sacrifice fly to tie the game at 2-2. Gaddis got out of the inning, but issued a leadoff walk in the fifth and reliever **Nathan Ocker** allowed the inherited runner to score to give the Whitecaps the lead. West Michigan held the lead to saddle Gaddis with the loss.

PROSPECTING: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

GEORGIA STATE STAR: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

PANTHER PRO'S: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

TEAM USA: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
