SUNDAY: The Captains ended a three-game losing streak with a 4-3 win over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond. Captains starter Mason Hickman spun five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. He allowed just two hits and two walks, en route to the win. Lake County scored the first four runs of the game, including a fourth-inning solo homer by José Tena and a fifth-inning two-run double by Joe Naranjo. The Captains still led 4-0 into the eighth when Loons DH Ryan Ward hit a two-run double to trim the Captains' lead to 4-2. The Loons threatened again in the ninth. Great Lakes put runners on second and third with nobody out on a Brayan Rocchio error at shortstop and a eonel Valera double. Reliever Jared Janczak escaped allowing just one run, on a Justin Yurchak RBI ground out, to earn the save.

LAST SERIES: The Captains split a six-game series with the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond, Lake County won the first two games, 10-6 and 3-2. The Loons won the next three straight, 5-3, 8-2 and 12-1. The Captains salvaged the final game, 4-3.

PATIENCE: Though the Captains posted their lowest single-series team batting average against Great Lakes (.201), they produced their highest on-base percentage of any series this year (.323) thanks to their highest single-series walk total (33). Jonathan Engelmann (6 BB, .588 OBP) and Will Brennan (5 BB, .591 OBP) led the club during the series

ERA SPIKE: The Captains' pitching stats took a hit last week. Lake County entered its series at Great Lakes with a 2.57 ERA that was good for second in the High-A Central League (HAC). During the Great Lakes series, the Captains' staff posted a 5.29 ERA. As a result, the Captains' 2021 team ERA jumped 89 points to 3.46. Lake County enters this series fourth in the HAC in team ERA

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 64 times this season. That is the fewest in the High-A Central League and tied for the third fewest in all of High-A. The Captains also have four of the 12 lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – José Tena (3.2% - 3<sup>rd</sup>), Brayan Rocchio (4.3% - 9<sup>th</sup>), Raynel Delgado (4.9% - 10<sup>th</sup>) and Joe Naranjo (5.1% -- 12<sup>th</sup>).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains are tied for second in the High-A Central League and tied for third in all of High-A with 35 stolen bases. Lake County base stealers have been caught six times for an 85.4% success rate. According to FanGraphs, Raynel Delgado is sixth in the High-A Central League in Weighted Stolen Base Runs (wSB) at 0.8, meaning Delgado's base stealing has contributed 0.8 more runs for his team han the average league player. Will Brennan is 12th at 0.5

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021, Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, five different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League - 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains RHP Jean Carlos Mejia made his major league debut for Cleveland on Friday. He was the 99th former Captain to reach the big leagues and the 19,999th player in MLB history. Seven former Captains have made their major league debuts this ear - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin 2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014) and Mejia (2018). The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year is nine (2013 and 2016).

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth season coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Gaddis lasted just three innings last Tuesday at Great Lakes. The right-hander held the Loons scoreless over the first two innings on two singles and a hit-batsman. In the third, however, Gaddis ran into trouble. He loaded the bases with one out on two singles and a walk. Gaddis then walked Deacon Liput with two outs and the bases loaded to force in a run. Gaddis ran up a 62 pitch count and was done after three innings. The Captains went on to win, 10-6.

**PROSPECTING**: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

**GEORGIA STATE STAR**: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team All Sun-Belt selection.

**PANTHER PRO'S**: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

**TEAM USA**: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
