LAST GAME: Rochester loaded the bases with two outs in the 8th inning down three runs and had the bases loaded with two outs in the 9th but fell to Worcester 3-1 Thursday night at Polar Park. Cody Wilson collected his first Triple-A RBI with a bases loaded walk in the 9th. Tyler Eppler suffered the loss but turned in just the second quality start by a Red Wing this season after allowing three runs on six hits and a walk with a strikeout over 6.0 innings.

WINNING WAYS: Rochester has won 11 of the last 13 games at Worcester/Pawtucket since August 5, 2018 and have averaged 7.8 runs per game (102 runs) over that stretch. The Red Wings are 22-7 (.759) on the road against the Red Sox since the start of 2017 after just one winning season on the road against Pawtucket from 2010-16 while going a combined 23-35 (.397).

PALKA POWER: Daniel Palka is batting .349/.462/.767 (15-for-43) with five home runs, three doubles, 13 RBI, and 13 runs scored in 13 games since May 19. He ranks among Triple-A East leaders since that time in runs scored (1st), slugging (1st), home runs (T-1st), OPS (2nd, 1.229), on-base percentage (T-3rd), extra-base hits (T-3rd), total bases (T-3rd, 33), and batting average (6th).

AGENT CARTER: Carter Kieboom leads Triple-A East lead with 14 walks since May 19 while ranking fifth in the league with a .449 on-base percentage over that stretch.

LUIS LUIS: Luis Garcia, who turned 21 on May 16, is batting .355/.394/.548 (11-for-31) with two home runs, seven RBI, four runs scored, and a stolen base in seven Triple-A games since May 20. He was recalled by Washington on May 25 and went 1-for-5 with a triple and a run scored in three MLB games before being optioned back to the Red Wings on May 30. Garcia has three 1st-inning home runs this year, including two leadoff homers in the first four games of the year. He's the first Red Wing with multiple leadoff home runs in a season since Byron Buxton and Taylor Motter each hit two in 2018. At 20 years, 11 months, and 19 days old, Garcia became the third youngest player to homer in the International League/Triple-A East since 2018, behind only Ronald Acuña Jr. (20 y, 3 m, 30 d) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (19 y, 4 m, 23 d).

MAKING THEIR PITCH: Rochester pitching had allowed just five home runs, fewest among all 30 Triple-A teams, in its first 12 games before Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Syracuse, and Worcester have hit 17 homers in the last 15 games against the Wings. The Red Wings have allowed 24 home runs, tied for sixth-fewest among all Triple-A teams. Wings relievers have allowed six of those homers while throwing the third-most innings in Triple-A East at 128.2.

OPENING STATEMENTS: Rochester has hit six, 1st-inning home runs, which is tied for fifth among all minor league teams this season. Luis Garcia has hit three of those while Carter Kieboom, Jake Noll and Brandon Snyder each have one. The Red Wings are tied for 69th among MiLB teams with 13 total runs scored in the opening frame. Opponents have scored 20 runs in the 1st inning, tied for the second-most runs allowed in the opening inning in Triple-A East this season.

BASEBALL AMERICAS QUALIFIER UPDATE: Venezuela plays Dominican Republic while Canada plays United States in the Super Round of the Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier today. Current Red Wings Ali Castillo and Ramón Flores have started all three games and former Wing Gabriel Moya has two appearances for Venezuela. Andrew Albers of Canada is the only other current or former Wing remaining in the tournament.

**LAST START:** Armenteros allowed one run on four hits and three walks with five strikeouts over 5.0 innings on May 30 vs. Syracuse. The Mets scored the lone run after catcher Nick Meyer laid down a perfect bunt to score Sebastian Elizalde in the 5th inning. Armenteros worked out of trouble in the 4th after Syracuse loaded the bases with one out but Armenteros struck out back-to-back batters to end the threat. Alec Keller (7), Humberto Arteaga (6) and Wellington Castillo (2) teamed up to throw Elizalde out at the plate following a double in the 1st inning. Armenteros still suffered the loss after the Wings fell 1-0.

**MAY 25 START:** Armenteros pitched a season-high 6.0 innings on May 25 vs. Syracuse, allowing four runs on five hits with four strikeouts. He retired the first seven batters he faced before a one-out triple in the third inning which was followed by a two-run homer from opposing starting pitcher Jerad Eickoff, the first home run by a pitcher in Frontier Field's history. Three straight doubles followed the home run allowing the Mets to score two more runs, pushing their lead to 4-0. Armenteros regrouped after the third and retired the final 10 batters he faced.

**2020:** Missed the entire season in the Houston Astros organization after having surgery to remove a bone spur from his elbow on March 13. He was officially placed on the 10-day Injured List on July 23 and transferred to the 60-day IL on September 5. Armenteros was placed on waivers and claimed by Arizona on November 20 before being placed on waivers again and claimed by Washington on December 7.

**2019:** Had three different stints with Houston. He made his Major League debut on June 14 vs. Toronto. He became the first Astro to record a save in his MLB debut after throwing 3.0 scoreless innings. Armenteros won his first MLB start on July 21 vs. Texas, allowing one run on two hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings. He was named the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week with Round Rock on July 14 after throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with five hits, a walk, and seven strikeouts on July 12 vs. Iowa.

**CUBAN CONNECTION:** Armenteros and Yasmany Tomás are the first Red Wings from Cuba since Deiny Suarez in 2011.

**PROSPECTING:** Armenteros was ranked Houston's 26th-best prospect in 2020, No. 23 in 2019, No. 12 in 2018, and No. 24 in 2017 by Baseball America
