LAST OUTING: Lindblom's last time out was a start against the Gwinnett Stripers on June 15 at Coolray Field. The right-hander worked 3.2 innings and gave up 1 run on 3 hits. He got a no decision in Nashville's 2-1 loss and threw 79 pitches, 53 for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom is facing Gwinnett for the fourth time in his career and second time this season.
