- WINNERS: The Blue Coats roster contains three players that have won either an NBA G League championship or an NCAA title.
 - MICHAEL FRAZIER II is a 2018-19 NBA G League champion with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers.
 - o **BRAXTON KEY** helped the University of Virginia to the 2019 NCAA Championship.
 - o **JULIAN WASHBURN** is a 2017-18 NBA G League champion with the Austin Spurs.
- In Tuesday's semifinal win over the Raptors 905, the Blue Coats dished out 36 assists, their highest assist total for any game this year, including the regular season.
 - o Delaware had 17 steals, which is also a season-high mark, after swiping at least 10 steals in 10 of their 15 regular season games and leading the G League and leading the G League in steals per game (11.1).
- Monday's win over the Austin Spurs was the first postseason victory in Delaware franchise history in the team's first-ever playoff game.
- With a win over the Canton Charge and NBA G League Ignite's loss to the Agua Caliente Clippers on March 3, the Blue Coats clinched a playoff berth for the first time in Delaware's eight-year franchise history.
- The Blue Coats held the Salt Lake City Stars to an NBA G League season-low 83 points on Friday.
- Delaware was sixth in offensive rating and sixth in defensive rating (fifth in net rating) during the regular season, one of only two teams to rank in the top six for both categories.
- On Feb. 26, the Blue Coats fell to the Lakeland Magic, 115-107, in the only regular season meeting between the two teams.
 - o 76ers two-way contract player **RAYJON TUCKER** finished with a game-high 25 points on 6-15 shooting from the field, 1-4 from three-point range and 7-8 from the free-throw line (12 G League free-throw points).
 - o Fellow 76ers two-way contract player **PAUL REED** notched his eighth double-double of the season for the Blue Coats with 22 points, a gamehigh 14 rebounds (four offensive), two assists, two steals and one block.
 - o The Magic led by 22 points at halftime before the Blue Coats made it a one possession game, trailing 94-91, with 4:48 to go in regulation. Lakeland overcame 20 turnovers in the win.
- Reed was the only NBA G League player who appeared in more than half of his team's regular season games to average at least 20 points and 11 rebounds. He started all 15 games.
 - o The DePaul product was the only player in the league with at least 25 steals (29) and 25 blocks (27) during the regular season.
 - o Reed was the only player among the G League's top-10 in total rebounds with at least 20 three-pointers made (24).

The Blue Coats shot 19-43 (.442) from three-point range in the win over the Raptors 905 in the semifinals. The team dished out 36 assists, their highest assist total for any game this year, including the regular season. Delaware had 17 steals as a group, which is also a season-high mark, after swiping at least 10 steals in 10 of their 15 regular season games and leading the G League in steals per game (11.1).

The Delaware Blue Coats defeated the Austin Spurs, 124-103, on Monday night at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex near Orlando, Florida. It was the first postseason victory in Delaware franchise history in the team's first-ever playoff game. Isaiah Joe, on assignment from the 76ers, poured in a game-high 28 points (9-18 FG, 7-15 3FG, 2-2 FT) with four rebounds, three assists and one steal for the Blue Coats. 76ers two-way contract players Paul Reed (17 points, six rebounds, three assists, two steals, one block) and Rayjon Tucker (14 points) combined for 31 points. The pair was part of a group of six Blue Coats to reach double figures scoring, including all five starters.

Delaware's Justin Robinson recorded a double-double with 16 points, a G League career-high-tying 13 assists and four steals in 33 minutes. Robinson's previous 13-assist game came in the first meeting against the Spurs on Feb. 21. Michael Frazier II, celebrating his 27th birthday on Monday, came off the Blue Coats bench to score 18 points and record a game-high plus-29 rating. Delaware reserve Jemerrio Jones posted a plus-25 rating with a team-high 12 rebounds on top of four points and three assists in 27 minutes of action.
