LAST NIGHT: The Captains came from behind to win their third straight game, 3-2, over the Loons. A two-run home run for **Daniel Schneemann** in the top of the seventh inning tied the game 2-2. In the top of the ninth **Brayan Roccio** launched the go-ahead home run on a solo shot to right field. **Logan Allen** made his third start of the season for the Captains, working a career high 5.2 innings and striking out seven. **Tim Herrin** tossed 2.1 scoreless innings in relief to earn the win. In the ninth **Nick Gallagher** walked the first two batters of the inning but escaped the jam for his second save.

PITCHING POWERS CAPS: The Captains' pitching staff leads the High-A Central League in ERA (2.78). Lake County is second in WHIP (1.15), strikeouts (154) and opponents' batting average (.212).

RED HOT WEEK: Over the course of last week (May 11-16), the Captains' pitching staff had the lowest ERA (1.83) and the second-lowest opponent's batting average (.160) in all of High-A. The Captains' offense led the High-A Central League last week in batting average (.254) and slugging percentage (.422). **José Tena** led the Lake County offense. Tena went 8-for-19 (.421) with three home runs, one double and six RBI.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 48 times this season. That is the second fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have four of the 11 lowest BB% rates in the High-A Central League – **Brayan Roccio** (3.6% - 2nd), **José Tena** (4.0% - 7th), **Joe Naranjo** (4.3% – 10th) and **Raynel Delgado** (4.4% - 11th).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains lead the High-A Central, are second in High-A and tied for second in all of Minor League Baseball with 32 stolen bases. Lake County baserunners have only been caught four times for a success rate of 88.9%. According to FanGraphs, **Raynel Delgado** is fifth in the High-A Central League in Weighted Stolen Base Runs (WSB) at 1.0, meaning Delgado's base stealing has contributed one more run for his team than the average league player. **Will Brennan** is ninth at 0.5.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first basemen, six different second basemen, five different third basemen and two different shortstops. **Raynel Delgado**, **Brayan Roccio** and **José Tena** have each played three different infield positions. **Victor Nova** and **Daniel Schneemann** have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B **Joe Naranjo** (20), INF **Aaron Bracho** (20), INF **José Tena** (20), INF **Brayan Roccio** (20) and OF **George Valera** (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW LEAGUE: The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a member of the South Atlantic League (SAL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

CAPTAINS AGAIN: 15 players on the Captains' Opening Day roster played for Lake County previously: RHP **Nick Gallagher** (2018-19), LHP **Tim Herrin** (2019), RHP **Thomas Ponticelli** (2018-19), LHP **Kellen Rholl** (2019), RHP **Alex Royalty** (2019), LHP **Matt Turner** (2019), RHP **Raymond Burgos** (2019), C **Gianpaul Gonzalez** (2018-19), C **Bryan Lavastida** (2019), INF **Raynel Delgado** (2019), INF **Daniel Schneemann** (2018-19), OF/1B **Jonathan Engelmann** (2019), OF **Quentin Holmes** (2019), OF **George Valera** (2019) and OF **Austin Wade** (2018).

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth season coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

2020 DRAFT: The Captains have three players on their Opening Day roster who were selected by Cleveland in last year's draft: RHP **Tanner Burns** (Competitive Balance Round A), LHP **Logan Allen** (2nd Round), and RHP **Mason Hickman** (5th Round).

2017 INTERNATIONAL CLASS: There were four Captains acquired by Cleveland in the 2017 International free agent class, led by OF **George Valera**. According to Baseball America, Valera was the sixth overall international prospect that year. Also now on the Captains from that class are INF **Aaron Bracho**, INF **Brayan Roccio** and INF **José Tena**. Bracho received the highest signing bonus of Cleveland's 2017 international signees at \$1.5 million.

LAST TIME OUT: Burgos returned to the mound with three scoreless innings in his 2021 debut. He allowed two hits and struck out four TinCaps in an 8-2 Captains win.

2019: Burgos was on the Captains' Opening Day roster and made eight starts for Lake County between April and mid-May. The lefty was placed on the Injured List on May 18 and missed the rest of the season. Across his eight starts, Burgos had a 3.44 ERA with 40 strikeouts and 12 walks over 36.2 innings.

2018: Burgos made his pro debut in the Arizona League and helped pitch the team to the playoffs with a 3-2 record and a 3.78 ERA across eight starts and four relief outings. He also got the ball in the playoffs and tossed 5.2 innings, striking out 10 and allowing one run on two hits and one walk. Burgos earned a late promotion to Mahoning Valley and started the Scrappers' final regular season game. He followed up his strong performance in the AZL playoffs with another 5.2-inning gem, blanking the West Virginia Black Bears and striking out nine with no walks.

ADVANCED STAT LEADER: Burgos was one of the top 10 pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018 by several different metrics. Among qualified pitchers, the lefty finished eighth in K% (26.5%), ninth in K-BB% (18.7%), ninth in FIP (3.38) and seventh in xFIP (3.33).

ERA-FIP: Among qualified pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018, Burgos had the fourth-largest positive difference between his ERA and his FIP. The lefty's E-F (ERA minus FIP) was 0.40 (3.78 ERA, 3.38 FIP). This could partially owe to a higher-than-average BABIP (batting average on balls in play) of .376. League average BABIP is typically about .300.

DELAYED START: Despite being drafted in 2016, Burgos did not make his professional debut until 2018 because of a shoulder injury. He had Tommy John surgery in 2016 and missed all of that season, plus all of 2017.

COLLEGE COMMIT: Burgos was committed to play college baseball at Florida A&M University before signing with the Indians.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Burgos turned in arguably the best start of his first professional season in an Arizona League playoff start. The lefty took the ball against the Rangers, opposed by rehabbing MLB right-hander Chi Chi Gonzalez. Burgos spun 5.2 stellar innings, in which he allowed just one run (a Stanley Martinez home run) on two hits and set a career-high with 10 strikeouts. He walked just one. The AZL Indians1 could not capitalize on Burgos' brilliant performance, however. The game remained tied at 1-1 going into extra innings. After the teams traded runs in the 10th to keep the game moving, the Rangers scored five in the 12th. The Indians' two runs in the bottom of the frame were not enough.
