**SUNDAY:** The Captains lost the finale of a six-game series against the Lansing Lugnuts at Jackson Field, 5-2. Three home runs propelled the Lansing offense. Jake Suddleson hit a leadoff homer off of Captains starter **Mason Hickman** in the third. Shane Selman hit a two-out, two-run homer off of Hickman in the fourth, which was the final pitch Hickman threw in his pro debut. Michael Guldberg led off the eighth with a home run off of Captains reliever **Jared Janczak**. The Captains' runs came in the fifth and sixth innings. **Will Brennan** singled home **Joe Naranjo** in the fifth. **Raynel Delgado** singled to score **George Valera** in the sixth. Hickman took the loss with a final line of 3.2 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 BB, 6 K. Lansing reliever Bryce Nightengale pitched 2/3 of an inning of scoreless baseball for the win. Jack Weisenburger set down the Captains in order in the ninth for the save.

**LAST SERIES:** The Captains split a three-game road series with the Lansing Lugnuts at Jackson Field to open the 2021 season. After the Lugnuts took game one, 8-1, the Captains won three in a row by final scores of 3-1, 7-6 and 6-2. Lake County's 7-6 win on Thursday was the team's first come-from-behind win of the season, keyed by a four-run seventh inning. **Brayan Rocchio** delivered the go-ahead single and right fielder **Jonathan Engelmann** made a game-saving basket catch in the right-centerfield gap, for the final out of the contest, with the tying run on third base. The Captains lost the last two games of the series, 2-0 and 5-2.

**YOUNGSTERS:** The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League - 1B **Joe Naranjo** (20), INF **Aaron Bracho** (20), INF **José Tena** (20), INF **Brayan Rocchio** (20) and OF **George Valera** (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turns 20 today, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second-youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

**ON THE GROUND:** Captains hitters consistently put the ball on the ground in their season-opening series. Lake County's offense leads the High-A Central League with a 2.73 ground out-to-air out ratio (GO/AO). The next-highest GO/AO belongs to Peoria Chiefs (St. Louis) at 1.51. The Captains' pitching staff also produced the league's third-highest GO/AO at 1.41.

**IN THE WIN COLUMN:** Wednesday was the Captains' first win in 608 days, since their victory in game two of the 2019 Midwest League Quarterfinals on September 5, 2019. It was also their first regular season victory in 611 days, since defeating the Great Lakes Loons on September 2, 2019.

**LONG AWAITED:** The Captains will return to Classic Park for their home opener on May 11, which will mark Lake County's first home game in 615 days. On September 4, 2019, the Captains hosted the first game of the Midwest League quarterfinals against the Great Lakes Loons and lost, 6-4.

**HIGH-A:** The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**NEW LEAGUE:** The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a member of the South Atlantic League (SAL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

**NEW SKIPPER:** Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

**CAPTAINS AGAIN:** 14 players on the Captains' Opening Day roster played for Lake County previously: RHP **Nick Gallagher** (2018-19), LHP **Tim Herrin** (2019), RHP **Thomas Ponticelli** (2018-19), LHP **Kellen Rholl** (2019), RHP **Alex Royalty** (2019), LHP **Matt Turner** (2019), C **Giampaol Gonzalez** (2018-19), C **Bryan Lavastida** (2019), INF **Raynel Delgado** (2019), INF **Daniel Schneemann** (2018-19), OF/1B **Jonathan Engelmann** (2019), OF **Quentin Holmes** (2019), OF **George Valera** (2019) and OF **Austen Wade** (2018)

**NOW IN THE DUGOUT:** Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth season coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench Coach. Smith led the Captains with a .316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

**2020 DRAFT:** The Captains have three players on their Opening Day roster who were selected by Cleveland in last year's draft. RHP **Tanner Burns** (Competitive Balance Round A), LHP **Logan Allen** (2nd Round), and RHP **Mason Hickman** (5th Round).

**2017 INTERNATIONAL CLASS:** There were four Captains acquired by Cleveland in the 2017 International free agent class, led by OF **George Valera**. According to Baseball America, Valera was the sixth overall international prospect that year. Also now on the Captains from that class are INF **Aaron Bracho**, INF **Brayan Rocchio** and INF **Jose Tena**. Brach received the highest signing bonus of Cleveland's 2017 international signees at \$1.5 million.

**SWITCH IT UP:** Only 1/3 of Captains' position players are true right-handed hitters. The Captains have three (3) switch-hitters, seven (7) left-handed hitters and five (5) right-handed hitters.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Gaddis took the loss in the 2021 season-opener at Lansing. The right-hander surrendered seven runs, four earned, over three-plus innings. In the first inning, Gaddis issued a two-out walk to Ryan Gridley and Jordan Diaz followed with a two-run home run. Lansing hit RBI doubles in three consecutive innings. Drew Millas doubled in a run in the second, Lester Madden, Jr. added an RBI double in the third and Michael Guldberg hit an RBI double in the fourth. Gaddis exited with the bases loaded and nobody out in the fourth. Reliever **Thomas Ponticelli** allowed two inherited runners to score on a sacrifice fly and an RBI single. The Captains lost, 8-1.

**PROSPECTING:** Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

**NO-HITTER:** On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

**GEORGIA STATE STAR:** Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

**PANTHER PRO'S:** David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

**TEAM USA:** In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
