

Executive Chairman and Chief Executive Officer
The Madison Square Garden Company

James L. Dolan is Executive Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of The Madison Square Garden Company (MSG), a leading live entertainment company renowned for its world-famous arena complex, professional sports teams, entertainment properties and historic showplaces. Mr. Dolan also serves as Executive Chairman of MSG Networks Inc., which includes two award-winning regional sports and entertainment networks.

In his role at MSG, Mr. Dolan is responsible for the Company's overall growth strategy and oversight of its operations. He also serves as governor to the National Basketball Association and the National Hockey League on behalf of the New York Knicks and New York Rangers.

Throughout his tenure, Mr. Dolan has spearheaded an ambitious vision to ensure the Company continues to set the standard for live sports and entertainment. This includes the Company's plans to build state-of-the-art venues in Las Vegas and London, called MSG Sphere, that will pioneer the next generation of immersive experiences. Mr. Dolan first introduced his strategy for a large-scale music and entertainment focused venue in January 2014 with the successful re-opening of the legendary Forum arena in Inglewood, California. Mr. Dolan was also the catalyst for the restoration of the Company's cherished national landmark, Radio City Music Hall, in 1999, as well as the famed Beacon

Theatre in early 2009. This was followed by the three-year, top-to-bottom transformation of the Madison Square Garden Arena, which was completed in October 2013. MSG's venues also include The Chicago Theatre, which was built in 1921 as one of the country's most opulent motion picture houses.

In addition to its portfolio of landmark venues, MSG owns and operates professional sports teams, the New York Knicks and New York Rangers, as well as entertainment properties, including the Christmas Spectacular Starring the Radio City Rockettes. MSG has expanded its live offerings through investments in Boston Calling Events, which produces the Boston Calling Music Festival; TAO Group, a hospitality group with globally-recognized entertainment dining and nightlife brands; and Counter Logic Gaming, a leading North American esports organization.

Mr. Dolan has led MSG's response to local and national tragedies. He played a principal role in organizing several extraordinary benefit concerts, including "12-12-12," which raised more than \$50 million for the victims of Hurricane Sandy; "The Concert For New York City," which generated more than \$35 million in aid for 9/11 victims and heroes; and "From The Big Apple to The Big Easy," which raised nearly \$9 million for Hurricane Katrina relief. Mr. Dolan also supports both MSG's and MSG Networks Inc.'s ongoing commitment to the community, particularly through the Garden of Dreams Foundation, the non-profit charity that works with both companies to help children throughout the New York metropolitan area.

In addition to his oversight of MSG, Mr. Dolan also serves as Executive Chairman of MSG Networks Inc., which became a standalone media company following the 2015 spin-off of The Madison Square Garden Company. MSG Networks Inc. is comprised of MSG Network and MSG+, which together annually telecast more than 450 live professional games, along with a comprehensive lineup of other sporting events, as well as critically-acclaimed original programming.

Mr. Dolan served as Chief Executive Officer of Cablevision Systems Corporation from 1995 until June 2016, when the leading media and telecommunications company, which served as MSG's parent company until 2010, was sold to Altice. Prior to his role as Cablevision CEO, Mr. Dolan was Chief Executive Officer of Rainbow Media Holdings, the former Cablevision programming subsidiary now known as AMC Networks Inc. Mr. Dolan began his career with Cablevision in the 1970s and held a variety of executive positions before overseeing Rainbow Media.

Mr. Dolan serves on the board of directors for MSG, MSG Networks Inc., and AMC Networks Inc. He is also on the board of The Lustgarten Foundation, an organization he helped found in 1998, which today is the nation's largest private supporter of pancreatic cancer research. Since its inception, the Foundation has directed more than \$165 million to research and assembled the best scientific minds to help find a cure.

President

The Madison Square Garden Company

As President of The Madison Square Garden Company (MSG), Andrew Lustgarten is responsible for driving both internal and external opportunities for growth. He oversees MSG's entertainment and sports bookings and productions businesses, as well as all aspects of the business operations of the Company's professional sports franchises. In addition, Mr. Lustgarten drives the Company's corporate development activities, including new strategic opportunities, initiatives and partnerships, as well as the Company's plans to build state-of-the-art venues, called MSG Sphere, in Las Vegas and London.

