YESTERDAY: The Captains won their third straight game with a 6-2 victory over the Lansing Lugnuts. Tanner Burns shut out Lansing over four innings in his professional debut and registered six strikeouts. Austen Wade ignited the offense with a solo homer in the second for the Captains' first long ball of the year. The Captains added two runs in the third, including an RBI double by Will Brennan. Victor Nova tacked on a tally in the seventh with an RBI single. Lake County plated two more in the eighth, including an RBI single by Joe Naranjo. The Captains carried a 6-1 lead into the ninth inning and Lansing rallied, but came up short. With two outs and runners on second and third, Michael Guldberg hit a ground ball to shortstop and a Brayan Rocchio error allowed the game to continue. Vance scored on the play to cut the Captains' lead to 6-2 and the Lugnuts had runners on the corners with the tying run in the on deck circle. Kevin Kelly, however, came in to reliever lefty Kellen Rholl and promptly ended the game. Kelly got Drew Millas to fly out to right on the first pitch to secure the win. Kelly picked up his second save, while reliever Kevin Coulter earned the win. Coulter allowed one run over three nnings. Lansing starter Reid Birlingmair took the loss after allowing three runs over five innings.

ON THE RUN: The Captains are tied for third in the High-A Central League with nine stolen bases (9-for-11). The Dayton Dragons (Cincinnati) also have nine steals (9-for-11) and the South Bend Cubs (Chicago - NL) also have nine (9-for-9). The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee) lead the league with 14 steals (14-for-15), followed by the Quad Cities River Bandits (Kansas City) with 12 (12-for-12).

IN THE WIN COLUMN: Wednesday was the Captains' first win in 608 days, since their victory in game two of the 2019 Midwest League Quarterfinals on September 5, 2019. It was also their first regular season victory in 611 days, since defeating the Great Lakes Loons on September 2, 2019.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW LEAGUE: The Captains begin 2021 playing in a brand new league. As part of the restructuring of the minor leagues, the Captains are now members of the High-A Central League (HA-C). This marks the third different league in the Captains' 19-year history. Lake County was a member of the South Atlantic League (SAL) from 2003-2009 (11 seasons) and the Midwest League from 2010-2020 (10 seasons; 11 years).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence Iniversity. DiCenzo enters his second year and first season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

CAPTAINS AGAIN: 14 players on the Captains' Opening Day roster played for Lake County previously: RHP Nick Gallagher (2018-19), LHP Tim Herrin (2019), RHP Thomas Ponticelli (2018-19), LHP Kellen Rholl (2019), RHP Alex Royalty (2019), LHP Matt Turner (2019), C Gianpaul Gonzalez (2018-19), C Bryan Lavastida (2019), INF Raynel Delgado (2019), INF Daniel Schneemann (2018-19), OF/1B Jonathan Engelmann (2019), OF Quentin Holmes (2019), OF George Valera (2019) and OF Austen Wade (2018)

LONG AWAITED: Tuesday marked the Captains' first game in 606 days. On September 6, 2019 the Captains lost the decisive game in a best-of-three Midwest League quarterfinal series to the Great Lakes Loons, 5-0, at Dow Diamond in Midland, MI. It was the Captains' first regular season game in 610 days. On September 2, 2019, the Captains defeated the Great Lakes Loons, 6-3, at Classic Park. The Captains will return to Classic Park for their home opener on May 11, which will mark Lake County's first home game in 615 days. On September 4, 2019, the Captains hosted the first game of the Midwest eague quarterfinals against the Great Lakes Loons and lost, 6-4.

NOW IN THE DUGOUT: Grant Fink returns to Lake County in his first year as Captains Hitting Coach. Fink was a Captains infielder in 2014 and 2015, and was the team's starting third baseman in 2014 when the Captains reached the Midwest League Championship Series. The 2021 season is Fink's fifth eason coaching in the Cleveland organization. Former Captains outfielder Jordan Smith also returns to Lake County in his second season as Bench coach. Smith led the Captains with a 316 batting average in 2012 and led the Captains to a playoff berth. Smith was the Captains Bench Coach in 2019 and is entering his third season coaching in Cleveland's organization.

