LAST NIGHT: The Captains scored a season-high 10 runs, including seven in the fifth inning, to beat the Great Lakes Loons, 10-6. Lake County. Mike Amditis dealt the big blow in the fifth with a three-run double. Aaron Bracho added insurance when he hit a solo homer in the eighth for his first home run of the season. The Loons nearly came back in the ninth, but Kevin Kelly shut the door. Great Lakes loaded the bases with nobody out on two bit atsmen and a walk by Kellen Rholl. Kelly came in and struck out all three men he faced to end the game and nail down the save. Nic Enright pitched 2.1 scoreless innings to pick up the win. The Captains' offense also set a season-high by drawing 10 walks in the game.

PITCHING POWERS CAPS: The Captains' pitching staff leads the High-A Central League in WHIP (1.14). Lake County is second in the league in ERA

RED HOT WEEK: Over the course of last week (May 11-16), the Captains' pitching staff had the lowest ERA (1.83) and the second-lowest opponent's batting average (.160) in all of High-A. The Captains' offense led the High-A Central League last week in batting average (.254) and slugging percentage .422). José Tena led the Lake County offense. Tena went 8-for-19 (.421) with three home runs, one double and six RBI.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 41 times this season. That is the fewest in the High-A Central League and the third-fewest in all of High-A. The Captains also have three of the 10 lowest BB% rates in the High-A Central League – Brayan Rocchio (3.9% - 5th), José Tena (4.4% - 8th), Raynel Delgado (4.4% - 9th).

RUNNING WILD: The Captains are lead the High-A Central, are second in High-A and fourth in all of Minor League Baseball with 30 stolen bases. Lake County baserunners have only been caught four times for a success rate of 88.2%. According to FanGraphs, Raynel Delgado is fourth in the High-A Central League in Weighted Stolen Base Runs (wSB) at 1.0, meaning Delgado's base stealing has contributed one more run for his team than the verage league player. Will Brennan is ninth at 0.5

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different econd baseman, five different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova has played two different infield positions and left field

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight layers who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW LEAGUE: The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a member of the South Atlantic League (SAL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

CAPTAINS AGAIN: 15 players on the Captains' Opening Day roster played for Lake County previously: RHP Nick Gallagher (2018-19), LHP Tim Herrin (2019), RHP Thomas Ponticelli (2018-19), LHP Kellen Rholl (2019), RHP Alex Royalty (2019), LHP Matt Turner (2019), RHP Raymond Burgos (2019), C Gianpaul Gonzalez (2018-19), C Bryan Lavastida (2019), INF Raynel Delgado (2019), INF Daniel Schneemann (2018-19), OF/1B Jonathan Engelmann (2019), OF Quentin Holmes (2019), OF George Valera (2019) and OF Austen Wade (2018)

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth ason coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

2020 DRAFT: The Captains have three players on their Opening Day roster who were selected by Cleveland in last year's draft. RHP Tanner Burns (Competitive Balance Round A), LHP Logan Allen (2nd Round), and RHP Mason Hickman (5th Round).

2017 INTERNATIONAL CLASS: There were four Captains acquired by Cleveland in the 2017 International free agent class, led by OF George Valera. According to Baseball America, Valera was the sixth overall international prospect that year. Also now on the Captains from that class are INF Aeron Bracho, INF Brayan Rocchio and INF Jose Tena. Brach received the highest signing bonus of Cleveland's 2017 international signees at \$1.5 million.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allen made his second professional start on Wednesday, May 12 against Fort Wayne in a 5-3 Captains victory. Over five scoreless innings, Allen struck out seven, including five in the first three innings. In the top of the fifth inning, the TinCaps loaded the bases but Allen struck out Tirso Ornelas to extend his scoreless streak to ten innings to begin his career.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Allen was named a Preseason All-American by several outlets ahead of the shortened 2020 season and was also named the 2020 Conference USA Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Allen racked up five C-USA Pitcher of the Week honors during his career, including in 2020 after pitching a seven-inning, one-hitter with 13 strikeouts against George Mason. Allen was twice honored with All-CUSA nods as a position player. He was named as a utility player on the All-CUSA 2<sup>nd</sup> Team as a freshman and on the All-CUSA 1<sup>st</sup> Team as a sophomore. He was named a Freshman All-American by three different outlets in 2018.

**TEAM USA:** In 2019, Allen became the first FIU Panther ever selected to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Allen in the second round (56th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Allen was Cleveland's third selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1st Round – 23rd overall) and RHP **Tanner Burns** (CBA Round – 36th overall).

**TWO-WAY**: Allen was a two-way player at Florida International University, playing first base when he wasn't pitching. He was even named to the All-CUSA 2<sup>nd</sup> Team as a freshman and the All-CUSA 1<sup>st</sup> Team as a sophomore, both as a utility player. In three seasons at FIU, Allen played 50 games at first base. He batted .297/.362/.410 (.773 OPS) during his career with six home runs, eight doubles and 23 RBI. As a freshman, when Allen played the most as a two-way player, he posted a career-best .390 OBP.

**NOT THAT LOGAN ALLEN:** Allen shares the same name as Cleveland's big league left-hander **Logan Allen**. The younger Allen said last year, "he reached out to me after the draft, and we talked... It's really funny. Maybe there can be some marketing possibilities one day."

**PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED:** Originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the sixth round of the 2016 draft out of University High School (Orange City, FL).

COLLEGE COACH: Allen has known his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, since he was five years old. Allen played "Pony Baseball" and travel baseball with Melendez's oldest son. Melendez helped coach the boys from a young age. "We consider [Logan] very dear to our family and he's like another son to me." Logan's brother, Hunter, also played college baseball for Melendez at Alabama State from 2014-16 (Hunter is now the assistant softball coach at FIU).

**CHANGEUP:** Allen's changeup – a circle change grip – is regarded as his best secondary pitch. According to his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), the development of that changeup goes back to Allen's youth. Melendez said he did not allow Allen to throw anything but a fastball and a changeup (no curveballs) until Allen was 12 years old. *MLB.com*'s scouting report of Allen's changeup notes "his changeup is his bread and butter, a potentially future plus circle change he sells really well with good fade and sink that misses bats and elicits weak contact on the ground."

**DELIVERY:** Eric Longenhagen of *FanGraphs* notes Allen's athleticism as a two-way player has helped him maintain a "well-balanced, repeatable delivery." Allen's college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who also coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), says of Allen's delivery "when [Logan] first started pitching at seven, you kind of saw the mechanical aspect of his pitching was a little bit more advanced than anybody else."