The Company's signature assets consist of some of the nation's most dynamic and powerful sports and entertainment brands. This diverse collection of properties includes a portfolio of iconic venues: New York's Madison Square Garden, Hulu Theater at Madison Square Garden, Radio City Music Hall and Beacon Theatre; the Forum in Inglewood, California; and The Chicago Theatre. In addition, MSG owns and operates professional sports teams, the New York Knicks and New York Rangers; and entertainment properties, including the Christmas Spectacular Starring the Radio City Rockettes.

Before being named President in 2017, Mr. Lustgarten served for three years as Executive Vice President of Corporate Development and Strategy and, during that time, was responsible for a variety of critical areas. He effectively oversaw

MSG's live operations, including its bookings businesses at all of the Company's iconic venues. In addition, he was responsible for diversifying MSG's portfolio of live offerings, overseeing MSG's acquisitions of controlling interests in TAO Group, a world-renowned hospitality group; Boston Calling Events, which produces the premier Boston Calling Music Festival; and Counter Logic Gaming, a leading North American esports organization; as well as the Company's purchase of a minority stake in Townsquare Media, a media, entertainment and digital marketing solutions company. Mr. Lustgarten also played an integral role in the Company's investment in and expansive marketing partnership with DraftKings, the fantasy sports giant, and has introduced innovative new opportunities such as bringing the first-ever esports events to The Garden and spearheading strategic investments in virtual reality leaders, Jaunt and NextVR.

Previously, Mr. Lustgarten spent seven years at the National Basketball Association, where he served as Senior Vice President, Global Strategy, and before that, Special Assistant to the Commissioner. He played a key role in the negotiation of the league's landmark media rights deals in 2014 and its collective bargaining agreement. He oversaw the NBA's global strategy group, which focuses on the league's global initiatives, media opportunities and new ventures, including equity investment structuring. Mr. Lustgarten was also involved in numerous strategic initiatives, including the league's revenue sharing plan, the formation of a \$253 million external investment in NBA China, and the investment in one-day fantasy sports operator FanDuel. Prior to joining the NBA, Mr. Lustgarten worked at Cablevision Systems Corporation in finance and in investment banking at Bear Stearns & Co.

In March 2014, Mr. Lustgarten was named to Sports Business Journal's Forty Under 40 list of the most influential executives in sports under 40 years old. He is on the board of directors of TAO Group, Boston Calling Events and Counter Logic Gaming. He is also on the boards of the Garden of Dreams Foundation, a non-profit organization that works closely with all areas of MSG to positively impact the lives of children facing obstacles, and the Lustgarten Foundation for Pancreatic Cancer Research, the nation's largest private supporter of pancreatic cancer research. In addition, Mr. Lustgarten serves on the board of governors for the National Basketball Association and the National Hockey League on behalf of the New York Knicks and New York Rangers.

Mr. Lustgarten earned an M.B.A. from Columbia Business School, with concentrations in finance and management, and received a Bachelor's degree in Economics from the University of Pennsylvania. He lives in New York with his wife and three children.



Craig Robinson

Vice President, Player Development & G League Operations and General Manager

Craig Robinson joined the Knicks for his first season as the Vice President prior to the start of the 2016-17 season. He also serves as the Westchester Knicks General Manager.

Robinson spent this past season with the Milwaukee Bucks as the vice president of player and organizational development. Prior to the Bucks, he worked as a men's college basketball analyst for ESPN Networks where his responsibilities included game, sideline, and in-studio broadcasts. Robinson spent six seasons as head basketball coach at Oregon State University (2008-14), and two seasons at Brown University (2006-08). He led Oregon State to a 93-104 record (.472).

The Chicago native began his coaching career as an assistant at the Illinois Institute of Technology (1988-90), becoming head coach at Chicago Lab School (1999-2000) before serving as an assistant at Northwestern University (2000-06).

