In Steel FC's lone home match against the Rhinos, the two teams battled to a 1-1 draw at Goodman Stadium on July 24. Derrick Jones opened the scoring for Steel FC in the 19th minute with Kenardo Forbes notching the equalizer in the 57th minute.

## Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his second season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, after coaching the squad to a 6-14-10 record during the club's inaugural campaign.
