YESTERDAY: The Captains scored two early runs but could not hold the lead on Tuesday in a 4-3 loss to West Michigan. Hunter Gaddis got the start for Lake County and struck out seven over four innings. He left the game with the scored tied at 2-2 but an inherited runner came around to score in the fifth inning to give the Whitecaps the lead. Trailing 4-2 entering the sixth inning, the Captains struck back on an RBI double by **Jonathan Engelmann** to make the score 4-3. In the top of the ninth the Captains threatened but left two on base to end the game.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan currently leads the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.478) and doubles (8). He is also second in the league in batting average (.364), but the only man above him, Dayton's Brian Rey (.423) is no longer in the league after being promoted to Double-A. Brennan is tied for fourth in the

PATIENCE: Though the Captains posted their lowest single-series team batting average against Great Lakes (.201), they produced their highest on-base percentage of any series this year (.323) thanks to their highest single-series walk total (33). **Jonathan Engelmann** (6 BB, .588 OBP) and **Will Brennan** (5 BB, .591 OBP) led the club during the series.

ERA SPIKE: The Captains' pitching stats took a hit last week. Lake County entered its series at Great Lakes with a 2.57 ERA that was good for second in the High-A Central League (HAC). During the Great Lakes series, the Captains' staff posted a 5.29 ERA. As a result, the Captains' 2021 team ERA jumped 89 points to 3.46. Lake County enters this series fourth in the HAC in team ERA.

SLUMPING: The Captains enter today with the fewest runs scored (75) in the High-A Central League. Over the last six games, Lake County has a team OPS of .584 and has been outscored 34-16 (18 runs).

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 68 times this season. That is the fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have three of the seven lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League - Brayan Rocchio (4.1% - 4th), José Tena (4.5% - 6th), Raynel Delgado (4.6% - 7th).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains are second in the High-A Central League and fourth in all of High-A with 38 stolen bases. Lake County base stealers have been caught six times for an 86.3% success rate. According to FanGraphs, Raynel Delgado is sixth in the High-A Central League in Weighted Stolen Base Runs (wSB) at 0.8, meaning Delgado's base stealing has contributed 0.8 more runs for his team than the average league player. **Will Brennan** is 14th at 0.4.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains RHP **Jean Carlos Mejia** made his major league debut for Cleveland on Friday. He was the 99th former Captain to reach the big leagues and the 19,999th player in MLB history. Seven former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014) and Mejia (2018). The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

LAST TIME OUT: Allen worked into the sixth inning for the first time in his professional career last Wednesday at Great Lakes. Across 5.2 innings, Allen scattered seven hits and struck out seven. He allowed the first earned run of his career on a solo home run by Leonel Valera in the third inning. Allen allowed another run in the sixth inning to make the score 2-0, but the Captains stormed back behind home runs from **Daniel Schneemann** and **Brayan Rocchio** to steal a 3-2 win. Allen did not factor in the decision.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Allen was named a Preseason All-American by several outlets ahead of the shortened 2020 season and was also named the 2020 Conference USA Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Allen racked up five C-USA Pitcher of the Week honors during his career, including in 2020 after pitching a seven-inning, one-hitter with 13 strikeouts against George Mason. Allen was twice honored with All-CUSA nods as a position player. He was named as a utility player on the All-CUSA 2nd Team as a freshman and on the All-CUSA 1st Team as a sophomore. He was named a Freshman All-American by three different outlets in 2018.

TEAM USA: In 2019, Allen became the first FIU Panther ever selected to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Allen in the second round (56th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Allen was Cleveland's third selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1st Round – 23rd overall) and RHP **Tanner Burns** (CBA Round – 36th overall).

TWO-WAY: Allen was a two-way player at Florida International University, playing first base when he wasn't pitching. He was even named to the All-CUSA 2nd Team as a freshman and the All-CUSA 1st Team as a sophomore, both as a utility player. In three seasons at FIU, Allen played 50 games at first base. He batted .297/.362/.410 (.773 OPS) during his career with six home runs, eight doubles and 23 RBI. As a freshman, when Allen played the most as a two-way player, he posted a career-best .390 OBP.

NOT THAT LOGAN ALLEN: Allen shares the same name as Cleveland's big league left-hander **Logan Allen**. The younger Allen said last year, "he reached out to me after the draft, and we talked... It's really funny. Maybe there can be some marketing possibilities one day."

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the sixth round of the 2016 draft out of University High School (Orange City, FL).

COLLEGE COACH: Allen has known his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, since he was five years old. Allen played "Pony Baseball" and travel baseball with Melendez's oldest son. Melendez helped coach the boys from a young age. "We consider [Logan] very dear to our family and he's like another son to me." Logan's brother, Hunter, also played college baseball for Melendez at Alabama State from 2014-16 (Hunter is now the assistant softball coach at FIU).

CHANGEUP: Allen's changeup – a circle change grip – is regarded as his best secondary pitch. According to his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), the development of that changeup goes back to Allen's youth. Melendez said he did not allow Allen to throw anything but a fastball and a changeup (no curveballs) until Allen was 12 years old. *MLB.com*'s scouting report of Allen's changeup notes "his changeup is his bread and butter, a potentially future plus circle change he sells really well with good fade and sink that misses bats and elicits weak contact on the ground."

DELIVERY: Eric Longenhagen of *FanGraphs* notes Allen's athleticism as a two-way player has helped him maintain a "well-balanced, repeatable delivery." Allen's college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who also coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), says of Allen's delivery "when [Logan] first started pitching at seven, you kind of saw the mechanical aspect of his pitching was a little bit more advanced than anybody else."