Robinson was a two-time Ivy League Player of the Year at Princeton University, where he was a teammate of New York Knicks President Steve Mills. He was selected by the Philadelphia 76ers in the fourth round (93rd overall) of the 1983 NBA Draft before playing professionally in England for two seasons.

Following his playing career, Robinson received a business degree in finance from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business in 1992. He worked as vice president at Continental Bank (1990-92), vice president at Morgan Stanley Dean Witter (1992-99), and as managing director and partner at Loop Capital Markets. He is also the author of the New York Times Best Seller "A Game of Character."

Robinson graduated from Princeton University in 1983 with a Bachelor of Arts in sociology and is the older brother of former U.S. First Lady Michelle Obama and the brother-in-law of former U.S. President Barack Obama. He is married to Kelly and they have four children.





Derrick Alston
Head Coach

On August 20, 2019, former Westchester Knicks assistant coach, Derrick Alston, became the franchise's fourth head coach in team history and succeeded Mike Miller who joined the New York Knicks coaching staff.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to become the new head coach of the Westchester Knicks and to continue the development of our young and talented players, both on and off the court." Alston said. "I want to thank Steve Mills, Scott Perry, Craig Robinson and the entire Knicks organization for this opportunity and continued support. I'm eager to get started."

"Derrick has been an integral part of this organization and what we are building in both New York and Westchester," said Craig Robinson, vice president of player development and Westchester Knicks general manager. "His appointment, after an extensive search, is a continuation of the development and success our players have enjoyed. Derrick has a unique vantage point and knows from experience the process of developing into an NBA player. His experience combined with his natural teaching ability and leadership skills make him the ideal coach to carry out the Westchester Knicks vision."

Alston spent the last four seasons as an assistant for Westchester helping guide the franchise to a 108-92 (.540) record. Alston helped Westchester capture its first-ever postseason victory last season.

Before joining the Knicks organization, Alston served as a player development coach with the Houston Rockets for three seasons. He played four years at Duquesne University and was named First Team All-Atlantic 10 in 1994. Selected 33rd overall in the 1994 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers, Alston spent two seasons with the team (1994-1996) and signed with the Atlanta Hawks prior to the 1996-97 season. Alston played two games with the Hawks in 1996 before moving overseas, spending the next 15 years playing for 13 different teams across six countries. In 1999, he led FCB Barcelona to the Spanish League title while also taking home the Finals MVP award.

Alston graduated from Hoboken High School in Hoboken, N.J. in 1990. Born on August 20, 1972 in the Bronx, N.Y., Derrick and his wife Robin are proud parents of Derrick Jr. and Avery.





Keith Bogans
Assistant Coach

Keith Bogans, a veteran of 11 season in the NBA with eight organizations (Orlando Magic, Charlotte Bobcats, Houston Rockets, Milwaukee Bucks, San Antonio Spurs, Chicago Bulls, New Jersey/Brooklyn Nets, and Boston Celtics), joined Westchester prior to the 2017-18 season through the NBA's Assistant Coaches Apprentice Program.

A four-year starter for the Kentucky Wildcats, Bogans was inducted into the University of Kentucky Athletics Hall of Fame in 2014. In his senior year at UK, he led the 2002-03 Wildcats to a 16-0 sweep of the Southeastern Conference and the SEC Tournament title, finishing with an Elite Eight run in the NCAA Tournament. He was an All-American as a college senior when he averaged 15.7 points, 3.8 rebounds, 2.7 assists, and 1.2 steals. He was also 80-for-209 from three-point range. His illustrious collegiate career ended as he limped off the court at the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome, after playing the game on a severely sprained ankle. The Wildcats ended up falling in the Elite 8.

Bogans was selected in the second round (43rd overall) in the 2003 NBA Draft by Milwaukee before being traded to Orlando. Appearing in 671 career NBA games at both the shooting guard and small forward positions, Bogans averaged 6.3 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 1.3 assists over 21.6 minutes per game. Bogans was acquired by the Westchester Knicks from the available player pool on Jan. 29, 2016 and appeared in seven games for Westchester during the 2015-16

season before ending his playing career due to injury.

