LAST TIME OUT

Myrtle Beach dropped their sixth straight game and fifth to the Charleston RiverDogs with a 7-3 loss on Saturday night. **OF Jacob Wetzel** hit his second home run of the season in the second inning to tie the game 1-1. Charleston used home runs from Brett Wisely to take the lead 2-1 and Abiezel Ramirez to break the game open 7-1. **RHP Richard Gallardo** took his third loss of the season for the Pelicans after giving up four runs off six hits. The RiverDogs now lead the series 5-0 and will go for the sweep today.

ALL THAT POWER

As a team, the Pelicans have struggled for home runs this season, ranking 11/12 in the Low-A East with 18 homers. Of the 18, five were hit in the series against Augusta from 6/8-6/13. Myrtle Beach hit a home run in five-straight games from 6/10 to 6/15, the longest stretch this season with **IF Luis Verdugo** hitting his first two homers last week, and **IF Ryan Reynolds** homering in the series against Augusta and the series opener against Charleston. **OF Jacob Wetzel** hit his second homer of the season on Saturday 6/19 against Charleston.

MYRTLE BEACH CELEBRITY

Sharing the name with the A-List actor, Pelicans infielder **Ryan Reynolds** has been making his name known in the last week. Reynolds has hit safely in six of his last seven games started, going 8-23 (.348) during that stretch with two home runs, a triple, and seven RBI. Nicknamed "Deadpool", Reynolds brought in 11 RBI in his first 11 games since returning from missing 18 games on the IL.

NEED SOME HELP

In the first three games of the series against Charleston, the Birds' pitching staff gave up double-digit hits in every contest, while being outscored 24-11. In this season-high six game losing streak, the Pelicans have been outscored 39-16 by their opponents while being shutout two games in a row by Charleston (6/17, 6/18).

PABLO...SANCHEZ?

Pelicans' **DH/C Pablo Aliendo** has been hitting like the Backyard Baseball legend Pablo Sanchez in the last three weeks. After starting the season just 4-32 (.125), Aliendo saw a nine-game hitting streak end on Wednesday night (6/9) which was tied for the longest by a Pelican this season. In the stretch, Aliendo went 17-33 (.515) with 4 2B, 6 RBIs and 6 runs scored. He leads the team in average at .290 and had six multi-hit performances in seven games from 5/25 to 6/2. Aliendo hit his first home

run of the season on 6/13 at Augusta.

HOWARD RETURNS

After nearly a month-long stint on the IL where he missed 21 games, Cubs' 2020 first-round draft pick **SS Ed Howard** returned to the starting lineup and went 0-2 against Charleston on 6/17. In his first two games back, Howard has been taken out after seeing four innings of action. Howard has gone 11-57 (.193) with 28 strikeouts in his first 16 professional games after becoming the first Cubs first-round selection out of high school since 2021 (Albert Almora Jr.)

BUDDY'S BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2021 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his second stint in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18, and will be coaching his 15th season in the Cubs organization. During his first three years with the Pelicans, Bailey recorded 216 wins, three half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau - he currently sits with 2,157. 2021 will be his 33rd season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

In the last homestand against Columbia from 6/1-6/6, the Pelicans were only able to play two-nine inning games without a delay. Tuesday and Wednesday were played normally, while Thursday's game was suspended in the sixth inning due to rain and completed on Friday. Friday's regular game was postponed to Saturday, where Myrtle Beach played two seven-inning games. Sunday was postponed to a later date. Tuesday's series opener in Augusta (6/8) was also postponed to a doubleheader on Thursday. Rain also affected the game on 6/15 against Charleston, with the contest being called after seven innings of play.

The Pelicans played Charleston for the first time in the season-opening series from 5/4-5/9 with the RiverDogs taking four of six games. It was the first time the two teams had played a regular season series. As a team, the Pelicans went 36-200 (.180) in the series.

In 11 games against Charleston, the Birds have gone 2-9 while being outscored 63-35 in those contests.

- Gave up career-high 7 earned runs in last start vs Charleston 6/15
- Pelicans opening night starter on 5/4/21
- Career-high 10 K at Augusta 6/9 in 5.0 IP (Most by any Pelicans pitcher this season)
- Espinoza was signed as an international free agent on July 31, 2017.
- The 20-year-old spent did not play in 2018, but joined the Cubs Arizona League roster in 2019. He went 5-2, in 11 appearances with seven starts.
- The Mexico-native ended 2019 with a 2.49 ERA over 47 innings pitched, giving up just one home run and nine walks during that time.
- Many players were kept away from game competition in 2020, but Espinoza went back to his hometown to play for Tomateros De Culiacan in the Mexican Pacific League during the pandemic-ridden year.
- He started four games with a 3.93 ERA, 4-4 record, 1 HR allowed, 4 BB, and 16 SO over 18.1 IP

2019 SEASON

- The righty started his tenure in the Cubs' organization strong with an impressive 2019 season in the Arizona League.

- In Espinoza's first start, he went five innings giving up just three hits and zero earned runs. He struck out three and didn't walk any against the AZL Diamondbacks.
- He collected a career-high eight strikeouts on 8/2/19 against the AZL Angels in a four inning start.
- Espinoza would finish with a 5-2 record and a 2.49 ERA over 47 innings pitched. The most impressive number was his strikeout to walk ratio, which stood at 4:1.
