

Advanced stats are big part of the game today and how it's played.
You've had the chance to dive into the analytic world being one of the
first quality control coaches in the MLB and going back to school recently getting your Master's Degree in Cybersecurity. How do you think
you'll be able to implement that into your coaching style here?

I think that the analytics aspect will help me in trying to put players in the best position to succeed in games and for the season. It is not 100% reliable, but reliable nonetheless. In player development, we try to have it where players can be placed in a position to execute their job on the field more accurately, and better suited for situations in-game. It also will help the team in this same way, at least that is my hope. The key is to not get players too bogged down in stats, but at the same time the numbers reveal hidden secrets that may help them in these types of situations.



You've been coached by some of the greatest coaches to do it, Terry Francona, Bobby Valentine, Bobby Cox and even Sparky Anderson.

What are the takeaways / lessons you took from those managers of such a prestigious background and how has it made you into the successful coach you are today?

A

A. I have definitely benefited from being around some great baseball people, managers. Tito Francona was and is a mastermind. His key has always been terrific communication skills, with players and all people generally. I know I have learned a great deal about that from him. His honesty and practicality regarding baseball is so important, and so interesting at the same time. Sparky was an old school guru, a giant in this great game of ours! His success revolved around placing the players, the right players, first. He was a sneaky tactician and used a unique competitive spirit to drive his winning

teams. And again, like Tito, Bobby Cox was a terrific communicator, and he was always well prepared for the game and series at hand. Dallas Green gave me a shot to play in MLB, and I am forever grateful to Dallas for that. I learned a lot from Dallas, especially the importance of being on the field every day, no matter the circumstances. You have to be able to play, to play and perform. Bobby Valentine is so smart. His plus for me was teaching me how to hit, and hit with power. Bobby V. is such a great teacher, especially when it comes to the all-important smaller details.

- Q You were hired as the coach of the A's Class-A Short Season Vermont Lake Monsters last year, but the pandemic shelved the opportunity. You get the chance this season to finally be back, what's it like to be back in the baseball environment again after stepping away?
- A Baseball always finds a way to rebound, even under difficult circumstances. The joy of the game is a forever thing and the fact that we are still able to play is such a blessing, one not to be taken for granted, ever.

- What is your favorite thing about being a coach?
- A I love to coach! The Joy is in watching players and teams develop, improve and of course, win. Sports competition is among my favorite things in life, and being a coach is being a part of that process. Nothing hatter!
- What is one thing you want the Stockton Ports community to know about you coming in?
- A lam all about team and teamwork. I consider myself a Belichick disciple in that regard. Nothing is more important in team sports than trying to always do what is in the best interest of the team. Team comes first. Our fans in Stockton will be watching a team that truly believes in teamwork, togetherness and all.