As a high school standout at DeMatha Catholic, Bogans was a 2002-03 Third Team All-American by Associated Press, a 2002-03 SEC Player of the Year by coaches, a 2002-03 All-SEC First Team, a 2002-03 SEC Tournament MVP, a 2000-01 Second Team All-SEC by Associated Press, a 2000-01 Second Team All-SEC by coaches, a 2000-01 SEC Tournament MVP, a 2000-01 SEC All-Tournament Team, a 1999-00 All-SEC Freshman Team, a 1998-99 McDonald's All-American and a 1998-99 Parade All-American.





Allen Deep
Assistant Coach

Allen Deep joined the Westchester Knicks staff as an assistant coach prior to the start of the 2019-20 season.

Deep arrives to the Knicks by the way of the Maine Red Claws, the official NBA G League affiliate of the Boston Celtics. Deep spent a little over two years in Portland, Maine where he helped guide the Red Claws to fourth (2017-18) and fifth (2018-19) place finishes in the Atlantic Division.

He was recently named an assistant coach for the 2019 NBA G-League International Challenge in Montevideo, Uruguay where an elite team comprised the league's premiere talent competed against top international standouts from around the world. Deep helped pilot the team to a second-place finish, falling within 10 points to euro-league powerhouse, Bayern Munich, in the championship game.

Deep currently serves as Support Staff/Player Development Assistant for USA Basketball and has since 2016. In this capacity, he carries out day-to-day operations tasks for National Team Director Sean Ford, assists with the World Cup Qualifying Team under esteemed former NBA coach Jeff Van Gundy and coordinates and personally carries out individual player development with Select and National Team members.

In 2016-17, Deep was a Graduate Assistant for player development for the University of Akron men's basketball program. That season, the Zips defeated the University of Houston in the opening round of the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) by three before enduring a second-round setback to UT Arlington.

Deep is a graduate of Indiana University of Pennsylvania (2008) and the University of Akron (2017). Born on July 28, 1984 in New Castle, Penn., Deep and his wife Kathryn are proud pet parents of Larry, and Belle.





Lisa C. Willis
Assistant Coach

Following the completion of the NBA's Assistant Coaches Program Apprenticeship, Lisa C. Willis joined the Westchester Knicks coaching staff prior to the start of the 2019-20 season.

Previous to coaching, Willis played for the WNBA following a stellar collegiate career at UCLA. In the 2006 WNBA draft, she was selected fifth overall by the Los Angeles Sparks before playing two seasons with the New York Liberty (2007-08).

Willis was a four-year women's basketball standout at UCLA and in her senior season alone, was recognized as the nation's best defender by ESPN's Nancy Lieberman, named Honorable mention AP All American, selected to the Women's Basketball News Service All American Third Team, named as a Preseason Naismith Award Nominee and nominated for the Bayer Advantage Senior Class Award. Upon graduation, Willis left her mark on numerous all-time statistical categories in Bruins' program history. The 6'0 guard was the all-time three-point leader and second all-time in the PAC-10, ranked ninth all-time in points scored, ranked fifth all-time in games played, ranked second all-time in steals and listed as the first player in history to record three straight seasons with 100 or more steals.

A native of Long Beach, California, Willis was a four-year Varsity basketball player at Narbonne High School. There, she won two US national championships, captured two straight city championships, named second team All-State as an underclassman, was recognized as the Los Angeles Player of the Year and a Nike All-American. As a sophomore in 2000, Willis was named the California Player of the Year.

Born June 13, 1984, Willis is the youngest of Robert and Sandra Willis' five children, Bryant, Robin, Kevin and Stephanie.

MSG TRAINING CENTER

The Madison Square Garden Training Center, just north of New York City in Westchester County, is the home-away-from-home for the Westchester Knicks and also houses the New York Knicks and New York Rangers. During the spring and summer of 2019, the state-of-the-art facility went under considerable renovation allowing approximately 8,500 square feet of additional space for Knicks and Rangers offices, equipment and storage. Both Knicks and Rangers weight rooms were converted to open floor plans with an approximately 30-percent increase in occupied space for each team. Additionally, both Rangers and Knicks locker rooms were completely rebuilt with new lockers in each stall. The Knicks locker room also features a brand new style and layout.