2020 DRAFT: The Captains have three players on their Opening Day roster who were selected by Cleveland in last year's draft. RHP Tanner Burns Competitive Balance Round A), LHP Logan Allen (2nd Round), and RHP Mason Hickman (5th Round).

2017 INTERNATIONAL CLASS: There were four Captains acquired by Cleveland in the 2017 International free agent class, led by OF George Valera. According to Baseball America, Valera was the sixth overall international prospect that year. Also now on the Captains from that class are INF Aaron Bracho, INF Brayan Rocchio and INF Jose Tena. Brach received the highest signing bonus of Cleveland's 2017 international signees at \$1.5 million.

YOUNGSTERS: Eight Captains enter the 2021 season at the age of 21 or younger. INF Joe Naranjo is the youngest on the squad at 19, followed by INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF Jose Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). There are three Captains who are 21 years old. INF Raynel Delgado is the youngest of the trio, which also includes INF Victor Nova and OF Quentin Holmes. The youngest pitcher on the team is RHP Tanner Burns, who is 22.

SWITCH IT UP: Only 1/3 of Captains' position players are true right-handed hitters. The Captains have four (3) switch-hitters, six (7) left-handed hitters nd five (5) right-handed hitters

CAPTAINS FAMILY TIES: Captains 1B Joe Naranjo has a close connection with former Captains SS Tyler Freeman. Naranjo, who is from Whittier, CA, grew up as close friends with Tyler's younger brother Cody, an infielder who was drafted in the 4th round by Texas in 2019. Naranjo remains close with yler, Cody and the Freeman family.

2020 Training: Trained at Cressey Sports Performance and Bommarito Performance, both of which are located in Turner's home state of Florida. Eric Cressey, the president and co-founder of Cressey Sports Performance, is a celebrity in the performance coaching world. Cressey has been the Director of Player Health & Performance for the New York Yankees since January 2020 and has worked with big league stars like Corey Kluber, Noah Syndergaard and Max Scherzer, according to an MLB.com article about his hiring. Matt Blake, formerly Cleveland's director of pitching development and now the Yankees' pitching coach, had previously served as the pitching coordinator at Cressey Sports Performance. Bommarito Performance's website lists professional athlete clientele that includes Miguel Cabrera, JD Martinez, Carlos Santana, Ezekiel Elliott, Rob Gronkowski and Stefon

2019: Turner started the year with Short Season Mahoning Valley and went 2-2 with a 2.90 ERA over six starts. He was promoted to Low-A Lake County in mid-July and finished the season with the Captains. Turner made nine starts with the Captains and went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA.

2018: Turner returned to the Arizona League for the second year, pitching for the Arizona League Indians 1. He made three starts and four relief appearances, posting a 3.75 ERA (15 ER, 36 IP). Turner struck out 36 batters in 36 innings with eight walks and lowered his batting average against to .250 with a 324 BABIP.

2017: After signing with Cleveland, Turner made 10 appearances (three starts, followed by seven relief appearances) for the Rookie level Arizona League Indians. The lefty was limited to a max of three innings per outing and allowed 18 ER over 24 IP (6.75 ERA). Turner struck out 22 hitters in 24 innings and walked eight, but batters hit .340 against him with a .417 BABIP.

DRAFTED YOUNG: Turner was only 17-years old when the Indians drafted him out of Miami Palmetto HS (FL).

MIAMI PALMETTO: Notable alumni from Miami Palmetto High School include Amazon Founder and wealthiest person on Earth Jeff Bezos (net worth \$165.4 billion), late mixed martial artist Kimbo Slice, Dallas Mavericks shooting guard Tim Hardaway, Jr., Miami Marlins radio play-by-play announcer, Glenn Geffner, Tampa Bay Rays third base coach Tom Foley, former Florida Marlins pitcher Bill Hurst, former major League pitcher Vinnie Chulk (Blue Jays, Giants, Indians and Brewers) and former major league third baseman/outfielder Wade Rowdon (Reds, Cubs and Orioles).
