YESTERDAY: The Captains lost to the West Michigan Whitecaps, 1-0, on a 10th-inning walk-off balk. Rey Rivera scored the only run of the game when **Kellen Rholl** balked him home from third base with two outs in the 10th inning. Four Captains pitchers combined to two-hit West Michigan in the loss. Left-handed starter **Logan Allen** held the Whitecaps scoreless over six frames with five strikeouts and one walk. Both West Michigan hits came against Allen. The Captains' offense stranded five men on second base and squandered four doubles. Lake County did not advance a runner beyond second base in the game.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF **Will Brennan** currently leads the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (9). He is also second in on-base percentage (.465) and batting average (.356). The only qualified hitter with a better average than Brennan is Dayton's Brian Rey (.423), who is no longer in the league after being promoted to Double-A. Brennan is tied for fourth in the HAC in hits (21).

SLUMPING: The Captains enter today with the fewest runs scored (75) in the High-A Central League. Over the last seven games, Lake County has a team OPS of .565 and has been outscored 35-16 (19 runs).

PATIENCE: Though the Captains posted their lowest single-series team batting average against Great Lakes (.201), they produced their highest on-base percentage of any series this year (.323) thanks to their highest single-series walk total (33). **Jonathan Engelmann** (6 BB, .588 OBP) and **Will Brennan** (5 BB, .591 OBP) led the club during the series.

PITCHING POWERS CAPTAINS: The Captains' pitching staff enters today with the lowest WHIP (1.19) and the second-lowest ERA (3.32) in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County remains among the league's best staffs despite posting a 5.29 ERA during their series against Great Lakes last week, which increased the team's ERA by 89 points. **Logan Allen** has the second-lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the HAC at 0.83.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 69 times this season. That is the fewest in the High-A Central League and the fourth-fewest in High-A. The Captains also have three of the seven lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – **Brayan Rocchio** (3.8% - 3rd), **José Tena** (4.3% - 6th), **Raynel Delgado** (4.6% - 7th).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains are second in the High-A Central League and fourth in all of High-A with 38 stolen bases. Lake County base stealers have been caught seven times for an 81.6% success rate.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. **Raynel Delgado**, **Brayan Rocchio** and **José Tena** have each played three different infield positions. **Victor Nova** and **Daniel Schneemann** have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B **Joe Naranjo** (20), INF **Aaron Bracho** (20), INF **José Tena** (20), INF **Brayan Rocchio** (20) and OF **George Valera** (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains RHP **Jean Carlos Mejia** made his major league debut for Cleveland on Friday. He was the 99th former Captain to reach the big leagues and the 19,999th player in MLB history. Seven former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014) and Mejia (2018). The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

LAST TIME OUT: Burgos took the loss at Great Lakes after allowing four runs, three earned, over six innings last Thursday at Dow Diamond. The lefty gave up two first-inning runs on a two-run single by Carson Taylor. One of the first-inning runs was unearned because of an errant pickoff throw by Burgos. In the third, Great Lakes added two more runs on a leadoff homer by Miguel Vargas and an RBI single by Taylor. The Captains lost to the Loons, 5-3.

2019: Burgos was on the Captains' Opening Day roster and made eight starts for Lake County between April and mid-May. The lefty was placed on the Injured List on May 18 and missed the rest of the season. Across his eight starts, Burgos had a 3.44 ERA with 40 strikeouts and 12 walks over 36.2 innings.

2018: Burgos made his pro debut in the Arizona League and helped pitch the team to the playoffs with a 3-2 record and a 3.78 ERA across eight starts and four relief outings. He also got the ball in the playoffs and tossed 5.2 innings, striking out 10 and allowing one run on two hits and one walk. Burgos earned a late promotion to Mahoning Valley and started the Scrappers' final regular season game. He followed up his strong performance in the AZL playoffs with another 5.2-inning gem, blanking the West Virginia Black Bears and striking out nine with no walks.

ADVANCED STAT LEADER: Burgos was one of the top 10 pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018 by several different metrics. Among qualified pitchers, the lefty finished eighth in K% (26.5%), ninth in K-BB% (18.7%), ninth in FIP (3.38) and seventh in xFIP (3.33).

ERA-FIP: Among qualified pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018, Burgos had the fourth-largest positive difference between his ERA and his FIP. The lefty's E-F (ERA minus FIP) was 0.40 (3.78 ERA, 3.38 FIP). This could partially owe to a higher-than-average BABIP (batting average on balls in play) of .376. League average BABIP is typically about .300.

DELAYED START: Despite being drafted in 2016, Burgos did not make his professional debut until 2018 because of a shoulder injury. He had Tommy John surgery in 2016 and missed all of that season, plus all of 2017. He also missed the last three months of the 2019 season due to an arm injury that did not require surgery.

COLLEGE COMMIT: Burgos was committed to play college baseball at Florida A&M University before signing with the Indians.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Burgos turned in arguably the best start of his first professional season in an Arizona League playoff start. The lefty took the ball against the Rangers, opposed by rehabbing MLB right-hander Chi Chi Gonzalez. Burgos spun 5.2 stellar innings, in which he allowed just one run (a Stanley Martinez home run) on two hits and set a career-high with 10 strikeouts. He walked just one. The AZL Indians1 could not capitalize on Burgos' brilliant performance, however. The game remained tied at 1-1 going into extra innings. After the teams traded runs in the 10th to keep the game moving, the Rangers scored five in the 12th. The Indians' two runs in the bottom of the frame were not enough.
