AS CLOSE AS CAN BE

Since June 11, the Daytona Tortugas have played a series of tightly contested ballgames:

- Since last Friday, every contest Daytona has played has been decided by three-or-fewer runs, tallying a 4-4 record in 8 games.
- In that span, the Tortugas have played four one-run games (3-1), three two-run games (1-2), and one three-run game (0-1).
- During this week's six-game homestand vs. Palm Beach, the Tortugas and Cardinals have each scored exactly 36 runs in the first five meetings for an average of 7.2 runs per game...4-of-5 games so far in the set have been decided by one run, with Daytona capturing 3-of-those-4 affairs.
- So far this season, 26 of the Tortugas' 41 games have been decided by three or less...Daytona has gone 5-10 in one-run games, 3-5 in two-run affairs, and 1-2 in three-run ballgames for a combined total mark of 9-17...They are 9-6 in games determined by four-or-more tallies.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE

Daytona walked-off the Palm Beach Cardinals on a two-run SS Ivan Johnson single in Tuesday's resumed contest on Wednesday:

- The victory was Daytona's first walk-off triumph since their final home victory during the 2019 season...The Tortugas defeated the St. Lucie Mets on August 28, 2019, 3-2, in 10 innings...CF Lorenzo Cedrola reached on a throwing error by the first baseman, allowing the tying and winning runs to score.
- It was the 'Tugas first game-ending base-hit since August 7, 2019...IB Bruce Yari rifled a two-run triple to left-center, as Daytona defeated the Florida Fire Frogs, 3-2, in nine innings.
- Daytona's walk-off win was their first against Palm Beach since May 14, 2015...The Tortugas erased a 4-3 deficit in the bottom of the 12th and defeated the Cardinals, 5-4...LF Phil Ervin tied it with a single to center and CF Junior Arias won it with a walk-off RBI knock to left.

HOP ABOARD THE GUS BUS

INF Gus Steiger had a season-high 9-game on-base streak snapped in game two on Wednesday, but has reached in 12-of-13 contests:

- Dating back to June 3, the 22-year-old has tallied a .326 batting average (14-43) with a .326/.453/.349 slashline in addition to providing a .802 OPS.
- Steiger has scored seven runs, doubled, driven in five, walked 10 times, and stole four bases during the stretch.
- The Spring Lake, Minn. native has raised his batting average 50 points (.187 to .237) in the previous 16 days.
- In 6 games during the Bradenton series, Steiger had 4 multi-hit games and went a combined 9-for-20 (.450) at the plate with 4 walks.

GREEN WOLF

Daytona C/DH Garrett Wolforth has been a catalyst at the middle of the Tortugas lineup over the last several contests

- Wolforth enters Sunday on team season-high-tying 9-game hitting streak...During the stretch that began on June 8, the switch-hitter has registered a .343 clip (12-36) with a .343/.351/.657 slashline, adding a 1.008 OPS.
- During the streak, Wolforth has garnered eight runs scored, four doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBI, and a walk.
- In 15 games for the 'Tugas in June, the 23-year-old has a team-best 14 RBI...Wolforth has collected a .288 average (17-59) with a team-high 12 runs scored, 5 doubles, 2 triples, and 3 home runs.
- Since the calendar turned to June, Wolforth is third among Low-A Southeast batters in slugging percentage (.593) and tied for the most triples (2)...He is also second in extra-base hits (10), tied for third in total bases (35), and tied for seventh in home runs (3) and RBI (14).
- Since Wolforth's batting average dipped to a season-low .121 (4-33) on May 25, the switch-hitter has slashed .286/.324/.587 over 17 games with 13 runs scored, 11 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 15 RBI...He has raised his batting average 108 points (.121 to .229) in the last 25 days.

MARRERO'S MONSTER MASH

Like Triana, OF Wendell Marrero had a sluggish beginning to the 2021 campaign and has since caught fire over the last several games:

- Since Daytona's 1-0 no-hitter of Jupiter on May 22, the 20-year-old enters Sunday with a .333/.471/.522 slashline over his previous 23 contests, adding a .993 OPS.
- In that span, Marrero has scored 19 runs, posted 7 extra-base hits, 2 home runs, driven in 9 tallies, drawn 15 walks, and been hit by a pitch thrice.
- Dating back to May 22, the Dorado, P.R. native is tied for the lead among all Low-A Southeast hitters in triples (2)...Additionally, Marrero is third in on-base percentage (.471) and batting average (.333), fourth in OPS (.993), tied for fifth in runs scored (19), and sixth in slugging (.522).
- In his first 10 contests this season, Marrero was 2-for-36 at the plate (.056) with 3 runs, 2 doubles, and an RBI.

CLASS WITH PROFESSOR PROCTOR

Minor League Baseball announced on June 2 that Tortugas RHP James Proctor has been named the Low-A Southeast Pitcher of the Month for May.

- During the season's opening month, the Princeton alum posted a 2-0 record with a microscopic 0.45 ERA (1 ER in 20.0 IP) and 30 strikeouts in five appearances (four starts).
- Proctor ignited Daytona's combined no-hitter of the Jupiter Hammerheads on Saturday, May 22, at Jackie Robinson Ballpark.
 - » Threw 5.0 innings of no-hit ball, allowing only two baserunners in the fourth on a walk and hit-by-pitch.
 - » RHP Vin Timpanelli, RHP Ricky Karcher, RHP Nick Hanson, and RHP Carson Spiers united over the final 4.0 frames to complete the bid.
 - » It was the Tortugas' second no-no and their first since RHP Tyler Mahle threw a 9.0-inning no-hitter at Jupiter on June 13, 2016.
 - » His 11 K's that night are the second-most from a Tortugas pitcher since the franchise rebranded prior to the start of the 2015 season.

CONTRASTING STYLES

Through the first month-plus of the season, the Daytona Tortugas have played 23 home and 18 road games. However, the results at Jackie Robinson Ballpark have had a stark contrast in comparison to what the team has done in visiting ballparks. With umpires calling balls and strikes in Daytona Beach and using the ABS (Automated Ball Strike) System on the road, here is how the splits have shook out thus far:

MEET MY CONSIGLIERE, MÍCHEL

Tortugas 1B Michel Triana has been scorching hot over the couple of weeks:

- Since May 20, Triana has slashed .333/.412/.444 with a .856 OPS...In 20 games, he has 13 runs scored, 7 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, 10 walks, and 3 stolen bases.
- Triana is third among Low-A Southeast hitters in batting average (.333) since that date...Dunedin INF Leo Jiménez is first (.347).
- Prior to that date, the Cuba native hoisted a .156/.270/.188 slashline with a double and no runs batted in 11 games from May 4-19.
- The left-handed slugger thrived at Clover Park, tallying a .353 clip (6-17) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 4 runs batted in, and 4 walks over 5 games played against St. Lucie.
- In the previous series vs. Clearwater, Triana is 8-for-20 (.400) at the plate with two runs scored, a double, and two RBI.

- Allowed a career-high four runs and four hits in 1.2 innings of work... Walked a pair and struck out three...Tossed one wild pitch and induced a double play.
- Did not allow inherited runner to score.
- Yielded a three-run home run to DH Todd Lott and a solo blast by CF Tommy Jew in the fifth.
- Relieved by RHP Brett Lockwood to begin the sixth inning with the Tortugas ahead, 7-6.
- Palm Beach rallied to take the lead, but Daytona tied it in the ninth on a C Daniel Vellojín home run and walked-off in the tenth on a SS Ivan Johnson RBI single.
