Steel FC Goes Gold

Bethlehem Steel FC has teamed up with the Pediatric Cancer Foundation of the Lehigh Valley to go gold to raise funds for the organization when the club returns home on Sunday, Sept. 24. Steel FC will wear special gold warmups prior to kickoff and gold armbands for the entirety of the match. During the match, fans will be able to bid on the warmups and armbands through a silent auction held on the concourse. All auctioned items will be signed by the players following the match.

The club will also honor those who lost their fight to pediatric cancer while celebrating those who are fighting cancer. The club will be escorted onto the field with children from PCFLV.

Moar, Moar, Moar

Santi Moar continued his strong rookie campaign at Louisville, notching his fourth goal of the season. The Spaniard's goal gave him a matching total for goals and assists, with the winger tied for the club's lead in all-time and single season assists with Adam Najem. Moar's goal was similar to his pervious goal at Ottawa Fury FC, collecting a rebound and firing it into the back of the net.

Golden Burke

Since coming back from the CONCACAF Gold Cup where he helped Jamaica to the finals, Cory Burke has been unstoppable for Steel FC. Over the past month, Burke notched three goals and two assists and was named a finalist for the league's Player of the Month. Burke leads Steel FC all-time with 22 points (nine goals and four assists) and is tied for the club's lead in goals and assists.

STEEL FC STARTS THREE GAME STRETCH AT HOME

Bethlehem Steel FC kicks off it's busiest stretch of the regular season campaign this weekend, beginning against in-state rival Pittsburgh Riverhounds. This will be the third and final meeting between the two Keystone State rivals, with Pittsburgh owning a 1-0-1 advantage in 2017. The match is crucial for both clubs, as both sit one point outside the playoff picture in ninth place in the Eastern Conference.

LAST REGULAR SEASON MEETING:

The two clubs squared off last month, with Pittsburgh claiming a 3-2 victory over Steel FC. Despite a career-night from Cory Burke's brace, Kevin Kerr responded with the game-winning goal in the 75th minute to add to his pair of assists. Steel FC rallied from a 2-0 first half deficit with goals from Burke but the lead only held for four minutes before Pittsburgh took advantage of an unfornate bounce at the goalline.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the draw against Louisville...

"Happy to get a result at Louisville, it's a difficult place to play for a number of reasons. They have a good crowd and a difficult field and I think that affected Jake [McGuire] a little bit but in terms of the team's performance, there was a lot of energy. We pressed hard, turned them over quite a bit in midfield and I think matched them stride for stride for the most part."

On gaining momentum ahead of a busy upcoming stretch...
"I think so. We've gone of the road against two playoff teams in Orlando and Louisville and performed and gotten draws. Probably both should have been wins but we got draws in both of those games and I'm happy with that and I do consider that momentum coming back home for two games."

On preparing for Pittsburgh for the third time in 2017... "You know there is going to be a lot of emotion and energy in the game and that is what [Pittsburgh] is all about. They have very good forwards, two very good wingers and a stout defensive group. There aren't really any holes in Pittsburgh so you have to be in good form and energetic to get a result in a game like that."

Head coach Brendan Burke
