YESTERDAY: The Captains lost their third straight to the West Michigan Whitecaps, 6-2 yesterday. The Whitecaps jumped in front in the first inning with three runs on three hits off of Captains starter Raymond Burgos. In the third they added another tally with three consecutive singles to make the score 4-0. In the fifth they extended their lead to 5-0 against Captains reliever Kevin Coulter. Bryant Packard went from first to third on a wild pitch and scored on an RBI single by Dillon Dingler. In the sixth the Captains ended an 18 inning scoreless drought when Aaron Bracho delivered an RBI double. With the bases loaded and two outs Gianpaul Gonzalez drew a walk to force home another Captains run to make the score 5-2. The final run for the Whitecaps came in the eighth inning with Rey Rivera scoring on a sacrifice-fly by Jose King. The Captains offense mustered just three hits in the loss.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan currently leads the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (9). He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.434) and batting average (.328). Brennan is tied for fifth in the HAC in hits (21).

SLUMPING: The Captains enter today with the fewest runs scored (77) in the High-A Central League. Over the last eight games, Lake County has a team OPS of .541 and has been outscored 41-18 (23 runs).

PATIENCE: Though the Captains posted their lowest single-series team batting average against Great Lakes (.201), they produced their highest on-base percentage of any series this year (.323) thanks to their highest single-series walk total (33). Jonathan Engelmann (6 BB, .588 OBP) and Will Brennan (5 BB, .591 OBP) led the club during the series.

PITCHING POWERS CAPTAINS: The Captains' pitching staff enters today with the lowest WHIP (1.22) and the secondlowest ERA (3.37) in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County remains among the league's best staffs despite posting a 5.29 ERA during their series against Great Lakes last week, which increased the team's ERA by 89 points. Logan Allen has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the HAC at 0.83.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 75 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central League and the tied for fifth-fewest in High-A. The Captains also have three of the 14 lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – José Tena (4.3% - 5th), Brayan Rocchio (4.8% - 6th), Raynel Delgado (5.8% - 14th).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains are fourth in the High-A Central League and sixth in all of High-A with 40 stolen bases. Lake County base stealers have been caught seven times for an 85.1% success rate.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Bravan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or vounger.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains RHP Jean Carlos Mejia made his major league debut for Cleveland last Friday. He was the 99th former Captain to reach the big leagues and the 19,999th player in MLB history. Seven former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014) and Mejia (2018). The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

LAST TIME OUT: Burns took his first professional loss last Friday in an 8-2 defeat at Great Lakes. After working a one-two-three-first inning, Burns allowed back-to-back extra-base hits to start the second – a leadoff triple by Joe Vranesh and an RBI double by Carson Taylor – but the right-hander got the next three men to keep the deficit at 1-0. Burns pitched a scoreless third, but had to battle again in the fourth. The Loons put men on the corners with one out and Burns could not fight his way out of the jam. Leonel Valera hit a three-run home run to balloon Great Lakes' lead to 4-0. Burns was pulled after giving up a two-out single in the fifth. Reliever Jared Janczak came in and promptly allowed a two-run homer to score Burns' runner. Over a career-long 4.2 innings, Burns allowed career-highs in runs (five) and hits (7). Three of the Loons' hits went for extra bases.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS Carson Tucker (1st Round – 23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Logenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Logenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Logenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to leam.
