Playoff Bound!

Steel FC earned the eighth seed on Sunday afternoon, drawing Saint Louis FC, 1-1. Coupled with results from this past weekend, Steel FC's second season in the USL was good enough for the final spot in the USL Cup Playoffs.

The official USL affiliate of the Philadelphia Union, Steel FC claimed one of the eight conference playoff spots on officially Thursday night when Orlando City B fell to the Tampa Bay Rowdies. In only its second season of modern existence, Steel FC has had a strong sophomore regular season campaign, setting a club record for victories (12), goals (46) as well as netting an impressive eight-match unbeaten streak during the summer.

Real Nets First Professional Goal

After falling behind on an unfortunate goal, Bethlehem Steel FC equalized less than a minute later from an unusual source as defender Matt Real collected his first professional goal.

After play resumed following the visitor's goal, Real collected a James Chambers pass and dribbled into the offensive side of the field. After a volley to Moar was defended by Saint Louis FC, the 18-year-old defender won the ball back against a pair of defenders. With the ball inside the 18-yard-box, Real beat the keeper on the near post to tie the match.

STEEL FC HEADS TO EASTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPS FOR FIRST USL CUP PLAYOFF MATCH IN CLUB HISTORY

With the club's first USL playoff berth secured, Bethlehem Steel FC will look to improve it's playoff seeding when the squad concludes its regular season in front of its home crowd against Saint Louis FC. Steel FC clinched a playoff spot with Orlando City B's loss on Thursday night. Steel FC has taken points in eight of its last nine matches and will look to continue their impressive play as the season comes to an end.

PREVIOUS MEETING

Steel FC fought Louisville to a 2-2 draw on the road in mid September. Steel FC jumped out to an early lead with a Cory Burke penalty kick. After Louisville answered with their PK, five minutes Santi Moar gave Steel FC the lead once again with a rebound goal. However, Louisville battled back for a draw as Oscar Jimenez scored from distance on a free kick.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the club making it's first postseason appearance... "It's a tremendous accomplishment. For our staff and the families that support us because so much goes into a 10 month season. It's a great accomplishment and something that we've enjoyed this week and made sure we realished the opportunity to go into the playoffs and to go into a quarterfinal with Louisville."

On preparing for Louisville City FC and their challenging environment... "Now it's time to sit back and what the players do what they do and try and do what's gotten us here over the past couple of weeks. You have to be fearless, energetic and not play any differently than we have this year. I think we've been good at putting teams under pressure in their own environments and getting off to a good start on the road and that's going to be important. The most important thing we can do for ourselves is match the energy in the first 15-20 minutes."

MATCH RECAP

Facing the top club in the United Soccer League's Eastern Conference, Bethlehem Steel FC showed no fear as it fought to a 2-2 draw at Louisville City FC.

Having not played in over two weeks, Steel FC came out aggressive at Louisville Slugger Field where Louisville had won eight of its 12 matches at the start of the night. Steel FC jumped out to a first-half lead behind Cory Burke's sixth goal of the season, as the 25-year-old converted from the penalty spot. After Louisville equalized with their own penalty kick goal, Santi Moar gave Steel FC it's second lead of the night, as he slotted home the rebound off a saved Burke shot. The goal was the forward's fourth goal of his rookie campaign. An Oscar Jimenez free kick goal late in the second half helped Louisville City fight to escape with a 2-2 draw in front of their supporters.



Playing another one of the top clubs in the Eastern Conference, Bethlehem Steel FC couldn't overcome a pair of first half goals, falling to Louisville City FC, 3-1.

In a match that featured three goals off of set pieces, current USL Player of the Week Luke Spencer helped push Louisville to the victory, netting a first-half brace. Steel FC fought back with a set piece goal from Philadelphia Union defender Richie Marquez late in the opening frame, scoring on a free kick started by Aaron Jones. With Steel FC knocking on the door of an equalizer, Louisville found an insurance goal off the head of substitute Cameron Lancaster.

Head coach Brendan Burke
