CONNEH CONTINUES SCORING STREAK

Liberian international forward Seku Conneh continued his historic scoring pace against Saint Louis FC, scoring in the 56th minute. After breaking the club's single-season scoring highmark in his previous game, Conneh extended the record while also scoring his fourth goal in the last five matches. The 21-year-old also notched his second assist of the year on James Chambers' game-winning goal.

THE CAPTAIN SCORES WINNING GOAL

After missing Steel FC's first four matches due to the death of his father, Bethlehem Steel FC team captain James Chambers has returned in form. The club's all-time leader in appearances, starts and minutes, the 30-year-old midfielder notched his first game-winning goal with the club in the 74th minute against Saint Louis FC. After a patient build up from Seku Conneh, Chambers fired a rocket from 20 yards out that curled inside the post to give Steel FC a 2-1 win.

MCGUIRE CONTINUES AMAZING SEASON

Jake McGuire, a goalkeeper from the Philadelphia Union, has had an immediate impact on Bethlehem Steel FC through the club's first 12 matches. With starts in nine games, McGuire has already established a new team record for wins passing fellow Union teammate John McCarthy's mark in 2016. Besides leading Steel FC to wins, McGuire ranks third in the USL in saves, having notched 36 this season. His best performance of the year thus far came on the road at Toronto FC II, notching seven saves in route to his third shutout of the season.

STEEL FC CONTINUES JUNE ROAD TRIP AT RIVAL RED BULLS II

After picking up its fifth win of the season, second on the road at Saint Louis FC, Bethlehem Steel FC will look to build upon its winning ways when it makes the short ride to face rival New York Red Bulls II. The squad is in search of its first victory against its regional rival, with the club falling in all three previous matchups last season to the 2016 USL Champions.

LAST REGULAR SEASON MEETING:

In the midst of its attempt to make the playoffs, Steel FC faced off against rival New York Red Bulls II for a third time. Playing in front of its home crowd, New York took the early lead on a goal from Brandon Allen in the 31st minute. In the match that was highlighted by the return of Maurice Edu from injury, Steel FC battled hard but Derrick Etienne added the insurance goal in stoppage time to propel Red Bulls II to the season sweep.

THEY SAID...

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the comeback victory at Saint Louis FC...

"I'm really proud of the guys for them to push through in that environment, it showed a lot of character. The general sentiment was that we could have played better soccer in the first half but that we corrected it in the second half. The second goal the real showpiece for our ability to break their lines. You can't get too much more out of a game on the road than we did in the second half."

On changes at the half...

"In the first half we talked about managing the weather and turf with the high temperatures and it was muggy as well with wind on top of it. We had talked about sitting off the game the opening 15 minutes and we were clearly not good when we did that. We got back to what we do well in the final half and pressed and it served us really well with the tempo on the ball and to dictate the pace of the game until we ran out of gas."

On playing New York Red Bulls II for the first time this season...

"They are very good at being systematic top to bottom as a club and that's credit to their coaching and technical staff. I think their biggest change this season has been the quality of some players compared to the players last season. When you look at Tyler Adams, Derrick Etienne, Alex Muyl and now those guys are eating first team minutes. It's working but its left the squad still very good and I still expect them to finish near the top of the Eastern Conference. We know we are walking into a dog fight anytime you play a Red Bulls team at any level.

Head coach Brendan Burke