The Training Center features amenities such as a state-of-the-art Hydroworks wet therapy system that is approximately 400-percent larger than the previous system and a dedicated sports science lab.

The A/V technology throughout the building was upgraded and now featured in each team's new dedicated conference rooms. New branding concepts for each team were introduced, including the Westchester Knicks, throughout the building which were designed by Advent. New LED lighting upgrades were installed throughout the building, including over the Rangers practice rink, Knicks basketball courts and both team weight rooms.

The newly renovated practice facility also includes-

- Soundproofed basketball courts and Knicks weight room; courts were also re-screened and re-painted
- Press conference room has doubled in size
- Increased parking capacity; an additional lot with approximately 40 new spots
- New carpeting and paint throughout the entire building



USA BASKETBALL

John Jenkins was selected to the USA World Cup Qualifiers for the November games which finished 1-1. Stephen Zimmerman was selected to the USA World Cup Qualifiers for the February games which finished 2-0.

FIRST TRIPLE OVERTIME BATTLE

On February 28, 2019 the Westchester Knicks (25-18) endured a franchise first triple-overtime battle at the Greensboro Swarm (21-20) but fell, 122-116, Thursday afternoon at The Fieldhouse.

MIKE MILLER EARNS 100th VICTORY

On February 8, 2019 the Westchester Knicks (21-16) topped the visiting Canton Charge (12-22), 112-96, behind a career-high performance from Devon Baulkman Friday evening at Westchester County Center. With the win, head coach Mike Miller earned his 100th career victory.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On February 11, Billy Garrett was named the NBA G League Player of the Week as announced by the league Monday afternoon. In a 2-0 week for Westchester, Garrett averaged a team-leading 30.0 points on 51.2-percent shooting, 3.5 rebounds, 7.0 assists, 1.5 steals and drained four triples.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE

On March 7, 2019, Kadeem Allen of the Westchester Knicks (27-18), became the second player in franchise history to record a triple-double in a 127-118 win over the Windy City Bulls (27-18) Thursday afternoon at Westchester County Center. Allen, who is a Two-Way Player, registered 16 points on 54.6-percent shooting, a career-high 12 rebounds and 12 assists. His triple-double performance is just the fifth of its kind in Westchester Knicks history.

2018-19 ALL-NBA G LEAGUE DEFENSIVE TEAM

On April 3, 2019, Two-Way Player Kadeem Allen of the Westchester Knicks, was named to the 2018-19 NBA G League All-Defensive Team as announced by the league office Wednesday afternoon.

In 39 games played, Allen, 6'3, 200, ranked top-20 in the G League in steals per game (1.5). His season-high stood at four steals which he registered at Long Island (12/20).

His 5.5 rebounds per game ranked top-30 but top-10 among guards who appeared in at least 39 contests. His 1.1 offensive rebounds slotted him 12th among guards who appeared in at least 39 games.

FRANCHISE RECORD BLOWOUT

On November 23, 2018, the Westchester Knicks (7-3), downed the visiting Wisconsin Herd (1-7), 131-75, Friday night at the Westchester County Center. The 56-point margin of the victory set a franchise record while it also marked the first time a team won by 50-plus points since the Raptors 905 dominated Texas, 136-80 on February 5, 2016.

Luke Kornet netted a game-high 25 points on 57.1-percent shooting. The forward also swished five triples on a 71.4-percent shooting clip. New Orleans Flex Assignee Kenrich Williams notched a double-double comprised of 15 points and 13 rebounds, including three on the offensive glass.

KNICKS' WIN MAKES HISTORY

On December 5, 2018, the Westchester Knicks (12-3), topped the visiting South Bay Lakers (6-8), 103-89, on Wednesday evening at the Westchester County Center. The win makes seven straight-setting a new franchise record.

New Orleans Pelicans Two-Way Player Trevon Bluiett netted a career-high 29 points on 62.5-percent shooting. The reserve drained a game-high five triples on 45.5-percent shooting. 


