YESTERDAY: The Captains won their fourth straight game over the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 8-2. José Tena homered twice and doubled in a 3for-5 performance with three RBI. The game was tied at 2-2 until the seventh inning when the Captains scored three runs to take the lead, including a go-ahead RBI single by Aaron Bracho. Lake County scored three more runs in the eighth, including a two-run homer by Tena for his second of the night. Captains starter Tanner Burns struck out seven over four innings and held Fort Wayne to two runs on a two-run homer by Jonny Homza. Reliever **Kevin Kelly** earned the win with three scoreless innings. **Kellen Rholl** picked up a six-out save with two scoreless frames. Fort Wayne reliever Felix Minjarez allowed walked six and gave up two runs in two-plus innings to take the loss.

HOME COOKIN': The Captains are undefeated in four games at home. Offensively, Lake County leads all of High-A baseball in home batting average (.315). The Captains lead the High-A Central League (HA-C) in home slugging percentage (.523), OPS (.900) and stolen bases (14). Only two teams in all of Minor League Baseball - Reno (Triple-A; Arizona) and El Paso (Triple-A; San Diego) - have struck out less in their home park than the Captains (25), but those clubs have only played two home games compared to the Captains' four. The Captains' pitching staff has posted a 1.75 ERA at home, which is tied for the lowest home ERA in the HA-C with the Beloit Snappers (Miami).

TENA ON A TEAR: José Tena is 7-for-12 with three home runs, a double, six RBI and six runs scored in the three games he has played against Fort Wayne. He leads all of Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (1.417) and OPS (2.000) during that stretch. Tena also leads the High-Á Central League in batting average (.583), on-base percentage (.583), home runs (3), extrá-base hits (4), RBI (6), runs (6) and total bases (17) since Tuesday. Tena's batting average has jumped 165 points (.158 to .323). His on-base percentage has increased 126 points (.238 to .364). His slugging percentage has improved by 466 points (.211 to .677). His OPS has jumped 592 points (.449 to 1.041).

SUDDEN SLUG: With 13 extra-base hits in their last two games, the Captains' slugging percentage has jumped 70 points. Lake County entered Thursday with a .307 slugging percentage. The club now has the fourth-highest slugging percentage in the High-A Central League at

RUNNING WILD: The Captains lead the High-A Central League with 26 stolen bases. Lake County base runners have been caught just four imes for an 86.7% success rate.

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense is last in the High-A Central League and fourth from the bottom in all of Minor League Baseball with 28 walks. Lake County has 35 fewer walks than the Great Lakes Loons (High-A; Los Angeles – NL) who lead the league and are third in MiLB

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League - 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW LEAGUE: The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a nember of the South Atlantic League (SĂL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball eague and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's rganization.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Turner took the loss last Saturday at Lansing. The left-hander surrendered two runs across four innings with three hits, no walks and one strikeout. Both Lansing runs against Turner came in the third. Max Schuemann led off with a double, stole third and scored on a wild throw by catcher **Bryan Lavastida**. Michael Guldberg hit a solo homer later in the inning. Those two runs were the only tallies of the game. Lansing won, 2-0.

2020 Training: Trained at Cressey Sports Performance and Bommarito Performance, both of which are located in Turner's home state of Florida. Eric Cressey, the president and co-founder of Cressey Sports Performance, is a celebrity in the performance coaching world. Cressey has been the Director of Player Health & Performance for the New York Yankees since January 2020 and has worked with big league stars like Corey Kluber, Noah Syndergaard and Max Scherzer, according to an <a href="MLB.com article">MLB.com article</a> about his hiring. Matt Blake, formerly Cleveland's director of pitching development and now the Yankees' pitching coach, had previously served as the pitching coordinator at Cressey Sports Performance. <a href="Bommarito Performance's website">Bommarito Performance's website</a> lists professional athlete clientele that includes Miguel Cabrera, JD Martinez, Carlos Santana, Ezekiel Elliott, Rob Gronkowski and Stefon Diogs.

**2019:** Turner started the year with Short Season Mahoning Valley and went 2-2 with a 2.90 ERA over six starts. He was promoted to Low-A Lake County in mid-July and finished the season with the Captains. Turner made nine starts with the Captains and went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA.

**2018:** Turner returned to the Arizona League for the second year, pitching for the Arizona League Indians 1. He made three starts and four relief appearances, posting a 3.75 ERA (15 ER, 36 IP). Turner struck out 36 batters in 36 innings with eight walks and lowered his batting average against to .250 with a 324 BABIP.

2017: After signing with Cleveland, Turner made 10 appearances (three starts, followed by seven relief appearances) for the Rookie level Arizona League Indians. The lefty was limited to a max of three innings per outing and allowed 18 ER over 24 IP (6.75 ERA). Turner struck out 22 hitters in 24 innings and walked eight, but batters hit .340 against him with a .417 BABIP.

DRAFTED YOUNG: Turner was only 17-years old when the Indians drafted him out of Miami Palmetto HS (FL).

MIAMI PALMETTO: Notable alumni from Miami Palmetto High School include Amazon Founder and wealthiest person on Earth Jeff Bezos (net worth \$165.4 billion), late mixed martial artist Kimbo Slice, Dallas Mavericks shooting guard Tim Hardaway, Jr., Miami Marlins radio play-by-play announcer, Glenn Geffner, Tampa Bay Rays third base coach Tom Foley, former Florida Marlins pitcher Bill Hurst, former major League pitcher Vinnie Chulk (Blue Jays, Giants, Indians and Brewers) and former major league third baseman/outfielder Wade Rowdon (Reds, Cubs and Orioles).
