YESTERDAY: The Captains beat the Fort Wayne TinCaps for the second straight night. Logan Allen held Fort Wayne scoreless over five innings to earn the win. The lefty stranded seven baserunners, including five in scoring position, and struck out seven. José Tena keyed the aptains' offense from the leadoff spot. Tena went 3-for-4 and hit a long home run to right-centerfield in the third inning for his first of the season. He also stole a base and scored three times. Lake County held a 5-0 lead after six innings, but Fort Wayne battled back. The TinCaps scored a run in the seventh on an RBI triple by Reinaldo llarraza and two more in the eighth on an RBI double by Luis Almanzar and an RBI single by Ethan Skender. Nick Gallagher helped the Captains escape trouble in the eighth and closed out the game in the ninth. Gallagher struck out Jawuan Harris to leave two men on base in the eighth and retired all three men he faced in the ninth to earn the save.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second-youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger

IN THE WIN COLUMN: Wednesday was the Captains' first win in 608 days since their victory in game two of the 2019 Midwest League Quarterfinals on September 5, 2019. Their win last night was their first victory at home in 617 days since defeating the Great Lakes Loons on

LONG AWAITED: The Captains' return to Classic Park last night was the team's first home game in 615 days. On September 4, 2019, the aptains hosted the first game of the Midwest League quarterfinals against the Great Lakes Loons and lost, 6-4.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW LEAGUE: The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a member of the South Atlantic League (SAL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball eague and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization

CAPTAINS AGAIN: 15 players on the Captains' Opening Day roster played for Lake County previously: RHP Nick Gallagher (2018-19), LHP Tim Herrin (2019), RHP Thomas Ponticelli (2018-19), LHP Kellen Rholl (2019), RHP Alex Royalty (2019), LHP Matt Turner (2019), RHP Raymond Burgos (2019), C Gianpaul Gonzalez (2018-19), C Bryan Lavastida (2019), INF Raynel Delgado (2019), INF Daniel Schneemann (2018-19), OF/1B Jonathan Engelmann (2019), OF Quentin Holmes (2019), OF George Valera (2019) and OF Austen

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth season coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff perth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

2020 DRAFT: The Captains have three players on their Opening Day roster who were selected by Cleveland in last year's draft. RHP Tanner Burns (Competitive Balance Round A), LHP Logan Allen (2[∞] Round), and RHP Mason Hickman (5[∞] Round).

2017 INTERNATIONAL CLASS: There were four Captains acquired by Cleveland in the 2017 International free agent class, led by OF George Valera. According to Baseball America, Valera was the sixth overall international prospect that year. Also now on the Captains from hat class are INF Aaron Bracho, INF Brayan Rocchio and INF Jose Tena. Brach received the highest signing bonus of Cleveland's 2017 nternational signees at \$1.5 million

SWITCH IT UP: Only 1/3 of Captains' position players are true right-handed hitters. The Captains have three (3) switch-hitters, seven (7) leftanded hitters and five (5) right-handed hitters.

2019: Burgos was on the Captains' Opening Day roster and made eight starts for Lake County between April and mid-May. The lefty was placed on the Injured List on May 18 and missed the rest of the season. Across his eight starts, Burgos had a 3.44 ERA with 40 strikeouts and 12 walks over 36.2 innings.

2018: Burgos made his pro debut in the Arizona League and helped pitch the team to the playoffs with a 3-2 record and a 3.78 ERA across eight starts and four relief outings. He also got the ball in the playoffs and tossed 5.2 innings, striking out 10 and allowing one run on two hits and one walk. Burgos earned a late promotion to Mahoning Valley and started the Scrappers' final regular season game. He followed up his strong performance in the AZL playoffs with another 5.2-inning gem, blanking the West Virginia Black Bears and striking out nine with no walks.

ADVANCED STAT LEADER: Burgos was one of the top 10 pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018 by several different metrics. Among qualified pitchers, the lefty finished eighth in K% (26.5%), ninth in K-BB% (18.7%), ninth in FIP (3.38) and seventh in xFIP (3.33).

ERA-FIP: Among qualified pitchers in the Arizona League in 2018, Burgos had the fourth-largest positive difference between his ERA and his FIP. The lefty's E-F (ERA minus FIP) was 0.40 (3.78 ERA, 3.38 FIP). This *could* partially owe to a higher-than-average BABIP (batting average on balls in play) of .376. League average BABIP is typically about .300.

DELAYED START: Despite being drafted in 2016, Burgos did not make his professional debut until 2018 because of an injury. He had arm surgery in 2016 and missed all of that season, plus all of 2017.

COLLEGE COMMIT: Burgos was committed to play college baseball at Florida A&M University before signing with the Indians.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Burgos turned in arguably the best start of his first professional season in an Arizona League playoff start. The lefty took the ball against the Rangers, opposed by rehabbing MLB right-hander Chi Chi Gonzalez. Burgos spun 5.2 stellar innings, in which he allowed just one run (a Stanley Martinez home run) on two hits and set a career-high with 10 strikeouts. He walked just one. The AZL Indians1 could not capitalize on Burgos' brilliant performance, however, the game remained tied at 1-1 going into extra innings. After the teams traded runs in the 10th to keep the game moving, the Rangers scored five in the 12th. The Indians' two runs in the bottom of the frame were not enough.
